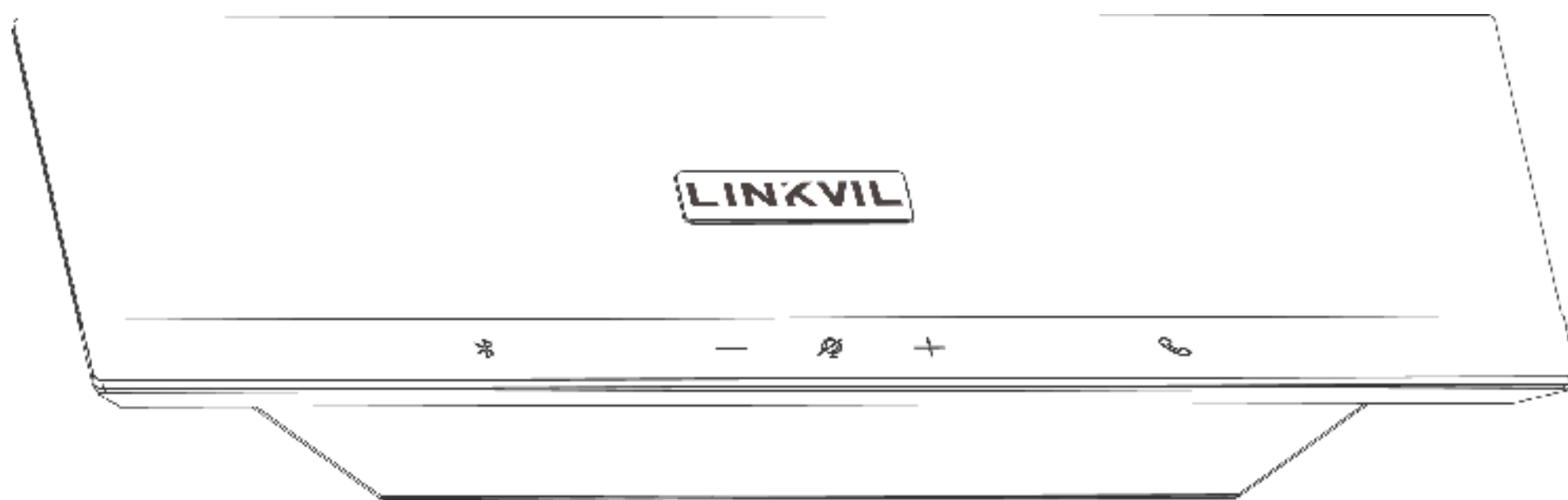
**CS40 is a loud speakerphone with vocal enhanced features design for medium meeting rooms.**

### 3.1. CS40 Conferencing Speakerphone



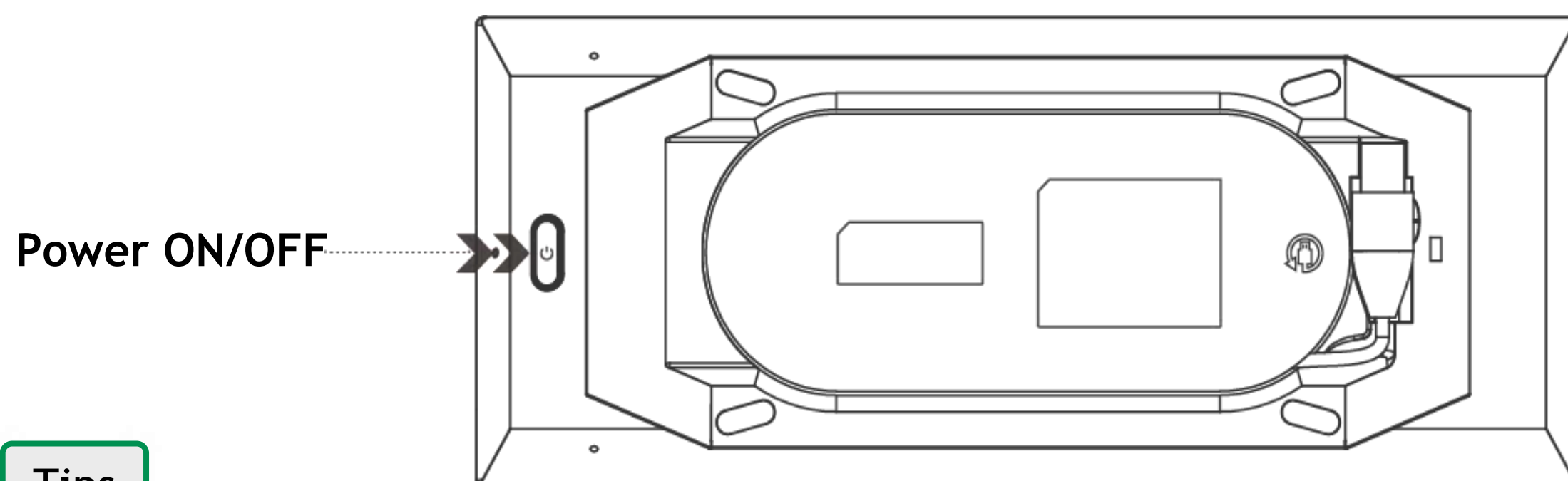

## 4. How to Use

### 4.1. Power ON/OFF

Hold power button 2s to power ON/OFF, the LED bars can be turned OFF or ON.

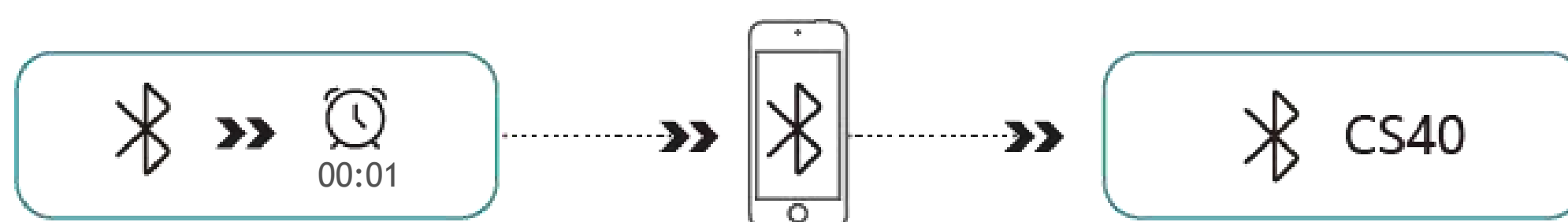


#### Tips

If there is no button operation or audio output within 20 minutes, the CS40 will automatically power OFF.

### 4.2. Bluetooth Pairing

Press and hold Bluetooth button for 1s to enter pairing mode. From the list of Bluetooth devices, select “CS40” to pair it.

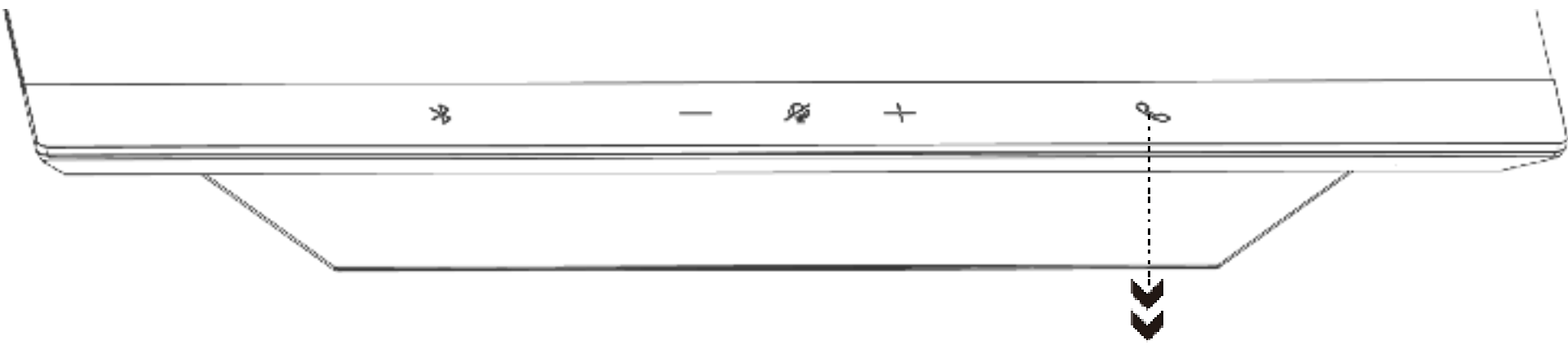


Tap the Bluetooth button in pairing mode, the pairing will be cancelled.

### 4.3. Volume Up/Down

To adjust the volume of the media audio or during a call, tap the volume up or down button.

Reject call

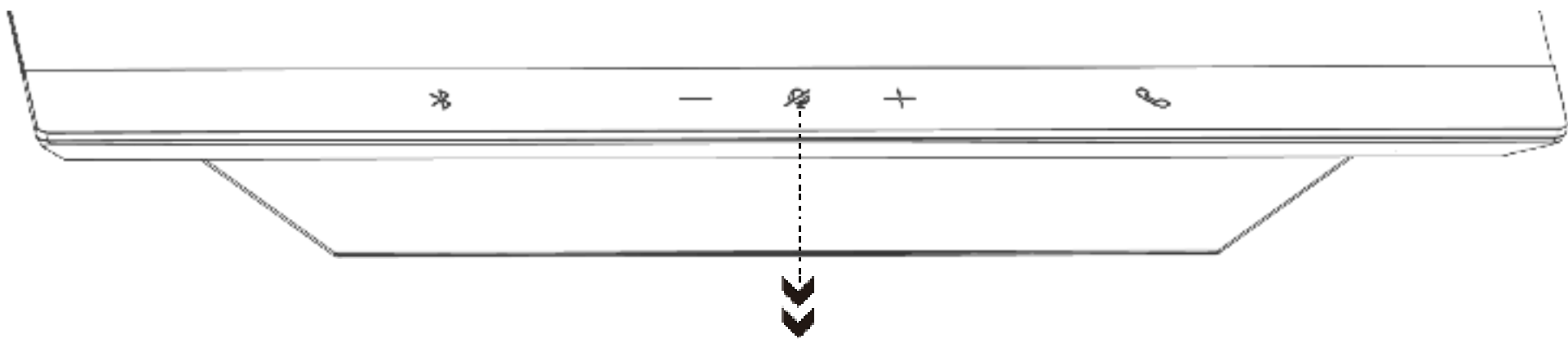
Double click the call button

To mute or unmute, tap the Mute button

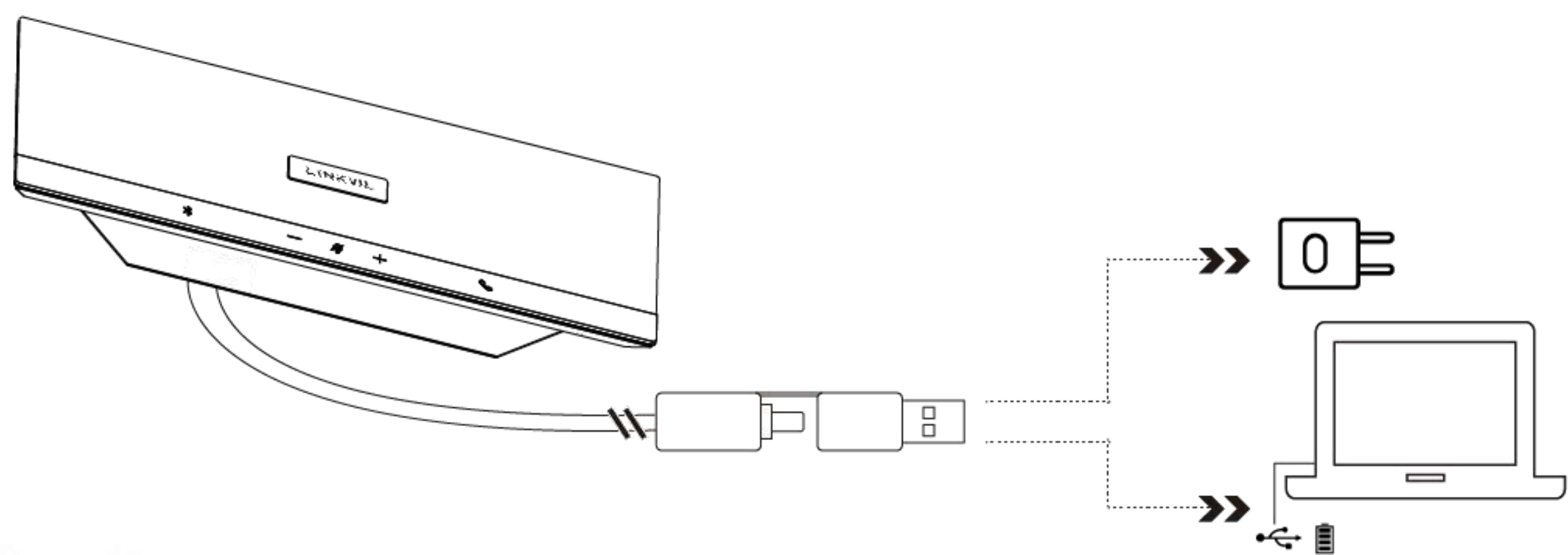

# 5. How to Charge

## 5.1. Charge

Connect the USB cable to power adapter\* or computer, the LED bars will light up automatically and power ON.



Tips

The speakerphone has a combined USB-A and USB-C cable for flexible connection to either type of computer port.  
And in corded mode, the speakerphone powers ON without using the Power button.



\* Excessive voltage may cause damage to the product. Using a power supply that exceeds the specified voltage can damage the device or pose other potential risks.
