It is not to be recharged, repaired or modified in any way. 1.1.3 The battery is not to be used for any purpose other than that for which it is designed. 1.1.4 The battery is not to be used in any environment where it may be exposed to fire, explosion, or other hazardous conditions. 1.1.5 The battery is not to be used in any environment where it may be exposed to moisture, dust, or other contaminants. 1.1.6 The battery is not to be used in any environment where it may be exposed to extreme temperatures. 1.1.7 The battery is not to be used in any environment where it may be exposed to
