



# **PART 3 BASIC OPERATION**

# 3.1 How to charge the device

#### Note:

hours

Charge fully when first receiving the camera.

Please power off the camera to charge for at least 6

Compatible Charger Plug: 5V, 1A

### Low battery prompt:

- When the battery voltage is too low, the battery icon in the upper right corner of the display will turn red, and the screen will intermittently display the words "Battery Low" with a prompt sound, and it will automatically shut down after 5 minutes.
- Please charge it in time after the battery is low, so as not to affect your use (Power off state to charge).

### Charging Tips:

Use the standard cable and 5V-1A charger plug to charge for about 6 hours (Power off state to charge). When charging, in power-on status the working indicator light shows green, the power indicator light

shows blue, and the blue indicator goes out after fully charged.

# 3.2 Power On/Off/Standby Mode

### 3.2.1 Power On:

In the shutdown state, press and hold the  $\circlearrowleft$  button to power on, and enter the preview screen, the power indicator shows steady green.

Turn on the **LCD Auto Off** function in the menu, if without any operation after 5min after powering on, the default is to auto turn off the screen display (camera standby mode) and the green indicator steady on. Start video recording for 5min, without other operations, then it automatically enters the LCD Auto Off mode and the red indicator keeps flashing.(LCD Auto Off mode can be set to off/5min).

### 3.2.2 Power Off:

In the power-on state, press and hold the **(b)** button for 3 seconds to power off, and all the indicator lights go out.

## 3.2.3 Standby Mode/LCD Screen Off Mode

In the power-on state, the power indicator stays green. Turn on the LCD Auto Off function in the menu, if without any operation after 5min after powering on, the screen will turn off. Tap any button to light up the display screen/activate the camera.

### 3.3 Take Photo

In standby, short press button once to take a picture. OR in the power-on state, press and hold the button (This button is on front of the camera, below the BOBLOV logo.) for 3 seconds to take a picture and auto save it.

There will be a"click"sound during the picture. Every press and hold will take one picture. The picture is named after the date and time, and the suffix is **JPG**. Short press when to enter playback mode

# 3.4 Video & Audio Recording

### 3.4.1 Normal Video

In power on state, short press 🖫 button to start video recording.

When recording, there is a red dot flashing slowly in the screen upper left corner, and the work indicator shows red flashing.

Press the 🖫 button again to stop recording, the red indicator goes off, the video file is auto saved and the screen auto returns to the preview screen. The video is named after the date and time, with MP4. as the suffix.

Short press button to enter playback mode.

## 3.4.2 Snapshot

During the recording process, long press button (This button is on front of the camera, below the BOBLOV logo.) for 3 seconds to take a picture and save it auto. The video recording will not be interrupted during this process.


## 3.4.3 Important Video Locked/Marked


Press button to start the video recording, click the button to lock the current video and mark it as a key video, then need to click video button again to save this key video.

The function will not interrupt the video process.

The marked video will be saved in another file folder named "IMP" and the video file name starts with

"SOS ". Please check the below picture:





During the video recording, click the Ab button to lock the current video and click the button again to release/cancel the lock, then press the video button

🖫 to save the file.

This video will save as a normal video in the "VIDEO" file folder, named beginning as "NOR\_".



If marking the video as a locked video, this file will not be covered after the memory is full during the Loop Recording mode. Marked/Lockedvideo can't be deleted on the camera, please connect to a computer to delete it.

### 3.4.4 Zoom In & Out

In standby/video mode, long press the 🏝 button to zoom in the scene on the screen, and long press the 🕦 button to zoom out of the image.

The zoom in and zoom out can be adjusted in the range of 1.00X-128.00X.

# 3.4.5 Audio Recording

In the power-on state, tap the button; **OR long** press and hold the button for 3 seconds in the

power-off state, to start an audio recording.

When recording, the screen displays a ∮ logo, and the work indicator flashes yellow.

Press the button again to stop the audio recording. The yellow work indicator goes off and the audio file is auto saved. The screen auto returns to the preview screen. The indicator turns to steady green light.

# 3.5 Night Vision

The infrared night vision of camera default is "Manual", please long-press the  $\frac{\bullet}{\mathcal{O}}$  button to turn on/off the night vision in standby or video mode.

If you want camera night vision to be activated auto, please go to menu setting, and set "IR Filter" to "Auto". Then the camera can be switched to the night vision mode according to the brightness of the environment.

### 3.6 What is Stealth Mode?



On Menu Setting page, there is a **Stealth Mode** option, default is **Off**.

Turn it to On, the camera will be hidden recording states, no indicators, prompt sound, or button sounds. In Stealth Mode On Mode, you could record video with sound and playback it on camera with sound.

### Note:

If turn on Stealth Mode, the Laser Light/
Flashing/Alarm Sound can't be activated.
And we advise setting the camera Auto Power
Off to 10 min if Stealth Mode is On, as the
camera has no indicators in this situation, and
we don't know what the camera working state
is. Auto power off will save the camera battery.

# 3.7 Files View /Playback

a. In the standby mode, short press the button to enter the playback menu, and use the button or button to select the desired option, as shown in the figure below:



- b. Press the button to enter the playback list, and use the button or the button to select the file to be played;
- c. Press the Movement button to view and press the button to return to the previous menu.

#### Fast forward and rewind

When playback the video files, short press the ♠⅓ button in order is rewind play, short press ♠ button act as fast forward.

Short press the Am or button once to increase the speed two times. The fast forward and rewind can be adjusted in the range of 2X-128X.

### 3.8 File Deletion

#### Note:

If you need to protect the recorded files, turn on the "Password Protection" in the menu setting. Otherwise, all the files can be deleted without password verify.

The marked/locked video can't be deleted on camera side due to the design of recording evidence protection. Please connect to a computer to delete it.


After turn on the "Password Protection" in the menu setting, need to enter the default password: 000000 first before deleting files.

### Step as:

- ① In standby, short press 🕶 button to enter the playback mode
- ② Use ♠★ and ▼ø button to choose the Video/ Photo/ Audio file need to delete, click ★w button to the playback file list.
- 3 Long press Moutton to the password verify page, insert the default password(000000) if first use(otherwise, enter the password you have

modified).

④ After that get the option of "YES" and "NO" interface, use ♠/☆ and ▼/⊚ button to choose "YES" or "NO", then click ★/⋈ button to confirm. After deleting the file, the camera goes back to the previous playback file list



# 3.9 File Transfer/Connecting Computer

Connect to the computer by the USB cable attached.
Then enter USB disk mode.

(If turn on "Password Protection" in the menu, need to input the password you set first, (the default password is 000000) then could review or delete the files in the computer)

### 3.10 Camera Password

### \*Default Camera Password: 000000

There is "Password Protection" in the menu setting, click | decirity | button in the standby mode to get into menu, then turn to "Password Protection" section. If want to turn it on, you need to insert the default password: 000000 first. Click | decirity | button again, then use | decirity | and | very | button to choose the "On" option and click | decirity | button again to save the change.

After turning on the "Password Protection", the below circumstance need to verify the password, including but not limited to:

- 1. When connecting the camera to the PC side;
- 2. Try to delete the files on the camera;
- 3. Choose to change the camera password, need to

verify the old password(If the new camera, need to enter the default password.)



### How to change the password?

Short press 

■/OKI button in the standby mode, then turn to "Change Password" section in the menu. Before changing, you need to insert the default password: 000000 first. Then click **■/OK** button again to the new password setting page, use A/A and button to choose the 6 character password you desired, then need to click MODE button to save the change.

### 3.11 Reset

If the camera crashes or stops working, you could do a reset by poking the reset hole with a pin or thimble (be careful not to use excessive force). The device will auto shut down after the reset and can be restarted by long pressing the Power Button to turn it on.



# PART 4 SYSTEM SETTING/ MENU LIST

In standby mode, press the **1** button to enter the setting menu.

After entering the menu interface, press the button or button to select the list to be set, press the button to confirm. Use the button or button to change the options, then press the button again to confirm and save the setting changes.

# PART 5 WORKING INDICATOR LIGHT

- In the power-on state, camera standby, the power indicator shows steady green;
- ② On the video mode, the working indicator light is red and flashes slowly;
- ③ On the audio mode, the working indicator is yellow and flashes slowly;
- ④ Connecting a camera to the computer, the work indicator is red, the power indicator is blue and green;
- When charging, the power indicator is blue, and the light will be off when fully charged. If charging when powering on, the indicator shows blue and green;

6 After power on, every time a photo is taken, the work indicator flashes red once;

# PART 6 LASER/WHITE LIGHT & ALARM FUNCTION

- a. Laser Light: After powering on, long press the button to turn the laser light, the camera emits a red laser beam to locate the shooting direction, long press the button to turn off.
- b. White Light: After powering on, long press the button to turn on/off the white light, the camera emits white light, which acts as an illuminating light.
- c. Red & Blue Flashing and Alarm: After powering on, tap the pri button to turn on the alarm function.

  The camera will sound an alarm and flash red and blue warning lights. Press the pri button again to turn off the alarm sound, and tap it again to turn off the flashing lights.

# PART 7 TIME & DATE SETTING

### No GPS Version Setting Method:



## **GPS Version Setting Method:**

- Enter Menu, find option of "Time Zone", set it to your local time zone, and save.
   Eg: If you are in the US, set the time zone to "GMT-08:00" (According to your local time zone)
- ② Turn on the "GPS" option in menu, then get the camera GPS located successfully (the GPS icon will turn to Green (\*\*), the camera date & time will sync to the local correct time.

Please use the GPS in an open place. Or the signal will be hard to locate.









# PART 8 DASH CAMERA MODE

Dash Car Mode means the camera will start recording auto as long as you power the machine.

If you want the camera to be a dash cam, on standby mode, enter the setting menu to set the **Dash Camera Mode** to "On" and save the change.

### Note please:

When you activate the dash camera mode, the camera will start to record auto after you connect the camera with your car in ignition status.

### Install the Car Suction Bracket and Camera

M5 body camera includes a Car Suction Cup Bracket to install the body camera on the car windshield.

This suction cup only support the clean and smooth glass material. If the surface is not smooth enough or frosted glass can not suck firmly.

#### Attach Car Bracket to M5 Camera






Lock the snap and get the camera sucked on the windshield



# PART 9 GPS FUNCTION (OPTIONAL)

There is "GPS" in the menu setting, click button in the standby mode to get intomenu, then turn to "GPS" section. Click button again, then use and button to choose the "On" option and click button again to save the change.



After turning on the "GPS" in the menu, back to the preview screen, an icon will show up on the right corner of the screen. Take a video and the GPS information will be collected.

### Note:

If the icon show yellow , mean the GPS signal is weak and couldn't work. Only the icon show green the GPS information could be recorded normally.

Please use the camera in an open area to collect the GPS information.

If in buildings, a traffic jam in the viaduct or tunnel, the GPS signal will be weakened.

In addition, if there is metal shielding around the camera, the weaken will be more obvious.





# 9.1 How to check the GPS information of the video on computer?

The GPS player only support the PC. There are two m ethod to download the GPS Player file.

#### Method 1:

To playback the video with GPS, please search boblov.com and download the "M5 GXPlayer" app provided by the manufacturer to the computer desktop.

#### Method 2:

Or connecting the M5 Body camera to the computer, enter the camera U disk find "GPS Player Download" TXT file, copy the link and download the compressed

**GXPlayer ZIP file** to the computer desktop.






# GPS Player Download

### Stepsas:

- After download the GPS Player compressed file, unzip it in a new folder on your computer desktop.
- Then enter this new folder, double click the file named "sunning" could open the player.



#### Note:

When you download the GPS player in both methods, if you are alerted that "the file has a virus, download it yes or no", don't worry, it is only because your computer monitors an unfamiliar file. The file has no problem.



# PART 11 TROUBLESHOOTING

# Q: The camera couldn't power on, does it stop working?

- **A:** 1.Connect the charger and cable to charge the device, and check whether the problem is solved after 4 hours of charging:
  - Please check whether the charger and the USB cable are normal;
  - Use a pin to do a reset of the camera and re-power on to check again.
  - 4. If the problem cannot be solved, please contact customer service for further help.

# Q: Why the camera stop record? Can't take video anymore?

- **A:** 1. Make sure the camera storage capacity is enough to record.
  - Turn on the Loop Recording function to let the camera record continuously by overwriting the old files once the memory is full.
  - Physical Double check: Check whether the Video Button is intact and could be pressed normally.

- 3. Format the camera and do a hard reset then record again.
- 4. If the problem cannot be solved, please contact customer service for further help.
- Q: The camera display is showing red/green.
- **A:** Please reset the camera and power on it to check again.

# Q: A video or audio cannot be played? Or no sound for videos?

A: Please check the menu and turn on the "Record with sound" function. Turn to the loudest volume of the camera to check whether the sound could playback normally with the camera itself. It is recommended to playback videos/ audio on the VLC media player.

## Q: Why the screen turns off automatically?

A: The camera enters the LCD Auto Off mode in default without 5 minutes operation. If you want the display is always on, please enter the menu to set LCD Auto Off option to Off. LCD Auto Off option can be set to off/5 min.

### Q: Why does the camera shut off auto?

A: Please check whether the Auto Power Off option in the menu is on. If you want the camera to stay power-on state, please enter the menu to set Auto Power Off to Off. Auto Power Off mode can be set to off/1min/3min/5min/10min.
