

**BASIC CROCHET STITCH DIAGRAM**

**1. Stitch (Abbreviated 'st')**

Bring piece of crocheted chain back to the start of the first loop. Wrap the yarn around four fingers (forming a ball) and pull the tail (yarn) through the loops. Insert the crochet hook into the second loop and gently pull the loose tail onto the crochet hook.

**2. Chain Stitch (Abbreviated 'ch')**

The chain stitch is the basis for all crochet, which is also called in continuous fashion.

**3. Slip Stitch (Abbreviated 'sl st')**

The slip stitch is the finishing or seam of all crocheted pieces. You can use this stitch by interlocking the ends of a previously crocheted ring.

**4. Single Crochet (Abbreviated 'sc')**

The single crochet is the most fundamental of all stitches. Catch the yarn with your crochet hook and draw up the loop through the stitch. Wrap the yarn around the hook and pull it through two loops, leaving one loop on the hook.

**5. Increase (Abbreviated 'inc')**

You can increase stitches by adding a stitch at the beginning of the row. Make 2 sc in the same stitch.

**6. Decrease (Abbreviated 'dec')**

You can decrease stitches, which is mostly just subtracting a stitch. In a row, make 2 sc in 1 st, then make 2 loops in the hook. Then catch a hook in the next knot, or which you see 2 loops in the hook, and finally wrap the yarn through 2 loops to finish 1 dec.

**7. Fatten off (Abbreviated 'f/o')**

Fatten off by pulling the yarn through the end stitch and pulling it taut. Cut off.

**8. Sewing**

Generally used for the connection of 2 parts. The plastic needle with a wire is threaded in turn through the loops where the two parts need to be connected.

**9. Round (Abbreviated 'Rd')**

This connects the other stitches into a circle. Each round starts with ch and ends with sl st.

**10. Magic ring**

When crocheting round without a base, make 1 magic ring first and then connect from the center. Crochet through the circle loop in the hand to pull back the last yarn, make 1 sc to form the first knot. After some rows, pull the before-given tight and off loops form a ring. Make 1 ch in the first knot to close the magic ring.

**11. Weaving in/invisible close**

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail and tape the end through the final loop on the hook and thread it onto a yarn needle. Weave your needle through the front loops only on the last round and pull tight. Secure remaining yarn into your piece.

Please note that all jumps need to be hidden between the rounds.  
Abbreviations used:  
 ch - chain  
 sl st - slip stitch  
 sc - single crochet  
 inc - increase (add)  
 dec - decrease (subtract)  
 x - repeat step a certain number of times  
 R/o - fatten off

## MAKE A GINGERBREAD

### 1. BODY

- R01: (2 sc, inc) x 6 times [18 cm]. Add f/fat/RD.  
 R02: 6 inc [12 cm].  
 R03: inc, inc x 6 times [18 cm].  
 R04: 12 sc [18 cm]. R/o.  
 R05: (Please use the white yarn) 16 sc [18 cm]. R/o.  
 R06: (Please use the white yarn) 16 sc [18 cm].  
 Please the R1 to R7 to 16 crocheted another leg. After connecting both legs, please them together and crocheted one round of single-crochet stitches to connect. Then using this method,  
 R07: 20 sc [24 cm].  
 R08: 16 sc, inc x 6 times [24 cm].  
 R09: 16 sc, inc x 6 times [24 cm].  
 R10: 15 sc, inc x 6 times [24 cm].  
 R11: 19 sc [24 cm].  
 R12: (2 sc, dec) x 6 times [24 cm].  
 R13: 20 sc [24 cm].  
 R14: (2 sc, dec) x 6 times [24 cm].  
 R15: 20 sc [24 cm].  
 R16: (2 sc, dec) x 6 times [24 cm].  
 R17: 18 sc [24 cm].  
 Please the R18 to R20.  
 R21: 17 sc, inc x 6 times [24 cm].  
 R22: (2 sc, inc) x 6 times [24 cm].  
 R23: (2 sc, inc, inc x 6 times) [30 cm].  
 R24: 16 sc, inc x 6 times [26 cm].  
 R25: 16 sc, inc x 6 times [26 cm].  
 R26: (2 sc, inc) x 6 times [24 cm].  
 R27: 16 sc, inc x 6 times [24 cm].  
 R28: 15 sc, inc x 6 times [24 cm].  
 R29: 14 sc, inc x 6 times [24 cm].

 R38: (Please use the red yarn) 6 sc [8 cm].  
 R39: 4 sc [8 cm].

- R127: (Please use the red yarn) 10 sc [10 cm]. R/o.

### 6. CANDY CANE

- R128: (Please use the blue yarn) 6 sc [10 cm]. Do not pull through or stand up before:

R129-R130: 6 sc [10 cm].

Add opposite loops!

R131: 3 dec [10 cm].

And like other crocheted complete.




### 7. SEWING

Now, the arms, buttons and bow tie onto the body. Bend the right arm, around the neck of the marshmallow and use down to hold it in place. Sew the pants over the top of the head, then sew the hat to the marsh. Finally, sew the eyes, mouth and cheeks onto the face.
