# Safety & Warnings

# **Battery Replacement**

  - Replacing the battery with an incorrect type (e.g., certain lithium battery types).
  - Disposing of the battery in fire or a hot oven or subjecting it to mechanical crushing or cutting.
  - Leaving the battery in an environment with extremely high temperatures.
  - Exposing the battery to extremely low air pressure.







# Installation

## **Installing Remote Control Batteries**

- 1. Remove the battery cover on the rear of the remote control.
- 2. Insert x2 AAA LR03 alkaline batteries according to the correct polarity.
- 3. Replace the battery cover.


# **System Connection**

#### Note:

Turn off all devices before connecting.


#### **Step 1: Connect to Power**

- 1. Connect one end of the provided USB cable to the Micro USB port on the device and the other end to the provided power adaptor.
- 2. Connect the power adaptor to an electrical outlet.



### **Step 2: Connect to the TV**

Connect one end of the provided HDMI cable to the HDMI port on the device and the other end to an available HDMI port on your TV.



#### Note:

If you have trouble fitting your device to an HDMI port on your TV, you can use an HDMI extension cable (not provided).

### **Step 3: Set Up Your Device**

Turn on your TV and follow the on-screen instructions to complete the setup.

# **Operation**

#### Indicator

- When any button is pressed, the indicator on the device will flash.
- If the remote control battery is low, the indicator will flash rapidly.

## **Pairing the Remote**

#### Pair

To pair the remote, press and hold the 'Home' and 'Back' buttons on the remote control simultaneously for 10 seconds.

#### Unpair

To unpair the remote, press and hold the 'Reset' button on the rear of the device for 3 seconds.

#### **Live TV**

- Live TV: Opens the LiveTVx FAST service, taking you directly to its home screen.
- Live TV Guide: Launches the Google TV 'Live' tab, showing the Electronic Program Guide (EPG) and a list of currently available live channels.

# **Google Assistant**

Press the 'Google Assistant' button to use voice commands for searching current content, changing channels, controlling the TV, opening apps, and more.

# **Troubleshooting**

Problem	Solution		
No display after powering on.	<ul> <li>Ensure both the device and TV are powered on.</li> <li>Confirm that the HDMI cable is securely connected and the TV is set to the correct HDMI input.</li> </ul>		
TV displays video but no sound.	<ul> <li>Verify that the TV is not muted and the volume is turned up.</li> <li>Open the A/V settings menu and select the appropriate audio channel and language.</li> </ul>		
Network connection fails.	<ul> <li>Check that your Wi-Fi is functioning correctly.</li> <li>Ensure the device is receiving a strong signal from the router.</li> </ul>		
Remote control is unresponsive.	<ul> <li>Replace the remote control batteries with new ones.</li> <li>Press and hold the 'Reset' button on the rear of the device for more than 3 seconds to unpair the remote. Then, follow the instructions to repair the remote.</li> <li>Always use the provided accessories to avoid compatibility or safety issues.</li> </ul>
