# GETTING STARTED






#### CONNECTING TO ACOMPUTER



- \* Press the Reset button with a pin to reboot the tablet.

#### QI. The tablet doesn't charge.

- \* Make sure the USB cable is properly plugged into the charging port.
- \* Try another compatible USB cable and adapter.

#### Q3. Error message occurs during the operation.

- \* Uninstall the App with the error message, then download and initial again.
- \* Press the Reset button with a pin to reboot the tablet.

#### Q4. The tablet cannot be detected by the computer.

- \* Make sure the tablet is powered on.
- \* Try another USB cable.
- \* fry another LSB port on the computer.
- \* Instead of Charge only, choose Media device(MTP) or Camera(PTP) when summerting the tablet to the computer.

#### Q5. The tablet cannot connect to the Wifi.

- \* Make sure the Wiffi in your tablet is ON.
- \* Make sure you input the correct password when connecting the Wiff.
- \* Nantart the router.
- Make sure there is no filter setting or device connection limitation in the setting of the moder.
- \* Forger, the current Wife, reset the router and cannect the Will again.

#### Q6. The storage space of the tablet is not enough

- \* Delete the Appropriations use:
- \* Chear the cache of the Apps regularly.
- \* Votal a microSD card to expand the storage.

#### Q7. The screen is unvesponsive
