## Put in the cards & power on

- 1 Insert the SIM tool into the hole next to the SIM & microSD card tray to pop out the tray.  
Make sure you use the correct size SIM card and don't cut the SIM card.
- 2 Insert the SIM cards with the gold contacts down, then gently push the tray into the slot.  
Add a microSD card **micro** (optional, sold separately) for additional storage.
- 3 Press and hold the Power button  to turn on your phone, then follow the prompts to get started.

To turn off your phone, press the Power and Volume Up buttons  +  at the same time.
