

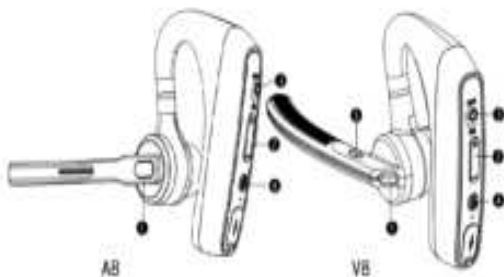

Power on/Power off

Model V8/A8, power on the headset via the specified power key ③, the led flashes blue and red alternatively and voice prompt "Power on, pairing" as pairing mod. Power off the headset, the led flashes red and voice prompt "Power off", then now the headset is in off mode.

Model P8, power on the headset via long pressing MFB key ① about 3s, the LED flashes blue and red alternatively and voice prompt "Power on, pairing" as pairing mode then waiting for connection. Power off the headset by long pressing the MFB key ① about 5s.

The headset will power off automatically if it is not being connected within 5minutes.

Pair your headset with a bluetooth mobile phone

Power on the headset and turn on your cell phone's bluetooth function and search for available bluetooth devices, select the model of your headset to connect the headset to your cell phone.

Multi-points connection

Follow the above pairing procedure to pair with the first device, turn off the Bluetooth function of the first device, repeat pairing procedure to pair with the second device, then turn on the first device's Bluetooth function. Power on the headset into standby mode, the headset will automatically recognize and connect to both devices accordingly.

Some phone may request connection manually

Charging your headset

Plug the headset to a power outlet, the LED will be red during the being charged period, and turn blue once the headset being fully charged.

Function	Operation in detail
Answer a call	Click 1 once to answer the incoming call
End the call	Click 1 once to end the call during the phone call
Reject the call	Long press 1 3s to reject the incoming call
Voice assistant	Long press 1 3s when the headset is in standby mode
Redial last call out	Double click 1 to redial last called out number
Mute microphone (V8/A8 special function)	Click 4 once to mute the mic during the phone talk, click again to resume the mic's function
Turn on/off ambient sound (V8H special function)	Click 5 to turn on the ambient sound during phone call if need, click once again to turn off the ambient sound
Play/Pause music	V8H/A8/P8, Click 1 once to pause or play music V8C/V8L, Click 5 once to pause or play music
Volume adjustment & Song tracks	Click 2 once to adjust volume during phone call or music playback, long press 2 to change song

Encendido/Apagado

Modelo V8/A8, encienda el auricular a través de la tecla de encendido especificada ❸, el LED parpadea en azul y rojo alternativamente y la voz indica "Encendido, emparejamiento" como modo de emparejamiento. Apague el auricular, el LED parpadea en rojo y la voz indica "Apagado", luego ahora el auricular está en modo apagado.

Modelo P8, encienda el auricular presionando prolongadamente la tecla MFB ❶ aproximadamente 3 s, el LED parpadea en azul y rojo alternativamente y la voz indica "Encendido, emparejamiento" como modo de emparejamiento y luego espere la conexión. Apague el auricular presionando prolongadamente la tecla MFB ❶ aproximadamente 5 s.

El auricular se apagará automáticamente si no se conecta dentro de los 5 minutos.

Empareje el auricular con un teléfono móvil con Bluetooth

Encienda el auricular y active la función Bluetooth de su teléfono celular y busque dispositivos Bluetooth disponibles, seleccione el modelo de su auricular para conectar el auricular a su teléfono celular.

Conexión multipuntos

Siga el procedimiento de emparejamiento anterior para emparejar con el primer dispositivo, apague la función Bluetooth del primer dispositivo, repita el procedimiento de emparejamiento para emparejar con el segundo dispositivo y luego encienda la función Bluetooth del primer dispositivo. Encienda los auriculares en modo de espera; los auriculares reconocerán y se conectarán automáticamente a ambos dispositivos.

Algunos teléfonos pueden solicitar la conexión manual

Carga de los auriculares

Conecte los auriculares a una toma de corriente; el LED estará rojo durante el período de carga y se volverá azul una vez que los auriculares estén completamente cargados.

Función	Funcionamiento en detalle
Responder una llamada	Haga clic en ❶ una vez para responder la llamada entrante
Finalizar la llamada	Haga clic en ❶ una vez para finalizar la llamada durante el procedimiento de llamada telefónica
Rechazar la llamada	Mantenga presionado ❶ durante 3 segundos para rechazar la llamada entrante
Asistente de voz	Mantenga presionado ❶ durante 3 segundos cuando el auricular esté en modo de espera
Volver a marcar la última llamada	Haga doble clic en ❶ para volver a marcar el último número marcado
Silenciar el micrófono (V8/A8 espeical función)	Haga clic en ❹ una vez para silenciar el micrófono durante la conversación telefónica, haga clic nuevamente para reanudar la función del micrófono
Activar/desactivar el sonido ambiente (V8H especial función)	Haga clic en ❺ para activar el sonido ambiente durante la llamada telefónica si es necesario, haga clic nuevamente para desactivar el sonido ambiente
Reproducir/Pausar música	V8H/A8/P8 , haga clic en ❶ una vez para pausar o reproducir música V8C/V8L , haga clic en ❺ una vez para pausar o reproducir música
Ajuste del volumen y pistas de canciones	Haga clic en ❷ una vez para ajustar el volumen durante una llamada telefónica o la reproducción de música, mantenga presionado ❷ para cambiar de canción
