5. OPERATION

- **5.1.** Remove the injector pipes and securing bolts.
- **5.2.** Fit the two extractor base screws (item 4) in place of injector securing bolts.
- 5.3. Assemble items (1, 2 and 3), slide over the extractor base screws ensuring (item 1) is securely located in the slots in the injector.
- 5.4. Tighten the set screws (item 3) evenly while counter holding the extractor legs to remove the injector.
