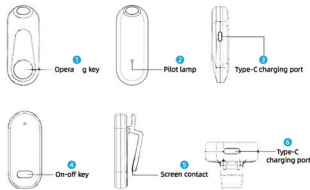

Function description

1. Page Turner and remote control, charging status indicator flashing, fully charged indicator steady on.
2. If the remote control and is not used for 30 minutes, the Page Turner will automatically shut down. You need to click the page Turner and click the function button of the remote control to continue using it. Each operation of the remote control and the page Turner indicator light will blink once (such as in the case of sufficient power, press the remote control, the page Turner does not respond, it is recommended to re-pair operation)
