
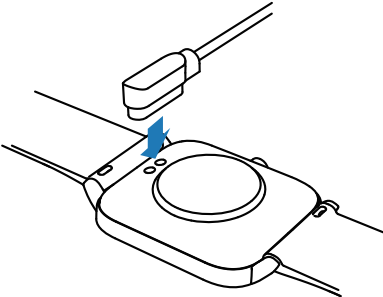

Please read this Manual carefully before use.</div>	<div>Downloading the App</div> <div>Scan the following QR code, download and install the App.</div> <div></div> <div>Scan QR Code and Download</div>	<div>Charging and Active</div> <div>Charging the device to active before the first time using; To charge your device, plug the charging cable into the adaptor or USB port on your computer.</div> <div></div>	<div>Pairing</div> <div>Open the App and set up your profile</div> <div>Go to the 「Device」, Click 「Add a Device」</div> <div>Choose your device on the scanning list</div> <div>Finish</div> <div>The MAC address on the “Setting”-“About” page could help you identify your device on the scanning list.</div>	<div>Smart Watch Features</div> <div><div>Sleep</div><div>If you keep wearing Smart Watch in your sleep, it can provide the hours slept and quality of sleep stats on both the screen and the APP. NOTE: Sleep stats reset to zero at 8:00 pm.</div></div> <div><div>Heart Rate Test</div><div>The Smart Watch could record your heart rate all day. You also could tap on the page to start measuring heart rate.</div></div> <div><div>Sports</div><div>Smart Watch automatically tracks Steps taken on the screen. NOTE: Your movement stats reset to zero at midnight.</div></div> <div><div>Training</div><div>Tap the training icon on the menu to start a new training measure recording, there are 123 sport modes to be chosen. The last training recording will be shown on the training page.</div></div>	<div><div>Blood Pressure Test</div><div>Tap on the blood pressure page to start measuring your blood pressure. On the blood pressure page, It can show the blood pressure measured data of the last times.</div></div> <div><div>SpO2 Test</div><div>Tap the SpO2 page to start measuring your SpO2. On the SpO2 page, It can show the SpO2 measured data of the last times.</div></div> <div><div>Weather</div><div>It could show the weather info of current and tomorrow on the weather page. Weather info is synced after connecting with the APP, it will not be updated after a long disconnected.</div></div> <div><div>Messages Reminder</div><div>The device can sync incoming notifications from Twitter, Facebook, Whatsapp, Instagram etc. Recently 5 messages can be stored. Note: You can switch on/off the incoming notification in the APP.</div></div>	<div><div>Remote Shutter</div><div>After connecting the device, youcan remote contral the camera on your phone.</div></div> <div><div>Player Shutter</div><div>After connecting the device, you can remote contral the music player on your phone.</div></div> <div><div>Other Features</div><div>Other features include stopwatch, alarm, timer, brightness, mute on/off, theater mode, factory reset, power off and about.</div></div> <div><div>Stop Watch</div><div>Tap the start button on stopwatch page to start timing, and tap the stop button to stop timing.</div></div> <div><div>Silent Alarms</div><div>Set up the alarm on the APP, the device will vibrate to remind on time.</div></div> <div><div>Remind to Drink</div><div>The smart watch will remind you “Time to Drink Some Water” at theplanned drinking time.</div></div>	<div>Note: You can set the feature in the APP.</div> <div><div>Remind to Move</div><div>The device will vibrate to remind you to make a relax after 1 hour sitting. Note: You can switch on/off the feature in the APP.</div></div> <div>Getting to Know Your Device</div> <div><div>1.Using in Wet Conditions</div><div>Your device is water-resistant, which means it is rain-proof and splash-proof and can stand up to even the sweatiest workout. NOTE: Do not swim with your Smart Bracelet. We also don't recommend showering with your wristband; though the water won't hurt the device, wearing it 24/7 does not give your skin a chance to breathe.
