How to change rear wheel bearing on **Seat Ibiza 6L1** – replacement guide

## i Important!

This replacement procedure can be used for:

The steps may slightly vary depending on the car design.

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## REPLACEMENT: WHEEL BEARING – SEAT IBIZA 6L1. TOOLS YOU MIGHT NEED:



- Wire brush
- WD-40 spray
- All-purpose cleaning spray
- Copper grease
- Torque wrench
- Combination spanner #10
- 12-point socket #30
- Torx bit T30

- Wheel impact socket #17
- Ratchet wrench
- Hammer
- Tap wrench
- Crow bar
- Rubber mallet
- Wheel chock

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### Replacement: wheel bearing – Seat Ibiza 6L1. AUTODOC experts recommend:

- Do not re-use the bearing assembly of your Seat Ibiza 6L1 car.
- The wheel hub bearing replacement procedure is identical for both wheels on the same axle.
- All work should be done with the engine stopped.

# REPLACEMENT: WHEEL BEARING – SEAT IBIZA 6L1. RECOMMENDED SEQUENCE OF STEPS:

1

Secure the wheels with chocks.



2

Loosen the wheel mounting bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



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Raise the rear of the car and secure on supports.



Unscrew the wheel bolts.



### **AUTODOC** recommends:

- Warning! To avoid injury, hold the wheel while unscrewing the fastening bolts.
  Seat Ibiza 6L1
- Remove the wheel.



6 Clean the brake drum fasteners. Use a wire brush. Use WD-40 spray.



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Unscrew the brake drum fastening. Use Torx T30. Use a ratchet wrench.



Open the car door.

9 Remove the parking brake lever trim cover.



Loosen the parking brake cable. Use a combination spanner #10.



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11 Remove the brake drum.



## Replacement: wheel bearing – Seat Ibiza 6L1. Tip from AUTODOC:

• Examine the brake drum. Replace it if necessary.

Remove the hub bearing protection cap. Use a crowbar. Use a hammer.



#### **AUTODOC** recommends:

• Some cars are not equipped with wheel hub caps.

Unscrew the wheel hub axle nut. Use 12-point socket No.30. Use a tap wrench.



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Remove the hub and the bearing together, since they are a sealed unit.



Clean the hub bearing mounting seat. Use all-purpose cleaning spray.



16 Install the new wheel hub with a bearing.

Tighten the hub. Use 12-point socket No.30. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 175 nm torque.



Replacement: wheel bearing – Seat Ibiza 6L1. Professionals recommend:

• The wheel bearing unit must not tilt on the axle pin.

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18 Install the hub bearing protection cap. Use a rubber mallet.



Treat the hub where it contacts the brake disk. Use copper grease.



20 Install a brake drum.

Tigten the brake drum fasteners. Use Torx T30. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 4 Nm torque.



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Clean the wheel rim mounting seat. Use a wire brush.



Treat the surface where the wheel rim contacts the brake drum. Use copper grease.



24 Install the wheel.

### **AUTODOC** recommends:

• Important! Hold the wheel while screwing in the fastening bolts. Seat Ibiza 6L1

Screw in the wheel bolts. Use wheel impact socket #17.



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Lower the car.



Remove the jacks and chocks.



Adjust the parking brake cable tension. Use a combination spanner #10.



Install the parking brake lever trim cover.



Close the car door.

Tighten the wheel bolts using a criss-cross pattern. Use wheel impact socket #17. Use a torque wrench. Tighten it to 120 Nm torque.





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
