- Sends audio to Auracast devices
- Supports hearing aids for multiplay → See Compatible Devices
- Default mode: Classic Bluetooth Switch to Hearing Aid:
 Press ② once. → LED blinks orange every 5s. If not, hold ② for 3s.

3. Buttons & Indicators



Enter Auracast: Press 🕲 once.

Hold (a) for 3s to swtich between:

- Hearing Aid:
 - m blinks orange every 5s
- Auracast Standard:
 - m stays orange

Enter Bluetooth: Press 🛊 once.








5. Use With App


- 1 Connect Audikast 4 to power.

 If not, hold ② for 3s.



6.2 Connect Hearing Aids


- Turn on Bluetooth on the phone, then select your hearing aids.

7.1 Connect the Optical Cable

Plug in the optical audio cable to connect Audikast 4 and your TV.





7.2 Set TV Audio Output

- Go to Settings > Sound > Sound > Output, then select Optical.
- 2 Set output audio to PCM to avoid no sound.
- Play a video → The audio signal stays solid.

- Go to Settings > Sound > Sound > Output, then select Headphones.
- Play a video → The audio signal stays solid.

8.1 Auracast Standard Setup

Auracast audio devices like

support both Auracast modes.

For better sound, switch to **Auracast Standard** mode:

Press and hold (2) for 3s.


→ LED stays orange.

8. Advanced Features

8.2 Bluetooth Setup

- Disable phone bluetooth, then enter pairing on headphones.
- 2 Plug in Audikast 4 and turn it ON.



8. Advanced Features

8.3 Reset Bluetooth Pairing

- 1 Plug in Audikast 4 and turn it ON.
- Press and hold + & for 5s.

 → All LEDs stays on for 2s. →
 Bluetooth LED blinks blue every 5s.

This will clear pairings and enter pairing mode.



9. Common Errors & Fixes

Connection failed?

Ensure your hearing aids are compatibe. → Check FAQ for the lastest list.

TV Audio Signal Valid?

The audio signal must be solid. If flashing:

- Check all cables are secure
- For Optical: Set TV audio to PCM
- For Aux: Set TV audio to Headphones

Still no sound?

Make sure Audikast 4 is in Hearing Aid mode.






