Safety Precaution







System Connection

Powering And Installation

Plug one end of the AC power Wall adapter into the DC IN 12V jack on the right of the machine, then plug the other end into the AC power receptacle. Please refer to the following illustration.



If using DC power car adapter to connect to the power: Plug one end of the DC power car adapter into the DC IN 12V jack on the unit, plug the other end into the car cigarette lighter socket. See illustration below.



Note:

- DC power car adapter is available to use only when the car cigarette lighter with DC 12V negative grounding.
- The mains plug is used as the disconnect device, the disconnect device should remain readily operable.


Connecting To The Monitor

The unit can also be connected to the external LCD monitor.

Connect the unit to power by AC power Wall adapter or DC power car adapter .

Then connect the unit DC OUT jack to DC IN 12V Jack of the LCD Monitor by a DC/AV cable. Also use this DC/AV cable to connect the AV OUT jack of the unit to AV IN jack of the Monitor.




In Car Installation

1. Fit the straps to the DVD Player / Monitor as required.


Please install the units with strap A (long) and strap B (short) together.



Turn the player around so the backs are facing you.



Strap A through the unit from right clip




Suggestion: the buckle about 3CM from the unit edge to avoid the head hitting the head

- 2. Fitting the straps to the headrest.
- a. Fitting the straps to the headrest.



Fit the straps around the headrest and engage the 2 trident clips.
Ensure clips are securely fastened.




Pull the straps tight using the adjustment.

Tuck the loose ends into the strap tidy.

The end of the strap through from the second hole of buckle back




Turn to buckle front, the end of strap through from first hole

Finally, you can adjust the strap length to fit your car headrest


Note: Due different car with different headrest, small or big, so the rest strap length will be different.

NOTE:

The supplied strap intends to hold the device only, not subject to extra force. Be sure to complete the installation then use the units in the car. For units installation is recommended that the DVD Player is on the LEFT headrest, to ensure a neat cable run to the monitor, as shown below:



Connecting With External Speaker



Note: There is no 5.1 channel in the unit, however, after connecting to APM it is available to output audio in 5.1 channel.

Basic Operation

Playing disc of DVD, CD, MP3



- 1. Connect the unit to the power;
- 2. Open the unit and adjust the monitor to the best position for viewing.
- 3. Turn on the unit by sliding the ON/OFF switch to ON.
- Open the disc door and insert a disc into the door with the label side facing up.
- 5. Close the disc door. The unit will load the disc and start playing.
- 6. During playback,press "ыı" to pause; press it again to resume playback.
- When playing disc of DVD, CD, Press ">>", the unit will search forward.
 Press it repeatedly, the unit will play at 2, 4, 8, 16, 32 times of speed. press "◄◄", the unit will search backward. Press it repeatedly, the unit will play at 2, 4, 8, 16, 32 times of speed.
- When the playing is finished, please turn off the power by sliding ON/OFF switch to OFF.

Virtual Remote Operation

- Press "FUNCTION" button when disc is playing, you will see a virtual remote control as below.
- The virtual key is shown on the left of the menu, and the current playback status is displayed on the right.
- Use the Mpm/M/m button to choose the icon, when the icon is selected, you can see the description at the bottom.
- 4. Press ►II button, the selected virtual key will be activated, "►II = Selected

function" icon will be shown at top left for 10 seconds, in these 10 seconds you just need to press ►II button to change the style of the function. If the icon disappear, the ►II key will not work. (For Search, Return, Mute, the icon won't be shown).

You can also press "FUNCTION" button to close virtual remote menu without any operation. The player will resume playing after the menu exit.

Note:

- When the disc is in the submenu, press the "FUNCTION" key can go back the title menu.
- 2. Stop or no disc state, the "FUNCTION" is invalid.

Virtual Remote Operation

1. SRH (Search): Press the "SRH" key ,you can see the number bar below, Use left/right key to move the cursor, press ok to confirm, when playing DVD, you can change the chapter and the title, press the "T/C" icon change the item you want to change. When playing CD, you can select the track.

Note: To select the title, you need to enter two numbers.

- 2. M (Menu): to enter menu root.
- 3. ZOOM: When playing DVD discs, you can zoom in, press the "ZOOM" button and ok button to change the image size according the following sequence: x2 x3 x4, when playing JPEG file, you can zoom in and zoom out, press the "ZOOM" button and ok button to change the image size according the following sequence: 100% 125% 150% 200% 75% 50%.
- 4. TT (Title): to display title information.
- 5. ADO (Audio): to select audio language.
- 6. SUB (Subtitle): to select subtitle language when playing DVD disc.
- OSD: Display the disc information during playing DVD/CD. Such as elapsed time and remaining time.
- (Repeat): When playing disc of DVD/CD/MP3, you can change the repeat style by press repeat button. For different type of disc, it change according different sequence.



- Slow: You can press slow key to change the playing speed slowly during playing DVD. Then press ► II repeatedly to change the playback speed according the following sequence: 1/2 1/4 1/8 1/16.
- 10. (Return): to return to the menu.
- 11. M (MUTE): to turn mute.
- Angle: When playing a DVD disc with multi-angles, press "Angle" button and I button to change the display angle.

Note: The function is available only for disc with multi-angle.

Playing JPEG File

- 1. Place a JPEG disc into the tray, the unit will start reading and playing.
- 2. Press "IM IM and I button to select a JPEG file from the menu.
- Press "▶▶" to reverse the picture horizontally and press "▶◄" to reverse the
 picture vertically.

Function operation:

Press "FUNCTION" key you will see the toolbar as below:

Press the «/» to move the cursor to select functions.

Press " > " to select the function.

Return, to return to the main menu.

: To repeat one, repeat all.

:To zoom in/out the image during playback.

Press "FUNCTION" to exit the toolbar.

Play MP3 File

- 1. Place a MP3 disc into the disc door.
- 2. Press "◄◄ ▶> " to select the file; Press ▶ button to play the file selected.



Function operation:

Press "FUNCTION" then you will see the toolbar as below:



Press the ≪/> to move the cursor to select functions,

Press the number key to select the track.

Press " >II " to select the function.

: MUTE, to turn mute.

>: To select repeat one, repeat folder, repeat off.

Press "FUNCTION" to exit the toolbar

When no disc, press function button, the main menu will be displayed on the screen In the General Setup Page, Press ▶ button to highlight this item.

Press ►II button to access.

Press ►II button to select the setting.

Press ►II button to confirm your selection.




TV display:

Optional setting: On Off.



In the option user can set OSD menu language (English).






Audio:

- User can also change the audio language during playback by pressing the Audio button.



Subtitle:

Select your preferred language to show the subtitles on the screen.

The default is OFF.

The subtitle languages depend on the information available on each disc, You can also change the subtitle language during playback by press the SUBTITLE button.



Disc Menu:

This function allows you to choose the menu language stored on the disc.

The default is English.

Note: the disc menu languages depend on the information available on the disc.



Parental:

Enter this option to set the parental control level to some unsuitable disc scenes being watched by the children.

Optional parental control levels: KID SAFE, G, PG, PG 13, PGR, R, NC17, ADULT.

The default of this option is ADULT.

Make continuously pressing "FUNCTION"
button on the unit 4 times to be the password.

Troubleshooting

PROBLEM	SOLUTION
No sound or distorted sound	Make sure the machine is connected properly. Make sure all cables are securely inserted into the appropriate jacks.
Can't advance through a movie	You can't advance through the opening credits and warning information that appears at the beginning of movies because the disc is programmed to prohibit that action.
The icon Ø appears on screen	The feature or action cannot be completed at this time because: 1. The disc's software restricts it. 2. The disc's software doesn't support the feature (e.g., angles) 3. The feature is not available at the moment. 4. You've requested a title or chapter number that is out of range.
Display shows- "No disk" after inserting DVD	1. Check to see if you may have inserted a blank disc. 2. Remove disk and check to ensure that disc is clean and not scratched. 3. Check to see if you may have inserted a disc that has not yet been finalized. 4. Check to see if you may have inserted the disc correctly; please remove and try to insert disc correctly. 5. Try to play the original DVD disk. please note that some DVD players cannot recognize improperly burned disks. 6. Use a lens cleaning disk or gently wipe the laser pickup lens with dry microfiber cloth.

Picture is distorted	The disc might be damaged. Try another disc; It is normal for some distortion to appear during forward or reverse scan.
No forward or reverse scan	Some discs have sections that prohibit rapid scanning or chapter skip; if you try to skip through the warning information and credits at the beginning of a movie, you won't be able to. This part of the movie is often programmed to prohibit skipping through it.
