How to upgrade firmware manually on my DWR-900V 5G Mobile Hotspot?

- 1 Visit the D-Link support page and select your country at https://support.dlink.com/globaldirectory.aspx. Look for the latest firmware version of your specific device model and download the file on your computer.
- 2 Connect your PC to the DWR-900V Mobile Hotspot either via Wi-Fi or using a Type C cable.


Note: To avoid disruption during the firmware upgrade, it is advised that you use a wired connection

- 3 Once connected to your DWR-900V mobile hotspot, open a web browser. (Such as Google Chrome, Firefox, or Safari)
- 4 In the address bar of the web browser, type the default IP address of the DWR-900V which is 192.168.1.1, and then press Enter.
- You will be prompted to enter the username and password to access the router's settings. The default username and password are both "admin" unless you have changed them previously.

Note: If you have changed the password and cannot remember it, you will need to reset the router to factory defaults.



6 Go to More tab, then choose **Update** from the left side menu.



7 Click on "Please add upgrade package file" and select the firmware file from your computer. (file format .bin) then Click on "Local Upgrade" to begin the firmware update process.
