
Download the Arlo app from the App Store or Google Play.







Angled mounting plate




Release pin (keep

If you choose to wire your doorbell

If you choose to wire your Wire-Free Video Doorbell, the voltage must be 8 – 24VAC and a 10VA transformer is required.

If your voltage doesn't meet the power requirements, and you need to install or upgrade a transformer, contact a licensed electrician or visit arlo.com for information about installation services.
