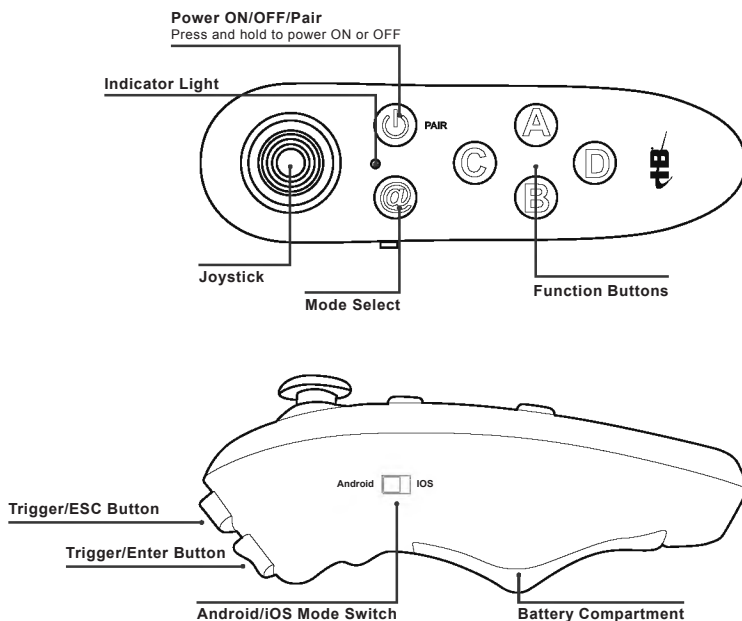

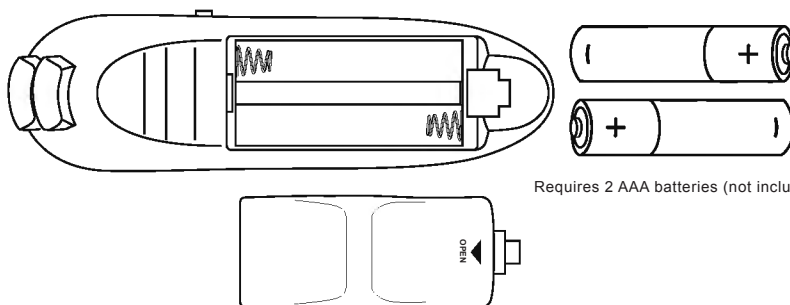
Features

Power and Pairing

- Press and hold the **Power/Pair button** to power ON and begin pairing. The indicator will flash blue. On your phone's Bluetooth setting, select **VR BOX** from the list of available options to pair. After pairing, the indicator will slowly flash blue.
- Press and hold **Power/Pair button** for 5 seconds to power OFF.
- Once paired, press and hold the **Power/Pair button**. The remote will power ON and automatically reconnect to your phone.
- Press and hold **Power/Pair button** for 3 seconds to unpair your phone.

Operation

Note: Not all phones or operating systems are supported. Apple iOS features are limited to volume, mute, camera and home functions.
