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Avoid Syncing Interruptions



If you are running a study overnight during a Daylight Savings Time change, the “Adjust for daylight saving time” option in your date and time settings on your laptop or tablet **MUST** be turned off.

Make this change BEFORE you begin your study!

IMPORTANT

If there is a time difference between the recording and the video, the EEG software will not recognize the video being associated with the EEG.

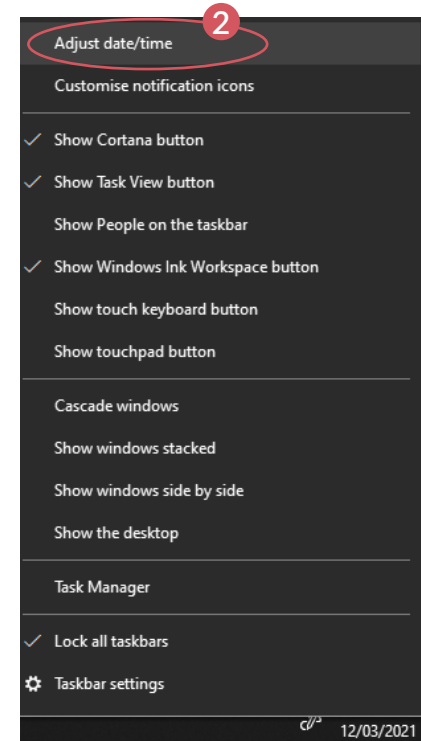
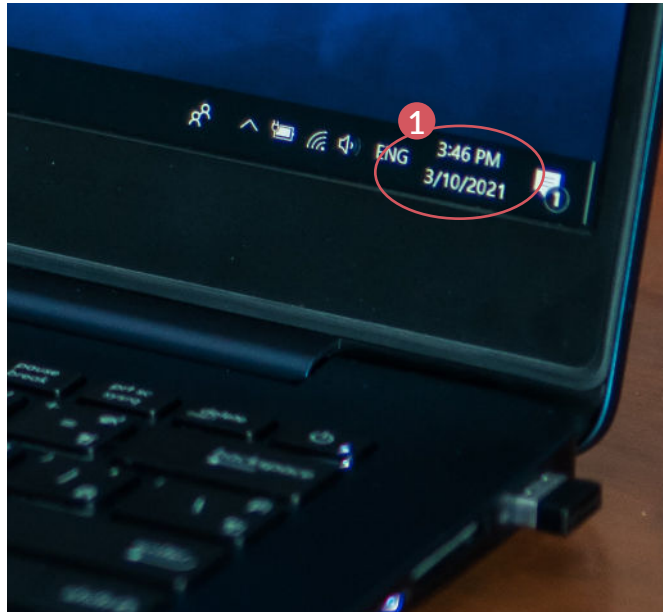
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Access The Date/Time Settings



1 Right click on the time or date in the task bar

2 Select Adjust date/time



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Change The Following Settings



1 Turn off the option

"Set the time automatically"

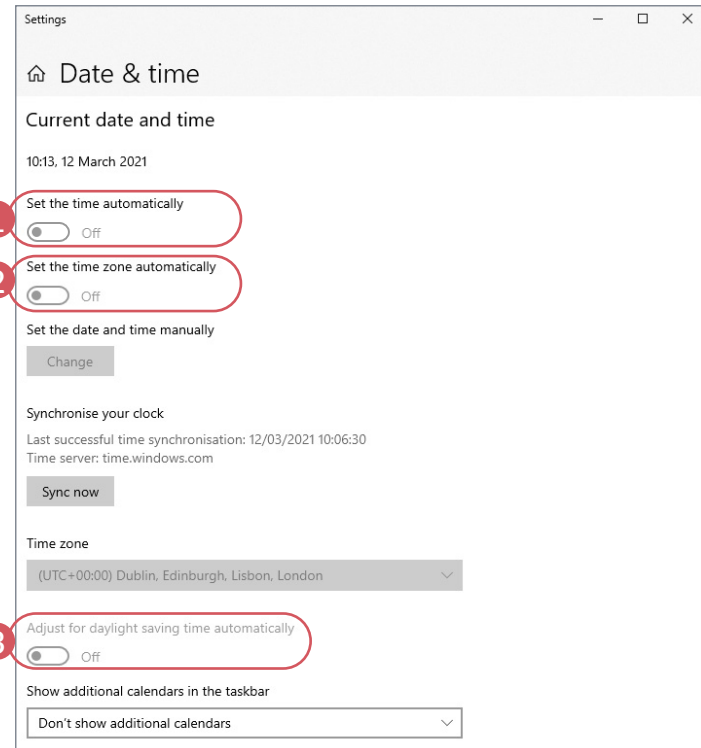
2 Turn off the option

"Set the time zone automatically"

3 Turn off the option

"Adjust for daylight saving time automatically"

Now you are ready to record.



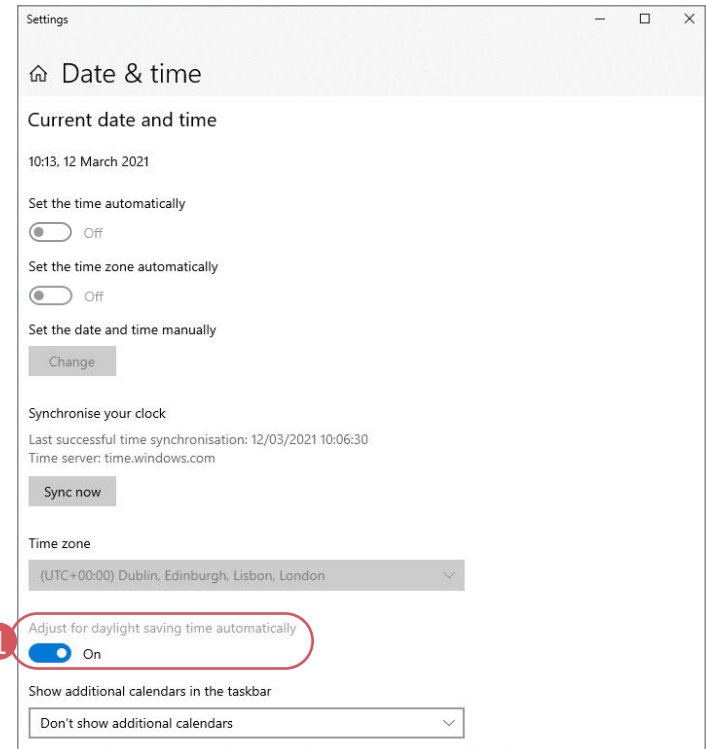
When Your Study Is Complete
