




Safety Warning:

*Tips: To switch between different modes of adjusting the volume with the microphone's +/- buttons, double-click the power button and you will hear a "beep" sound from the speaker. In mode ①, you can adjust the microphone volume by pressing the +/- buttons briefly. Double-click the power button again to enter mode ②, where you can adjust the ECHO reverb effect by pressing the +/- buttons briefly. Double-click the power button once more to enter mode ③, where you can adjust the speaker volume by pressing the +/- buttons briefly.

11----Type-C Charging Port: input DC 5V/1A

12-TF Card Port: up to 32GB

13-USB Port: USB2.0 drives up to 32GB

14----AUX-in jack: 3.5mm audio jack

FEATURES

1.Bluetooth®Connection

- Step 1. Press and hold the power button to turn on/off the device. The blue light will flash, and the speaker will enter the waiting-for-connection mode.
- Step 2. Activate Bluetooth® on your phone or other electronic devices, search for "K26" and click to connect.
- Step 3. The speaker will emit a sound to indicate a successful connection, and the blue light will stay on. If no device is connected, the blue light will continue flashing.
- Step 4. Pairing is successful.

2.TF Card

Play music or audio from a TF card, supports cards up to 32GB. Supported formats: MP3/WAV.

3.USB Flash Drive

Play music or audio from a USB flash drive (U disk), supports drives up to 32GB. Supported formats: MP3/WAV.

4.3.5mm AUX-in Jack

Can be used to connect headphones, microphones, and other audio devices.

5.Type-C Charging Port

Charging with a DC 5V/1A adapter (power adapter not included with the device). Charging process indicated by a steady red light, and the light goes off when fully charged.

6.Auto Shutdown

Automatically turns off after 10 minutes of music pause or no button operation.

FAQ

- Q: How do I connect the wireless microphone to the speaker via Bluetooth®?
- A: Turn on both the microphone and speaker. On your phone/tablet Bluetooth®settings, select the device name starting with "T39" to pair with the speaker. The microphone will connect automatically.
- Q: Can I use the karaoke machine without the pre-loaded songs on the SD card?
- A: Yes, you can use the wireless microphones with just the speaker itself, without background music if desired.
- Q: How do I control the volume of the microphone and speaker separately?
- A: Press the microphone button to cycle to the microphone or speaker volume mode. Then use the + and - buttons to adjust each volume independently.
- Q: Is there an echo effect on the microphones, and can I remove it?
- A: Yes, there is an echo effect that can be removed by long pressing the microphone button for 2-3 seconds.
- Q: What is the warranty period for the karaoke machine set?
- A: The product comes with a 1-year manufacturer's warranty. You can contact our support for any issues within that period.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- If the indicator light doesn't come on after powering on, please check if the speaker has sufficient battery power, or connect the speaker to a 5V/1A power source for charging. Charging time takes approximately 3-4 hours.
- If the microphone has no sound, it could be due to the power not being turned on, incorrect mode selection, or the volume not being adjusted. Please adjust the microphone volume.
- If there's no reverb from the speaker, it might be because the reverb switch is turned off. Please turn on the reverb switch.
- 4. If there's noise in the microphone, it could be due to environmental noise, signal interference, or the microphone being too close to the speaker. Please readjust the microphone's orientation.
- 5. If Bluetooth[®] playback is interrupted, it might be due to the Bluetooth[®] distance being too far, or obstacles between the phone and the speaker affecting signal transmission. Please stay close to the connected phone and avoid obstacles.
- 6. If Bluetooth[®]can't connect, it might be due to being too far away, obstacles, or another phone already being connected. Please approach the phone, avoid obstacles, and disconnect previously connected phones.
- If charging is not possible, check if the charger is functioning properly. During charging, the red indicator light at the charging port should be lit.
