




⚠ DANGERS:

To reduce the risk of electrocution:

- Do not plug this device into a voltage system which is different from specific voltage range.
- ◆ Do not use if you have trauma on your tongue or in your mouth.
- If you are in dental treatment, you should consult your dentist before using this instrument.
- ◆ Do not direct water flow under the tongue, into the ear, nose or other delicate organs.
- It's normal phenomenon that caused gum bleeding for the first time use. It is recommended to start from a lower pressure level.
- Never be left unattended when plugged in.Close supervision is necessary when it used by, on, or near children or invalids.

Product Description





Standard Tips: For teeth daily cleaning, ultra-fine pulsed water flow, it massages gums and get all the food particles out of your teeth.

Periodontal Tip: Deeply rinsing into the interdental fissure and subgingival site. Relieve periodontitis, gingivitis, teeth shrinking, reduce the thickness of pocket.

Orthodontic Tip: Suitable for the person with the false tooth, wearing orthotics, dental braces, teeth socket. It removes hard-to-reach plaque around orthodontic brackets and wires.

Dental Plaque Tip: For implants, dental bridge, false tooth crowns. It has 4 thin tufts of bristles to access stubborn plaque around implants, crowns, bridges and other areas.

Instruction for the modes



Soft: for people who have sensitive teeth and first-time-user. Pressure range: 20-50 PSI.



Medium: for daily cleaning. Pressure range: 50-80 PSI



Strong: for deep cleaning. Pressure range: 70-110 PSI

Pulse: massage for your teeth and gum. Pressure range: 70-100PSI



DIY Mode: Customize the water pressure / speed as you need. Long press the "Mode" button to enter the DIY mode, water pressure will change from min to max with pattern in OLED display. Press the "Mode" button again to choose the water pressure as you need. Pressure range: 8-110 PSI.



Operating Procedures

Usage instruction

Please ensure the machine is fully charged battery before first time usage, do not use it while charging.




Installation and Disassembly of Jet Tip

Press the release button and insert the nozzle into spray head hold until you hear a "click" ring.





Open the water tank lid and fill with the water in it. The choose the mode which suitable for you.





Operating Step

- ◆ Press the mode button continuously, the mode switches among the sequence: SOFT-MEDIUM-STRONG-PULSE-DIY;This device has a memory function. So in the off state, you can also select the mode suitable for the user and then turn it on again.
- ◆ Irrespective of the mode, after operating for 120 seconds the product will automatically switch off.
- ♦ When power is insufficient, the indicated light will flash until power off. During charging, this product cannot be used.
- ◆ The charger is suitable for: AC 100-240VAC, 50/60Hz, output 5V === 1A
- Keep the device vertical for the best effect, rotate the jet tip dial in order to adjust the direction of the water flow.
- ◆ It's normal phenomenon that caused gum bleeding for the first time use. It is recommended to start from a lower pressure level.




Recommended Techniques

Holding the device at downward, aim the jet tip to the teeth by rotating the tip base before switching on the device.




When the water flow and the gums are at a 90 degree angle, slightly close your mouth in order to avoid the water spraying out. In order to achieve the best results. Please start from molar area to the incisors. Slide the water flow along the gums, as well as stay a while between teeth, until the area around the gums and the spaces between the teeth are fully cleaned.

Please switch off the power, as well as empty the water tank.



Battery Maintenance And Handling

Battery Maintenance

Prior to initial usage the device must to be fully charged, for approximately 4 hours. If to be store for a long-period of time, please fully charge the device in advance. In order to maximize the usage life of the battery, please promptly recharge when power is insufficient.

Battery Handling

The device includes a lithium battery which cannot be changed. At the end of the battery life, please dispose in a local recycling centre.


Comment Problems and solutions

Malfunction	Cause	Handling method
Water leakage between the jet tip and screw part.	1.The jet tip cannot be installed properly. 2.The seal ring socket of the jet tip is damaged.	1.Insert the jet tip into the screw part until you hear a clicking sound. 2.Contact the retailer for repair and install the jet tip properly
Inadequate pressure	Seal ring is loose or damaged	Replace the seal ring
Inadequate pressure	Low voltage usage	Use after charging
Device cannot be switched on	Low voltage usage	Use after charging
Device is not spraying water	Filtration net is clogged	Wet and clean the Filtration net
Water tank sides are leaking water	Air entry hole is producing water	Standard phenomenon high air pressure principle
