

# 1 Stand Setup

Lift the TV out of the box using the plastic bag' covering the TV. Support the TV evenly on both sides while laying it on a padded, flat surface that is larger than the TV.


Install the stand feet' or a wall mount" (not included) according to the image below. When the stand legs are properly connected, the legs will not shift or move.

Plug the TV power cord into a wall outlet.
