Getting Started

The Purple Humper is a mid-boost pedal kit that captures the magic of a rare BJFE model. It's perfect for learning the ropes of pedal building while achieving that legendary mid-range tone.

This kit is powered by a standard 9V DC center-negative adapter (One Control EPA-2000/RPA-1000 recommended). Batteries are not supported.

Purple Humper - What's It All About?

Every guitar hero knows the importance of mid-range. Whether you're taming the high-end snarl of a Strat or pushing a clean transistor amp into vintage territory, mid-boosters have been the secret sauce since the days of 1960s British amps.

The original BJFE Purple Humper was designed to push a 60s Stratocaster up to ES-335 output levels, letting you dial in a richer, more powerful tone no matter what pickups you use. One Control's version pays tribute to this rare pedal, capturing that sweet spot between a warm buffer and a powerful mid-boost.

Unlike many mid-boost pedals, the Purple Humper doesn't just slam your signal with a honky boost. Instead, it preserves your guitar's natural tone while adding a warm, dynamic mid-range that instantly gives any amp a vintage British voice. Even a sterile solid-state amp comes alive with classic rock mojo.

Use it as a preamp, a solo booster, or to add character to your dirt pedals. It plays nice with everything from single coils to humbuckers, P-90s to actives, always finding that sweet spot without killing your tone.

Controls and Connections

- · INPUT: Connect your guitar or bass here.
- · OUTPUT: Connect to your amplifier.
- BLEND: Adjusts the amount of mid-range boost. Turn left for a subtle lift, or right for full-on mid-saturation (up to 15dB of boost).
- DC INPUT: Plug in a standard 9V DC adapter with center-negative polarity (6 to 18V supported).

How to Use It

- 1. Set the BLEND knob to your preferred level of mid-
- If the knob is on the left of center, try placing distortion pedals before the Purple Humper.
- 3. If it's on the right, try putting it after distortion.
- Experiment with your guitar and amp to find your ideal sound.

When using Purple Humper with distortion, the order in your pedal chain matters — try different setups to find your personal sweet spot. Start clean, then add grit to

With its powerful yet balanced boost, the Purple Humper is perfect as a lead booster or to sweeten up any amp that's too bright. You'll get that rich, dynamic mid-range that makes you want to play all night. Try it at 18v for added headroom
