

Product Diagram





Installation instructions

Installing the dust collecting bin to the vacuum

1. Install the HEPA filter into the dust collecting bin as shown in the figure.
2. Rotate the dust collecting bin assembly counterclockwise as shown in the figure, and a "click" sound indicates the installation is successful.




Dust collection mode

1. Insert the two in one flat suction into the suction port of the host.



Blowing mode

1. According to the arrow direction as shown in the figure, install the air nozzle on the host.



Extraction mode

1. According to the arrow direction as shown in the figure, install the air extraction nozzle on the host.



Operation Instruction

Preparation Before Use

- Charge the device using a 1A-2A USB power adapter. Check the power output of the USB power adapter as this will affect charge time.
- Ensure that all parts of the wireless vacuum cleaner are properly assembled. Verify that the power is sufficient to operate the product correctly.

Charging Instructions

- Connect one end of the included USB-C charging cable to the charge port on the device and the other end to a USB power adapter.
- The red indicator light will indicate that the device is charging, and green light will remain on when it is fully charged.
- Do not operate the vacuum while it is charging.
- Fully charge the battery before first use. It should take up to 2 hours to fully charge the battery.
- For long term storage, ensure to fully charge battery.


Powering On

- Press and hold the power button until the vacuum turns on. As soon as the vacuum is on, release the power button. The vacuum toggle on.
- Press the power button once to switch to high power mode, while the vacuum is on.

Powering Off

- Press the power button once while the vacuum is in high power mode.

Battery Safety


- Always charge the Torque Pro in a well-ventilated area away from flammable materials, and on a hard, non-combustible surface such as tile or concrete.
- Always disconnect the product from the charger once the battery is fully charged. Overcharging can lead to overheating, fire, or explosion.
- Never leave the product unattended while charging. Ensure you are present during the entire charging process.
- Do not store the Torque Pro in environments where the temperature exceeds 25°C (77°F).
- Never store the Torque Pro in a car that is exposed to high temperatures or direct sunlight.
- Do not store the Torque Pro in your vehicle, even in mild conditions. Always remove the product from your car when not in use.
- Do not store the Torque Pro in enclosed spaces within the vehicle, such as the glove box or trunk, where the temperature in the enclosed space exceeds 25°C (77°F), as these areas can become extremely hot and lack ventilation.

Product disassembly and cleaning

Cleaning and maintenance:

Clean the dust collecting cup:

1. First, rotate the dust collecting cup in the direction shown in the figure and remove it from the host;



2. Take out the HEPA filter screen in the dust bin and dump the garbage into the garbage can

3. Separate the HEPA filter cover and dust collecting cup in sequence, and clean the HEPA filter cover with a brush. The dust collecting cup can be washed and dried before use.

4. To reinstall the dust bin, put the HEPA filter screen into the dust bin, and rotate and tighten it in the opposite direction according to step 1 above.
