

Indicator Lights Description



① Power Indicator:

- Unfold the keyboard: it will light in green color for several seconds and then turns off.
- Low battery capacity: When the keyboard is in low battery capacity, it will flash in red color to remind you to charge it.
- Charging: stably on in red color
 Fully Charged: automatically turns off
- Battery capacity display: Press "Fn + | weys, it flashes in green color. Every flash represents 25% battery power (total 4 times flashes, 100% remaining battery power).
- ② Status Indicator:

Press "Fn + 8" keys to pair the keyboard with your Bluetooth-enabled

Pairing: quick flash in blue color

Successfully Paired: automatically turns off

(3) Caps Lock Indicator:

Press Caps Lock key to switch capital and small letters. Inputting Capital Letters: lit in blue color

Inputting Small Letters: automatically turns off

(For Android users, the Caps Lock indicator may not appear, but the Caps Lock function is still activated as per normal.)



- Two working conditions: Bluetooth wireless connection and USB wired connection
- 2. After connecting to the USB port, you can freely switch between BT connection and wired connection by pressing Fn + or Fn + ψ . That is to say, one of them is in activated status while the other is in standby status. 3. When unfold the keyboard, it is the same size with ordinary laptop keyboard, easy and comfort typing experience.

4. With two foot stands on both side to keep balance and stable when typing.



Backlit Function

Press "Fn +*" key to turn on/off backlit function

1st time press to turn on backlit


2nd time press to increase backlit brightness

a.Bluetooth Wireless Connection

Step 1. Unfold the keyboard to power on it.

Step 2. Press "Fn + " keys to enjoy wireless technology lifestyle.

Step 3. Press "Fn + §" keys, the Status Indicator will flash in blue color to enter pairing mode.

Step 4. Activate the Bluetooth function of your device and search other Bluetooth devices. Find the keyboard name (iClever IC-BK05 Keyboard) and click to connect them.

Note:

1.If the pairing process is failed, please retry the above steps until success - ful pairing.

2. Only one device can be actively paired at one time.

3.For other Bluetooth-enabled device, please verify the Bluetooth version and compatibility before attempting to connect to the keyboard.

4.After pairing for the first time, your device will connect to the keyboard automatically when powering on the keyboard next time.

b.USB Wired Connection

Step 1. Unfold the keyboard to power on it.

Step 2. Plug the provided Micro USB cable into this keyboard and connect the other end to your device.

Step 3. Press "Fn $+\psi$ " keys to successfully connect them, then you can enjoy your wired technology lifestyle.

Switching the keyboard's language

ver Saving Mode

The keyboard will enter sleep mode after being idle for 30 minutes.

To activate it, press any key and wait for 3 seconds.

How to Charge it

Use the included USB cable for charging. Connect one end to a USB charger, and the other to the keyboard. (USB charger is not included)
 In charging, the power indicator will turn red. Generally, it takes

approximately 4 hours for a full charge. (Output: DC 5V/500mA)

If you are unable to connect the keyboard to your tablet, please try the following:

1. Starting with a full charge on both devices ensures that process won't be

- interrupted by a low battery.
- Check your tablet's Bluetooth is on.
- 3. Make sure that the keyboard is within the effective operation distance of 33 feet (10 M).

- Keep the keyboard away from sharp objects that could damage it.
