


Before you Install

- 1. Confirm dimensions of product with installation space.
- 2.Check your installation conditions.

(water supply, water pressure, lectrical circuit)

- 3.Pay attention to other objects.
 - Other objects(door,cabinet,etc) may affect the installation or sensing functions.

Cautions and Warnings

This product is classified as Class 1 Equipment, READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING.

(4) Grounded This product should be grounded.

- · Make sure that a properly grounded outlet has been installed.
- · Improper use of the grounding plug can result in a risk of electric shock.
- · Check with a qualified electrician or serviceman if the grounding wire instructions are not completely understood, or if in doubt as to whether the product is properly grounded.

- Never disassemble, repair or alter. This product shall be repaired by professionals only.
- · Do not get any water or cleaning solution on the top unit or power plug.
- · Keep cigarettes and other open flames away from the product. · Do not plug or unplug the power plug with wet hands.
- Do not use the product if a malfunction occurs.
- Do not use other water than allowed by the laws and ordinances of the region of use. Only use potable water. Do not use seawater or recycled water.
- · Do not fold or crush the water supply hose.
- To prevent a sudden water leak, do not remove the water filter drain valve or other hose when the shutoff valve is open.
- · Do not use a loose or faulty electrical outlet.
- · Do not use any power supply other than the one specified.
- · Do not do anything that may damage the power cord or power plug.
 - Do not strike, yank, twist, excessively bend, damage, alter, or heat the power cords. Also, do not place anything heavy on, bind or pinch the power cords.
- · If the power cord is damaged, to prevent any injuries or accidents, it should be replaced by a professional.
- Do not use during thunderstorms (pull put the power plug during storms) .
- · Do not spray urine at the dryer trap.
- Do not stick a finger or anything else into the warm air outlet.
- · Do not flush anything other than bodily waste and toilet paper.
- · Do not apply strong force, mechanical shock, step on or stand on the toilet seat, toilet lid or top unit.

Any misuse from ignoring the content of this label May cause personal injury or product damage.

- Prevent any exposed skin contact with heated seat too long toprevent low temperature burning.
- · Do not spray urine in the direction of the bidet nozzle.
- · Please use the water supply hose accompanying with new machine.

The old hose assembly shall not be used again

- · Do not install the product at a place with excessive humidity, where moisture may condense at the surface of the product.
- · Aviod direct sunlight or heat.
- · When not using the product for a long time, close the shutoff valve, drain the water
- from the top unit and water supply hose, and unplug the power plug from the outlet. · Any water left in the product may be frozen during the winter season. Please keep
- the product in room temperature before reinstallation or usage. · When install the product in the room, a stop valve shall be installed in a close proximity.
- For emergency circumstances, the water inlet valve shall be stopped without using any tools; otherwise unexpected failure may cause the loss to the customer.
- · Do not use any hard setting material (cement mortar) while installing the toilet. Thermal expansion of hard setting material (cement mortar) will damage or crash the feet of toilet.
- · Periodically remove dust and dirt from the power plug and make sure it is securely plugged into the wall outlet.
- · Do not lean on cover when use this device to prevent product from damage.

Cautions and Warnings

Any misuse from ignoring the content of this label May cause personal injury or product damage.

- Children, elders or those with disabilities from their body, sensitivity or mental disabilities or lacking of common sense should not use or get close to this product unless under close tutelage.
- Children are not allowed to use or touch this product.
- Do not leave children alone in a room with such product.
- To prevent the following persons from getting a moderate temperature burn during use, other person should turn off the toilet seat heater and set the dryer temperature to "Low".
- Young children, the aged and other users unable to set the temperature appropriately themselves.
- The ill, physically disabled and others who do not have freedom of movement.
- Those using any medicines that cause drowsiness (sleeping or cold medicine), those who have been drinking heavily, anyone severely fatigued and anyone else liable to fall asleep.
- When installing the water fi lter drain valve, make sure that it is securely tightened in its proper position.
- Do not use this product when the ambient temperature is likely to drop to 32°F (0°C) or lower.

Warning

Do not use the product if a malfunction occurs.

In case of breakdown or other problem, be sure to cut off power by means such as unplugging the power plug.

Close the water shutoff valve to stop water supply. Connect the dealer for help.

Possible malfunctions:

- -Water is leaking from a pipe or the top unit.
- -The product emits smoke.
- -The bowl unit is clogged.
- -The product is cracked or broken. -The product is abnormally hot.
- -The toilet seat cushion is out of place. -The product makes a strange noise or emits a strange odor.

I Maintenance

This product is an electric appliance.

- Be careful not to let water seep inside or leave detergent in the gap between the top unit and bowl unit. (May damage plastic parts or cause a malfunction.)
- Keep the Seat Sensing Area clean, never cover it with seat sheath or other things.

Toilet Clean

- · Unplug the power plug from the outlet before cleaning.
- · Wipe with a soft cloth that has been soaked in water and wrung-out thoroughly.
- · For heavy dirt:Wipe with a soft cloth soaked in diluted, neutral kitchen detergent, and then wipe with a soft cloth soaked in water.
- · Wipe off any cleaner that remains on the product.
- · Wipe off all water that remains on the product to prevent water seep inside.
- For cleaning or maintenance of plasticparts, do not use any harsh cleaning agents.

(These include, but are notlimited to products such as: concentrated sulfuric acid, concentrated nitric acid, glacial acetic acid, carbon tetrachloride, chloroform, acetone, butanone, benzene, methylbenzene, phenol, methylphenol, dimethylformamide, methyl ether, soybean oil, acetate, 40% nitric acid, thick salt acid, 95% alcohol, gasoline, kerosene or brake oil, etc).

🛆 Nozzle Clean

1.When unseated.long press Kid button on the Remote Control

- · Enter "Nozzle Self-Cleaning", the wand extends and water sprays out for cleaning.
- · "Nozzle Self-Cleaning" will run for 90s.
- 2. Wipe with a soft, wet cloth or clean it.
 - Do not pull, push or press the wand with excessive force. Do not use any acid detergent.

3. Press Stop button to finish

△ Others

- To prevent breaking, Please empty water from the tank when not using the product for a long time.
- · In case of freezing, unable to flush or wash, the cloth soaked in hot water can be covered on the water supply hose of the toilet or the connection part of the water supply hose to defrost it. (Do not pour hot water or blow hot air with high temperature on the product body, water supply hose and other objects).
- · The shutoff valve should be cleaned every 6 months.
- · The filter element should be changed every 3-6 months.
