# **Hotkey Commands**

Hotkey commands are keystroke sequences that initiate computer/device functions and can be used to initiate KVM Switch functions. A hotkey command sequence must be initiated by the Hotkey Leading Code, followed by 1-2 additional keystrokes. Successful hotkey command inputs result in a high-pitch beep. Unsuccessful hotkey command inputs result in a low-pitched beep.

#### Notes:

- All keystroke combinations must be entered in rapid succession.
- Press and release the indicated keys, unless otherwise specified.

## **Hotkey Leading Code**

<b>Hotkey Command</b>	Function		
Scroll + Scroll + 1	<ul> <li>Select PC 1</li> <li>This hotkey sequence switches both monitors, mouse, keyboard, and the audio device.</li> </ul>	1A	1B
Scroll + Scroll + 2	<ul> <li>Select PC 2</li> <li>This hotkey sequence switches both monitors, mouse, keyboard, and the audio device.</li> </ul>	2 <u>A</u>	<u>2B</u>

## **Dual View**

Dual view is the ability to view one screen from each connected computer, and switch the keyboard, mouse, and audio device between the currently selected displays using hotkeys.

<b>Hotkey Command</b>	Function	
*Must use right side Alt key	Switch mouse and keyboard between computers when in Dual View modes	<r.alt>, <r.alt></r.alt></r.alt>
Scroll + Scroll + 3	• Puts the KVM displays into 1A + 2A	1A 2A
Scroll Lock + 4	Puts the KVM     displays into     2A + 1A	2A 1A
Scroll   + Scroll   + 5	• Puts the KVM displays into 1A + 2B	1A 2B
Scroll   + Scroll   + 6	Puts the KVM     displays into     2A + 1B	2A 1B
