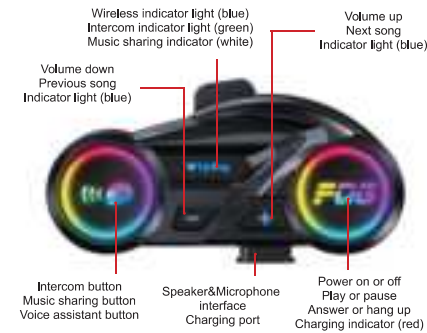


Product Overview

If there is a big difference in sound effect and volume after installing into the helmet, please adjust the position of the speaker inside the helmet.

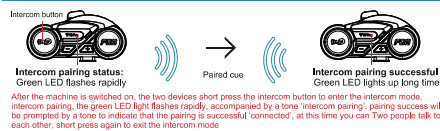

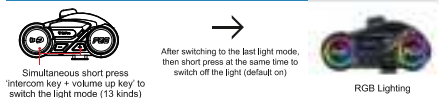

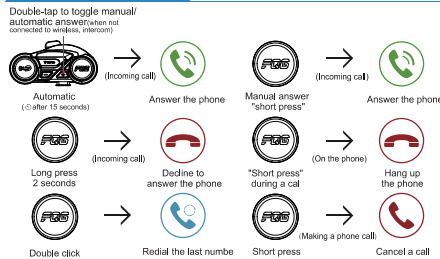

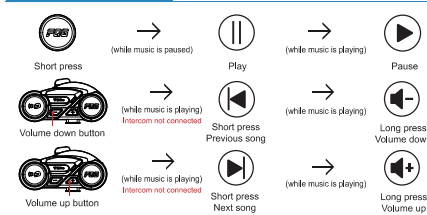

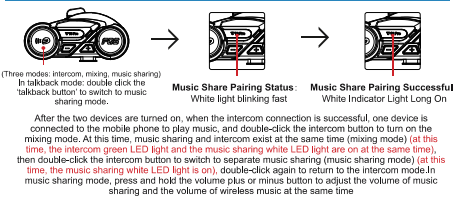

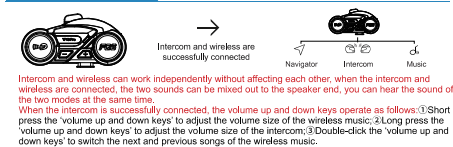

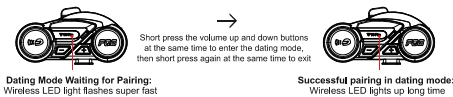
Music Sharing Pairing/Intercom and Music Sharing Coexistence



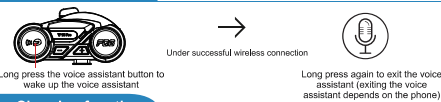
Mixing function



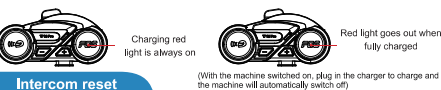

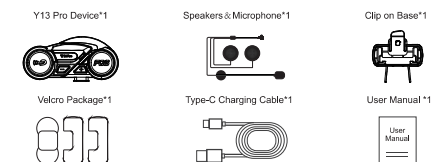

Introduction to wireless intercom connection operation (intercom and music sharing are switched off by default every time you switch on the computer)
I. Intercom back to connect: When the connected machines are switched on, short press the intercom key to enter intercom mode, and short press the corresponding pairing key on the hat to connect back to the other corresponding machines.
II. Phone Priority: After the machine is switched on and the machine is connected to the wireless, no matter which mode the machine is in, when the machine is calling or going to the phone, it will take priority to enter the phone mode automatically and resume the corresponding mode after hanging up.
III. Clear wireless pairing, restore factory settings: Clear wireless pairing information: power on without connecting wireless and intercom, long press the volume down and volume up buttons at the same time for 5S, clear the wireless pairing information, the indicator light flashes fast.
