# Exhaust Fans & Bathroom Heaters

Modern styles with superior performance to suit the air movement need of any bathroom, laundry or kitchen.



3 important factors determine how well an exhaust fan removes steam produced by showers/baths:

#### 1 Extraction rate

Selecting the right extraction rate of an exhaust fan involves 3 simple steps:

Calculate the room size.

Example: Volume of a  $2.5m \times 2.0m \times 2.4m$  rooms =  $12m^3$ 

- 2 For reasonably good ventilation an exhaust fan must be capable of replacing the air in a room about 15 times per hour (15 ACH). However a prolonged hot shower on a cold day may warrant more frequent air changes per hour to help get rid of excessive moisture in the air. If required choose a larger ACH value (>20).
  Example: Required ACH = 15 x 12 = 180m³/h
- 3 Choose an exhaust fan with extraction rate more than the required ACH. Example: Required extraction rate (>180m³/h) = 200m³/h

### How to keep a room well ventilated

#### Adequate cross ventilation

Getting a decent exhaust fan with sufficient air extraction rate alone does not guarantee that a room can be well ventilated. A little planning before fan installation is carried out goes a long way. To ensure that steam is effectively removed from bathroom, exhaust fan should be located, as far as practicable, opposite air intake openings so that cross breeze can traverse through the room.

#### Replenishment of exhaust air

Air discharged must be adequately replenished by fresh air from the outside.

Typical sources of air intake include opening under door, grille on door or window. If a room has insufficient avenues for air intake, an exhaust fan can be noticeably noisier and will barely extract air. Prolonged use of exhaust fan inside an air tight bathroom may shorten useful life of the motor.

The reasons above-mentioned account for most complaints relating to performance of a good exhaust fan. Other common factors affecting air extraction performance include wrinkled duct and restricted movement of self-closing draft stopper.

#### The impact of poor ventilation

Without adequate ventilation, stale air, moisture, and condensation can accumulate—gradually damaging building structures and creating unpleasant, uncomfortable, and unhealthy living conditions

Poor ventilation allows humidity, steam, smoke, and odours from bathrooms, toilets, and kitchens to linger, making spaces feel damp and unwelcoming. Condensation forms when moist air meets cool surfaces like walls or windows, leading to mould growth, peeling paint or wallpaper, and even serious structural issues such as timber decay. These outcomes are all preventable with the right ventilation system and fan selection.

Ventilation Requirements Under the NCC - To comply with the National Construction Code (NCC), specific ventilation standards must be met in bathrooms, toilets, and other occupied spaces:

#### Clause F6D6

Any room occupied for any purpose (e.g. bathrooms, toilets, offices, laundries) must have:

- (a) Natural ventilation as per F6D7; or
- (b) Mechanical ventilation complying with AS 1668.2 and AS/NZS 3666.1

#### Clause F6D7 - Natural Ventilation

If using natural ventilation (F6D6), openings like windows or doors must:

Provide a ventilating area of at least 5% of the room's floor area, and open to an appropriate external space such as:

- (i) A court or open sky
- (ii) A verandah, carport, or similar
- (iii) An adjoining room that meets F6D8

#### Clause F8D4 - Exhaust Systems

For mechanical exhaust in kitchens, bathrooms, and laundries:

Must achieve a minimum flow rate of:

- 25 L/s for bathrooms or toilets
- 40 L/s for kitchens or laundries

Exhaust air must discharge directly to the outside, either via duct or shaft

If the system doesn't run continuously and the space lacks natural ventilation:

- It must be interlocked with the light switch, and
- Include a 10-minute run-on timer after the light is turned off

**IP Rating** stands for Ingress Protection Rating, defined by IEC standard 60529. It classifies the degree of protection provided by electrical enclosures against solid objects and liquids.

The format is: IPXY, where:

X = protection against solid objects (like dust)

Y = protection against liquids (like water)

#### IPX2

Protected from dripping water when the enclosure is tilted up to 15° from vertical.

Not protected from splashes or sprays (e.g. near sinks, showers).

Typically used indoors, in low humidity or damp zones; toilets, laundry rooms, or wall fans under eaves; and away from direct water sources.

#### IPX4

Offers a much higher degree of protection against water splashes from any direction. Suitable for intermittent exposure to water (not immersion).

Typically used in bathrooms, kitchens with steam and splashes, covered outdoor patios/ceilings and areas close to showers or sinks (but not inside them).

- Water damage of any kind caused by inappropriate placement of fittings not IP rated for that location.
- 13. The cost of renting, obtaining and using special access equipment (i.e. scaffoldings, scissor lifts, etc.) for accessing products installed at a height of greater than 3.0 meters.
- 14. Travelling costs incurred by MERCATOR personnel or service agents traveling greater than 25 Km from a MERCATOR authorised service agent. The purchaser must meet these traveling costs.

 Non-structural corrosion damage of non-316 stainless steel components such as surface rust or minor rust.

### 6. COMMERCIAL USE

Mercator products which specifically designed for commercial use are designated as Commercial Use Products on the product packaging.

All other Mercator products are designed for domestic use.

Where products designed for domestic use are used in a commercial environment/commercial premises one third of the domestic warranty.

### HOW TO MAKE A WARRANTY CLAIM

A. Limited repair/replacement warranty: Please return the faulty MERCATOR product together with a copy of the proof of purchase, and if required, a certificate of compliance for the installation of the product by the licensed electrician who installed the product, to the authorised MERCATOR retailer where the product was purchased. To the maximum extent permitted by law, the customer must bear the costs and expenses of claiming under this warranty, including but not limited to the cost incurred in freight, postage, handling, travel, dismantling or reinstalling the product.

# B. In-home repair/replacement warranty: Where an in-home warranty applies, please phone the MERCATOR customer care hotline 1300 55 22 55 (select option 2.) Australia for all in-home warranty enquiries and do not phone or return the product to the retailer. Do not uninstall or return a hard-wired product to the retailer unless advised to do so by a MERCATOR customer service representative.


