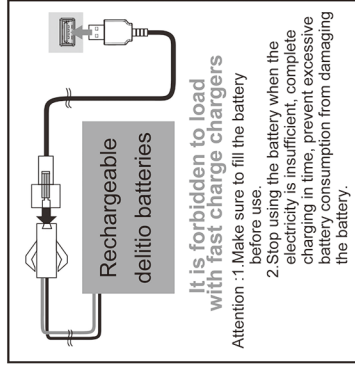

(THE FOLLOWING IMAGE ONLY SHOWS SOME CRYSTAL BALLS)

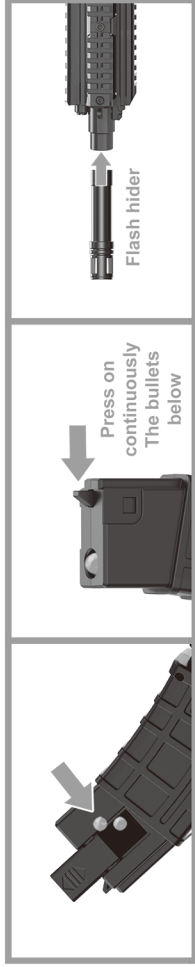


A glass of 180
ml of water

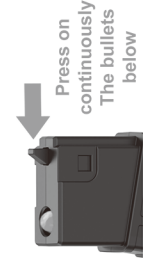
Pour the crystal ball into

diameter.

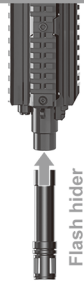
