User Manual

The remote control is used for intelligent toilet operation control, Before use, it is necessary to check the code with the receiving device on the smart toilet.

Remote Control Pair Code:Pull the plug off \rightarrow Press the stop button until the gear lights flicker \rightarrow Pull the plug in when the remote controller near the product \rightarrow The gear lights stop flicking and keep lighting \rightarrow Successful.



The functions that can be operated on the smart toilet are as follows:

Flush

Press the "flush" button to flush the product

Rear cleaning

Press the "Rear" button. The cleaning water spurts out from the front of the nozzle, cleaning the buttocks in the previous way. Press again

DRYER

Press to activate the warm air dryer.

Press again to adjust the fan speed.

NIGHT LIGHT

Press to turn the night light on/o.

Stop

To stop the function of buttocks cleaning or women washing, press" button or short press the knob button. \times hip cleaning and women's washing, with automatic stop function after

H/C massageIn

the cleaning mode, press the hot and cold massage button to realize alternating hot and cold cleaning of water temperature. \times this function can only be turned on/off for hot and cold massage during buttocks cleaning and women washing.

Nozzle Clean

Press the nozzle cleaning button, the nozzle is extended, and the cloth can be used for cleaning
