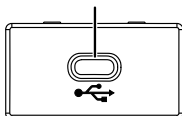
Button	Function
VOLUME 	<Press> • Touch to turn audio on/off. <Turn> • Turn to change the volume. – Turning to the right raises the volume, while turning to the left lowers it. <Press and hold> • Press and hold to turn off the screen display. – To display the screen again, touch or press any of the buttons and the screen will return to that shown before being turned off.
 *1	Touch to display the vehicle information screen.
	Touch to return to the previous screen.
	Touch to display the home screen. <When connected to Apple CarPlay or Android Auto> • Press and hold to display the app home screen.
	<When not connected to Apple CarPlay or Android Auto> • Touch to display the Phone screen if connected to a mobile phone. <When connected to Apple CarPlay or Android Auto> • Touch to display the application phone screen. • Press and hold to start application speech recognition.
 *1	<When not connected to Apple CarPlay or Android Auto> • Touch to display the Connect menu screen. <When connected to Apple CarPlay or Android Auto> • Touch to display the connected Apple CarPlay or Android Auto screen. – Touching the Apple CarPlay or Android Auto screen while it is displayed will open the Connect menu. <Press and hold> • Press and hold to display the Connect menu screen.
TUNE 	<Turn> • Move up/down the frequency 1 step. • Moves tracks/files up or down. <Press> • When audio is off: This displays the Audio menu screen. • When audio is on (when not on the audio top screen): This displays the Audio screen. • When audio is on (on the audio top screen): This displays the Audio menu screen. <Press and hold> • Press and hold to display the Audio menu screen.

Touch Switch Operation

You can operate the system using your finger on the touch screen.

» General operation

Tap

Touch to select an item on the screen.



Drag

Drag the screen to scroll it along with the movement of the finger.



Flick

Flick a finger up/down/left/right on the screen to quickly scroll the screen in that direction.

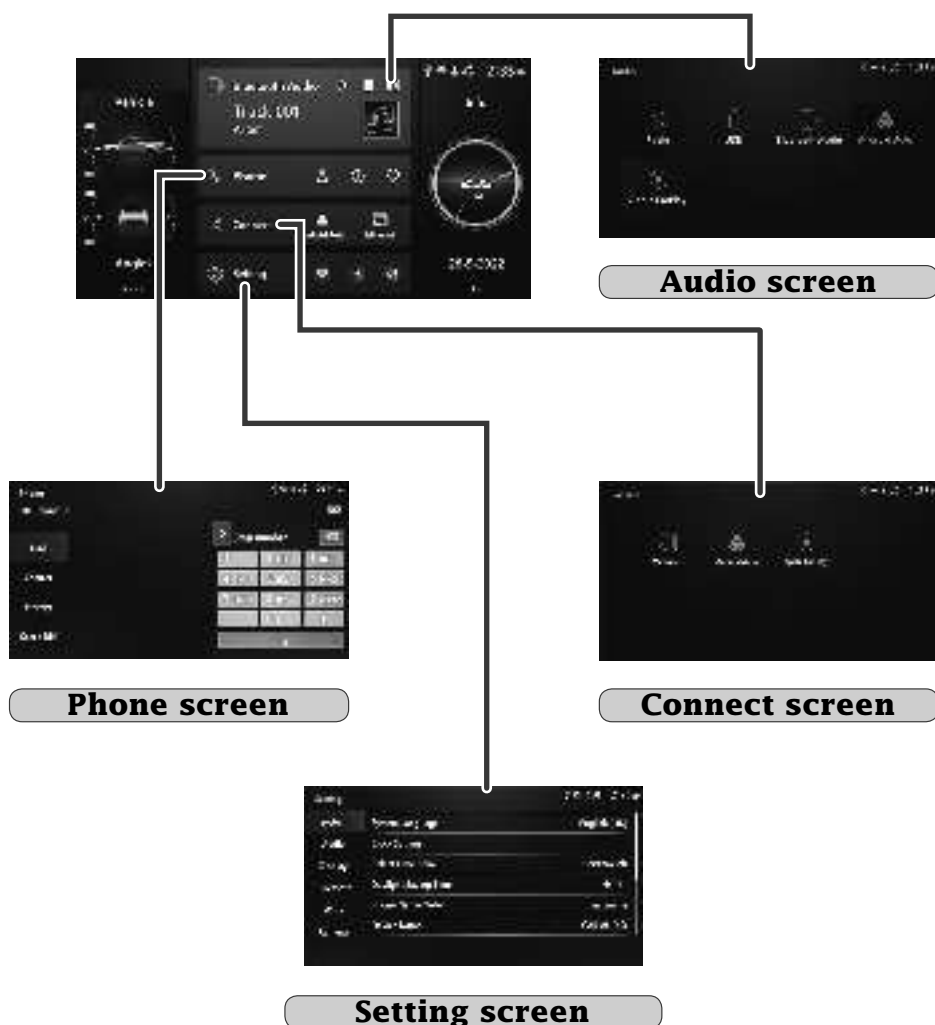

Widget	Function
Audio	• Touch when audio is on to display the audio screen. •  /  : Touch to play or pause media. •  : Touch to display the audio menu screen. • Flick to scroll up/down through presets / files.
Phone	• Touch to display the Phone menu screen. •  : Touch to display the Contact screen. •  : Touch to display the History screen. •  : Touch to display the Speed Dial screen. • If Apple CarPlay is connected, touch to display the application phone screen.
Connect	• Touch to display the Connect menu screen. •  : Touch to display the Apple CarPlay screen. •  : Touch to display the Android Auto screen. •  : Touch to display the Miracast screen.
Setting	• Touch to display the settings screen. •  : Touch to switch the Wi-Fi connection is on or off. •  : Touch to switch the Bluetooth® connection is on or off. •  : Touch to mute the audio.
Info	• Flick left or right to switch between the clock and calendar displays. • Touch to make the clock/calendar widget full screen.
Vehicle	• Flick right or left to switch to the Vehicle widget. • Touch to display the vehicle information screen.

Before Use

» Smartphone connect Menu Screen

Drag down the menu bar at the top of the home screen to display the Smartphone connect menu screen, where each source can be selected.

- 1 Drag down to open the Smartphone connect menu screen.



- 2 Drag up to close the Smartphone connect menu screen.

Widget screen

Add frequently used functions to the home screen as widgets. Widgets can be selected by flicking the clock/calendar widget or Vehicle widget to the left or right.



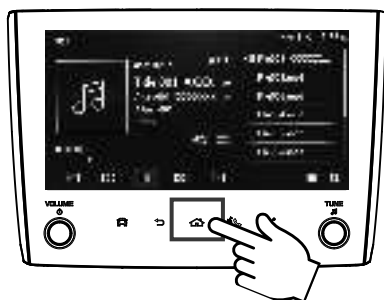

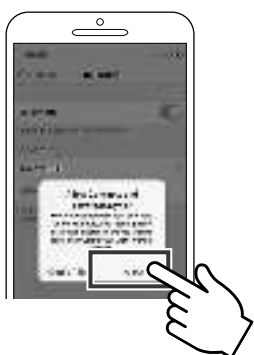

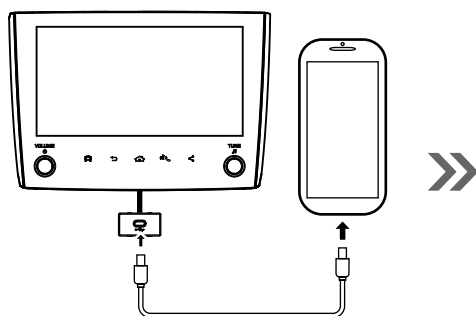
Apple CarPlay

BASIC REQUIREMENTS

- To use Apple CarPlay, you will need an iPhone 5s or above.
- For best performance, it is always recommended that your iPhone to the latest iOS version.
- You will need an Apple Lightning to USB cable or a high-quality, certified USB cable.
- Siri must be enabled to use Apple CarPlay.
- The unit will detect your iPhone. If you are first time user, follow the on-screen prompts to enable Apple CarPlay.
- If you are a first-time user, tap "Allow" on the pop-up notification displayed on your iPhone. This will allow your vehicle to access Apple CarPlay content on your iPhone without requiring you to unlock your iPhone first.

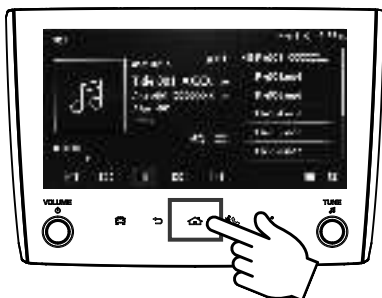

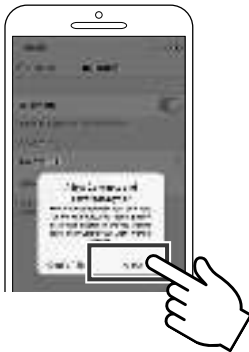

Android Auto™

BASIC REQUIREMENTS

- Make sure your vehicle is in Park. The parking brake **MUST** be engaged before getting started with setup.
- You will need a high-quality, certified USB cable for the in-vehicle connection.
- On your compatible Android phone, download and install the free Android Auto app from the Google Play Store.
- Launch the Android Auto App on your Android phone.
- Follow the on-screen instructions to complete app setup prior to connecting to your vehicle.
- For the best Android Auto experience, accept all permissions and enable notification access for Android Auto.
- Connect a USB cable to your Android phone and the USB port.
- The unit will detect your Android phone. If you are a first-time user, follow the on-screen prompts to enable Android Auto (you may need to refer to your Android phone to continue setup).

NOTE

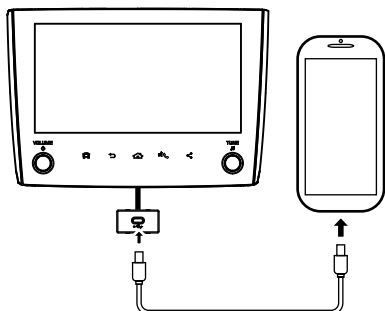
- When connecting for the first time, connection may fail if the date and time on the unit and the Android smartphone are different. Check the date and time settings on your Android smartphone and try again.
- The Android Auto may be displayed instead of the connected menu when a Android smartphone is connected.
- For devices that have been connected to Android Auto with a Wireless connection once, turning ACC OFF/ON while using Android Auto with a USB connection may result in a Wireless Android Auto connection.
