SYMMETRICAL AWD

Strike a balance, get a grip, take control. For over three decades, this has been the core philosophy that has led to the development of every Subaru vehicle. In that time, our engineers have perfected a combination unique to the industry: the SUBARU BOXER engine and the totally linear drivetrain layout called the Subaru symmetrical full-time All-Wheel Drive (AWD) system. In this layout, all drivetrain components – the engine, transmission, driveshaft, and front and rear differentials – are logically aligned close to the centre point of the vehicle. This gives every Subaru heightened stability and ideal weight distribution, front to rear and side to side. Why is symmetrical full-time All-Wheel Drive a better solution? Simply: balance, grip, control.

SUBARU BOXER



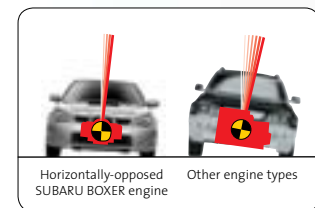
The horizontally-opposed engine, also known as the *boxer*, earned its nickname because its pistons move like a prize-fighter, alternately throwing left and right punches on a horizontal plane. The motion of the right bank of pistons counteracts that of the left bank, thereby balancing each other out and reducing engine

vibration. With respect to the SUBARU BOXER, this intrinsically smooth design is also more compact and sits lower in the engine compartment. Net benefits: seamless power delivery and a lower centre of gravity, which helps the AWD and suspension systems operate at peak efficiency. To further enhance durability, handling and directional stability, every SUBARU BOXER engine is constructed of lightweight, high-strength aluminum.

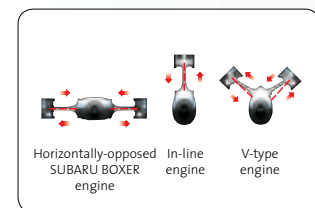

They are the stage upon which the SUBARU BOXER engines get to shine and, of course, the quickest path leading back to all those glorious corners again.

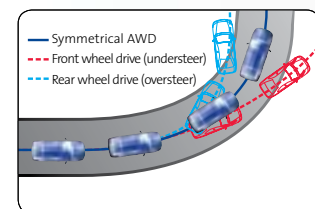
Better balance

During cornering, centrifugal force causes a vehicle to lean; how much depends in part on the vehicle's centre of gravity. Due to the placement of its compact SUBARU BOXER engine, each Subaru vehicle has an exceptionally low centre of gravity. This helps improve handling and stability, while reducing body roll, without having to resort to an overly stiff suspension.



Less vibration

With its 180° configuration, the SUBARU BOXER engine dramatically cuts down on vibration by eliminating the inertia of opposing pistons that exists in V-shaped or in-line configuration engines. The result is smooth, seamless power right through the rev range as well as unprecedented driving comfort.



More traction

Subaru's symmetrical full-time AWD has distinct traction advantages – especially when cornering. When power is sent to just two wheels, lateral forces tend to make a vehicle understeer or oversteer, which can lead to instability. With the Subaru system, power is sent through all four wheels and the vehicle steers more neutrally in the direction of the bend, thereby ensuring precise, controlled handling.





Pure unadulterated power.

Innovative thinking: the driving force behind every Subaru engine. Total driving enjoyment

The 2007 Impreza line-up is offered with three different engines, depending on the model chosen. The Impreza 2.5i and 2.5i Special Edition are powered by a 2.5-litre SOHC SUBARU BOXER engine that delivers a broad power band for quick acceleration and maximum efficiency. The WRX, meanwhile, uses a 2.5-litre DOHC turbocharged and intercooled SUBARU BOXER engine that incorporates technologies developed through years of success in rally competition. Finally, under the hood scoop of the WRX STI, you will find a 2.5-litre DOHC turbocharged and intercooled high-performance SUBARU BOXER engine that gives exotic cars a run for their money.

A shift in thinking about traction.

Power is one thing. Having the ability to transmit that power to the ground as efficiently as possible is another story altogether. Here's the Subaru story: the transmission, front differential and transfer case are combined together into one simple unit mounted symmetrically along the centreline of the vehicle. This compact design allows for linear, controllable, full-time power to be delivered to all four wheels simultaneously. Power created by the SUBARU BOXER engine, therefore, is not wasted – it's moving the vehicle forward through the technologically superior transmission and via the symmetrical full-time AWD system. The end result: optimum traction and control.

Subaru 5-speed Manual Transmission (5MT)

In automatic mode, DCCD distributes torque from 41/59 (front/rear) split to a full 50/50 (front/rear) ratio delivering optimum traction and stability; in manual mode, the driver selects among six settings between 50/50 and 41/59 (front/rear)
- Advanced symmetrical full-time AWD system includes a helical-type limited-slip front differential and a TORSSEN® limited-slip rear differential working together to meet the increased traction demands of a high-performance vehicle, while maintaining smooth cornering and acceleration characteristics.

Built for speed, tuned for handling.

The benefits of a balanced, symmetrical drivetrain are both numerous and substantial. In the Subaru Impreza, this layout provides the perfect foundation for a 4-wheel fully independent suspension system that delivers precise handling and incredible stability without sacrificing ride quality. The long, equal-length axle shafts allow for maximum suspension travel, superior balance at all four wheels and maximum contact between the tires and the road, even when the road surface changes. The suspension is further tuned to virtually eliminate torque steer and create superior driving dynamics that allow the Impreza's sporty nature to show through.

Lightweight construction, heavyweight strength

The engineers at Subaru have taken a merciless approach to reducing the Impreza's weight without impacting body strength or rigidity. This campaign has led to the extensive use of aluminum, high tensile strength steel and sophisticated production methods, such as hydroforming and tailored blank laser welding. The end result is a surprisingly light and nimble line of sedans and sport wagons that, nevertheless, offer significant passenger safety and security.

Performance-minded suspension system

The lightweight and rugged chassis of the Subaru Impreza has enabled engineers to calibrate the suspension to provide ideal levels of control and agility. The suspension geometry and damper settings are designed to work beautifully whether the vehicle is relatively empty or fully loaded. Further enhanced by stabilizer bars front and rear, this sport-tuned suspension system has been rigorously tested to ensure durability under even the most demanding driving conditions.

The WRX STI goes one step further, utilizing an inverted, strut-type suspension specially tuned by the engineers at Subaru Tecnica International (STI). To allow this incredible AWD system to operate at peak performance, the suspension features stabilizer bars, a front cross-member stiffener bar, rear cross-member stiffener plates and rear aluminum lateral links. These measures enable the WRX STI to put the power to the ground – and keep it there.

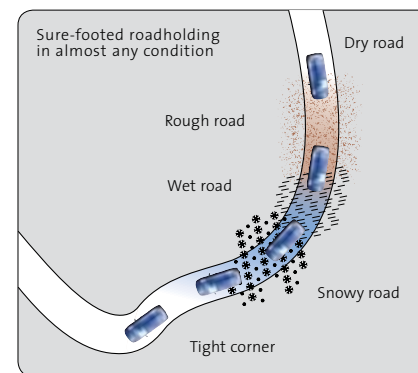

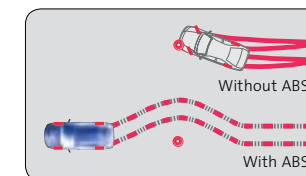
Safety starts with Subaru symmetrical full-time AWD

As a driver, you want a vehicle that inspires confidence. It makes perfect sense, then, that you want a Subaru – the only family of vehicles on the road with symmetrical full-time AWD standard on every model. With this system, the Subaru Impreza delivers sure-footed traction and control over everything from rain-slicked city streets to icy highways and gravel-covered country roads. Developed and perfected over more than 30 years, this advanced technology enables you to confidently and safely tackle virtually all manner of driving situations and conditions.



Powerful and reliable braking system

How a vehicle responds in braking situations is equally as important as how it drives under varying traction conditions. All 2007 Impreza models (excluding WRX STI) come standard with an advanced, 4-wheel / 4-channel / 4-sensor Anti-lock Braking System (ABS).



In addition, all models feature Electronic Brake-force Distribution (EBD), which enhances brake balance front to rear in order to shorten stopping distances – especially when the vehicle is loaded down.

The WRX boasts 4-piston brake calipers working with 292 x 24 mm ventilated discs up front and 2-piston calipers with 288 x 18 mm ventilated discs in the rear.



Front ventilated disc brake (WRX)

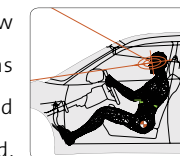


Rear ventilated disc brake (WRX)

The WRX STI is further equipped with massive, ventilated Brembo® brakes, front and rear. Up front: 4-piston calipers surround the 323 x 31 mm ventilated discs. At the back: 2-piston calipers clamp down on the 312 x 20 mm ventilated discs. These mighty anchors employ a Super Sport 4-wheel / 4-channel / 5-sensor Anti-lock Braking System (ABS) that includes a g-load sensor to help modulate braking forces while cornering and braking at the same time. Meaning: heightened safety and high performance all in one.

Optimum visibility = heightened awareness

With its height-adjustable seating position, sashless window frames and the ideal placement of pillars, the Impreza has been designed to offer the driver a clear and unobstructed view of the road. As a result, blind spots are minimized.



Your field of vision opens up. And this, in turn, enhances your ability to identify potential hazards before they become hazardous.

Travel safe, rest assured.

Unfortunately, even with the latest active safety technology at your fingertips, some accidents remain unavoidable. At these rare times, it's comforting to know that the Subaru Impreza has been designed to offer a 360-degree barrier of protection. And that it's received the 'Top Safety Pick - GOLD' for front, side and rear impact crash worthiness, the highest possible rating* from the renowned Insurance Institute for Highway Safety (IIHS).

All-around protection

Dual front airbags with dual-stage deployment and built-in occupant sensors. Front seatbelts with pretensioners and load limiters. The ISO-FIX/LATCH child seat anchor system and three-point seatbelts for the rear seats. And passive safety front seat headrests on the Subaru Impreza 2.5i that automatically reduce the distance between the passenger and the headrest in the event of a rear-end collision. All standard, all designed to offer superior occupant protection.

Advanced ring-shaped reinforcement frame

This all-embracing safety cage combines the roof, door pillars, window pillars and floor into one interconnected, energy-absorbing cell. The cell envelops the entire passenger cabin, thereby helping to dissipate impact energy, regardless of the direction from which it originates. The advanced ring-shaped reinforcement frame, energy-absorbing crumple zones and side-impact door beams combine to give the Subaru Impreza best-in-class collision safety for all occupants.



Pedestrian protection

With the 2007 Subaru Impreza, the 360-degree barrier of protection extends outside of the vehicle as well as inside. Detachable windshield wipers break away when subjected to enough force. Energy absorbing bumpers deliver as promised. And additional clearance between the aluminum hood and the compact SUBARU BOXER engine also helps provide increased accident protection for pedestrians.

Exterior Features



There are no frivolous add-ons for the 2007 Subaru Impreza here, only features designed to heighten the driving experience, enhance driving comfort – or both. Consider the standard 16-inch aluminum alloy wheels, projector beam headlights, and heated mirrors. The WRX adds a standard functional hood scoop, throaty turbo exhaust, low-profile spoiler and 17-inch wheels. Meanwhile, the WRX STI gains exclusive STI wheels, HID headlights and a larger, WRC-type rear spoiler. If looks could thrill...

STI HID headlights - These special projector beam High Intensity Discharge (HID) headlights provide superior illumination and improved road coverage in all lighting and weather conditions.



Moonroof and sunshade - Power operated to slide and tilt, this panoramic piece of glass helps make the most of sunny days behind the wheel.



Fog lights - Weather can play havoc with visibility while driving, but these projector beam halogen fog lights help clear the way even when fog, snow and rain are at their worst.



Hood scoop - This functional feature helps feed cool air to the turbocharger's intercooler and provide additional engine cooling, thereby improving overall engine performance.



Heated mirrors - Designed to clear away snow and ice with the touch of a button, the heated side mirrors are fully power operated to ensure clear visibility at all times.



Ground effects - These aerodynamic side ground effects help to reduce air flow under the vehicle thereby reducing lift and increasing stability at higher speeds.



Roof rails and crossbars - Perfect for weekend getaways, the roof rail and crossbar system is designed to accommodate roof cargo bins, as well as bicycle, ski, snowboard and kayak carriers.



Roof-line spoiler - The roof-line spoiler on the WRX Sport Wagon extends beyond the trailing edge of the roof to create a sportier profile and enhance vehicle aerodynamics.



16" Aluminum alloy wheels - These stylish wheels are made of lightweight aluminum alloy to cut down on weight and accommodate a larger tire for increased grip and control.

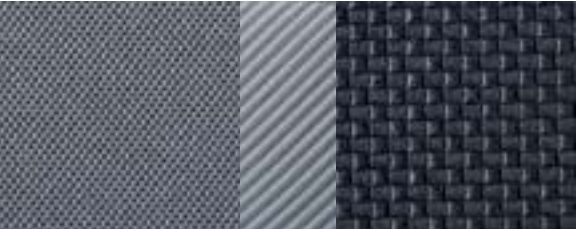

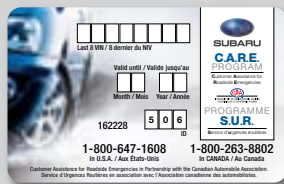
