- Installation location selection: you should choose a flat, solid ground in the courtyard, avoid installing on sloping or loose soil, so as not to cause the sun umbrella to tip over due to the instability of the base.
- Daily Cleaning

Umbrella Cleaning: Use mild soapy water and a soft bristle brush to gently brush the surface of the umbrella to remove dust, stains and so on. Do not use strong acidic or alkaline cleaners to avoid damaging the umbrella surface material.

Umbrella pole and bone cleaning: You can use a damp cloth to wipe the pole and bone to remove surface dirt. If you encounter stains that are difficult to clean, you can use an appropriate amount of cleaner, but be careful to dry them in time.

Regular maintenance

Checking the connecting parts: Users are advised to check the connecting parts of the parasol regularly, such as whether the screws and nuts are loose. If found loose, tighten them with a spanner in time to ensure the structural stability of the sun umbrella.

Anti-rust treatment: For metal parts that are prone to rust, such as umbrella poles and umbrella bones, you can apply anti-rust oil regularly to prevent rust from affecting normal use

Seasonal Maintenance

At the time of seasonal change, for example, before the onset of winter, it is recommended that the user carries out a comprehensive cleaning and maintenance of the sun umbrella, and then store it appropriately. For example, put the sun umbrella away, clean it, and store it in a dust cover in a dry, ventilated place to avoid damage caused by long-term exposure to humidity.

a Safety Precautions

Weather Conditions: Do not use the parasol in bad weather conditions (e.g., high winds, heavy rains, thunder and lightning, etc.) to avoid the parasol being blown over, damaged, or even causing injury. Users are advised to put the parasol away and fix it in time when encountering windy weather.

In thunderstorms, do not stand under the parasol as the metal pole may conduct electricity and increase the risk of being struck by lightning.

Age limit for use: Be aware of the age limit for the use of sun umbrellas, especially for families with small children. Children need to be supervised by an adult when using the parasol to avoid safety accidents caused by children climbing on the parasol.
