### 2.1 Main Parts and Accessories



- 1. Ensure the vacuum is fully charged.
- Remove the water tank by pressing down the release button and pulling the tank out.
- 3. Fill the Clean Water Tank with clean water, and add a gentle detergent if necessary.
- 4. Insert the water tank back onto the vacuum and ensure it is secured.
- 5. Press the Power button to turn on the vacuum. A blue light will turn on.
- 6. To use water while cleaning, press and hold the Water Spray Button to spray water out of the top of the vacuum.
- 7. Press the Power button to turn the vacuum off. The blue light will turn off.

#### Charging The Vacuum

- Plug one end of the included charging cable into the charging port on the vacuum, and the other end into an AC outlet.
- The indicator lights will flash green while the vacuum is charging, indicating
  the vacuum's power. 1 light indicates 30%, 2 lights indicate 60%, and 3 lights
  indicate 100%.
- The indicator lights will turn solid green once the vacuum is fully charged, then turn off after 30 minutes.
- The green LED lights will indicate the battery percentage while the vacuum is in use. The last indicator light will flash red when the battery is low.



#### 3.1 Cleaning the Dirty Water Tank


- When the Dirty Water Tank reaches maximum capacity, remove it from the vacuum by pressing down on the release button and pulling it out.
- 2. Empty the Dirty Water Tank and rinse it with clean water if necessary.
- 3. Reinstall the Dirty Water Tank back onto the vacuum.

Note: Keep the Dirty Water Tank vertical to prevent water from spilling.

#### 3.2 Cleaning the Suction Cover

- Press the buttons on both sides of the suction cover, then pull the cover down and outwords to remove it.
- Rinse the suction cover and dry it with a soft cloth, then reinstall it back onto the vacuum.

**Note:** Clean the suction cover as soon as you notice any stains to keep the suction opening unclogged.



#### Important Safeguards

- Do not tilt or hold the vacuum upside down if there is water in the Dirty Water Tank, as this will cause dirty water to overflow from the air outlet.
- When pointing the vacuum downwards, ensure that the dirty water does not exceed the tank's indicated water level. Remove any excess water to prevent dirty water from overflowing from the air outlet.
- · Do not immerse this vacuum in water or any other liquid.
- · Do not touch the vacuum with wet hands,
- Do not expose the vacuum to outdoor weather conditions, heat sources, direct sunlight, humidity, or sharp edges.
- The vacuum should not be used by children or persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities.
- · Keep hair, clothing, and body parts away from the suction opening during use.
- Do not attempt to alter, fix, or disassemble this unit. If this unit is damaged or malfunctioning, contact Customer Service or a qualified electrician.
- · Do not operate the vacuum without the water tank properly in place.
- Do not insert anything into any opening on the vacuum or use the vacuum if an opening is blocked.
- $\cdot$  Do not pick up flammable or toxic objects with the vacuum, such as ammonia, chlorine, bleach, lighter fluid, gasoline, kerosene, etc.
- Do not pick up hard or sharp objects with the vacuum, such as glass, nails, screws, etc.
- · Only store the vacuum and its accessories in a dry, cool place.
