## 01 IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

#### FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY

## <u>(1)</u>

#### **WARNING:**

When using an electrical appliance, to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, injury, or property damage, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

#### **READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING THIS VACUUM:**

- 1. This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given super vision or instruction by a responsible person concerning use of the appliance to ensure that they can use it safely.
- 2. Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- 3. Use only as described in the User manual. Do not carry out any maintenance other than that shown in the manual, or advised by the Ultenic Support Team.
- 4. Suitable for dry locations ONLY. Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- 5. Do not handle any part of the charger or appliance with wet hands.
- 6. Do not use with a damaged cable or plug. If the supply cable is damaged it must be replaced by Ultenic, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
- 7. If the appliance is not working as it should, if it has received a sharp blow, if it has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, do not use and contact the Ultenic Support Team.
- 8. Contact the Ultenic Support Team when a service or repair is required. Do not disassemble the appliance as incorrect reassembly may result in an electric shock or fire.
- 9. Do not stretch the cable or place the cable under strain. Keep the cable away from heated surfaces. Do not close a door on the cable, or pull the cable around sharp edges or corners. Arrange the cable away from traffic areas and where it will not be stepped on or tripped over. Do not run over the cable.

#### 10. DO NOT use to pick up:

- ① Liquids ② Large objects ③ Hard or sharp objects (glass, nails, screws, or coins) ④ Large quantities of dust (including drywall, fireplace ash, or embers). DO NOT use as an attachment to power tools for dust collection.
- (5) Smoking or burning objects (hot coals, cigarette butts, or matches) (6) Flammable or combustible materials (lighter fluid, gasoline, or kerosene) (7) Toxic materials (chlorine bleach, ammonia, or drain cleaner)
- 11. DO NOT use in the following areas:
- ① Poorly lit areas ② Wet or damp surfaces ③ Outdoor areas ④ Spaces that are enclosed and may contain explosive or toxic fumes or vapors (lighter fluid, gasoline, kerosene, paint, paint thinners, mothproofing substances, or flammable dust)
- 12. Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of the body away from openings and moving parts, such as the brush bar. Do not point the hose, wand or tools at your eyes or ears or put them in your mouth.
- 13. Use only Ultenic recommended accessories and replacement parts.
- 14. Do not use without the clear bin and filter(s) in place.
- 15. Unplug the charger when not in use for extended periods of time.
- 16. Unplug the charger and disconnect the battery from the appliance before carrying out any cleaning or

user maintenance.

- 17. Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.
- 18. To prevent unintentional starting, be careful to keep your hands and fingers away from the power trigger until you are ready to begin vacuuming, especially when picking up or carrying the appliance. Carrying the appliance with your finger on the power trigger invites accidents.
- 19. Use only the Ultenic charger for charging this appliance. Use only original batteries as other types may explode, causing injury and damage. If either part needs replacing, please contact and consult the Ultenic Support Team for assistance.
- 20. When removing or replacing a motorised brush bar, be careful not to pull the power trigger until the cleaner head has been reassembled.
- 21. Disconnect the battery from the appliance before storing for extended periods of time.
- 22. When the battery is not in use, keep it away from other metal objects such as paper clips, coins, keys, nails, screws or other small metal objects that can make a connection from one terminal to another. Shorting the battery terminals together may cause burns or a fire.
- 23. Do not use a battery pack or appliance that is damaged or modified. Damaged or modified batteries may exhibit unpredictable behaviour resulting in fire, explosion or risk of injury. The battery pack used in this appliance may present a risk of fire or chemical burn if mistreated. Do not place the appliance on or near a cooker or any other hot surface and do not disassemble or short-circuit the battery 's supply terminals. Do not expose the battery pack or appliance to fire or excessive temperatures. Exposure to fire or temperatures above 60 °C (140 ° F) may cause explosion.
- 24. Exhausted or damaged batteries should be removed from the appliance before it is discarded. When removing the battery, the appliance must be powered off. Safely dispose of the battery in accordance with local ordinances or regulations.
- 25. The battery is a sealed unit and under normal circumstances poses no safety concerns. In the unlikely event that liquid leaks from the battery, do not touch the liquid as it may cause irritation or burns, and observe the following precautions:
- Skin contact can cause irritation. Wash with soap and water.
- Inhalation can cause respiratory irritation. Expose to fresh air and seek medical advice.
- Eye contact can cause irritation. Immediately flush eyes thoroughly with water for at leas t 15 minutes. Seek medical attention.

- 26. Follow all charging instructions in the User manual. Do not charge the battery or appliance outside of the temperature range specified in the instructions. Charging improperly or at temperatures outside of the specified range may damage the battery and increase risk of fire.
- 27. Any servicing must be per formed by Ultenic or an authorised service agent using only Ultenic replacement parts. This will ensure that the safety of the appliance is maintained. Do not modify or at tempt to repair the appliance.
- 28. **FIRE WARNING** Do not place this appliance on or near a cooker or any other hot surface and do not incinerate this appliance even if it is severely damaged. The battery might catch fire or explode.
- 29. **FIRE WARNING** Do not apply any fragrance or scented product to the filter(s) of this appliance. The chemicals in such products are known to be flammable and can cause the appliance to catch fire.



#### **Additional Information**

- Your machine won't operate or charge if the ambient temperature is below 5°C (41°F). This is designed to protect both the motor and battery. The recommended temperature range for storage, operating and charging your machine is between 18°C (64°F) and 28°C (82°F)
- To help prolong battery life, avoid recharging immediately after a full discharge. Allow to cool for a few minutes.
- Avoid using the machine with the battery flush to a surface. This will help it run cooler and prolong battery runtime and life.

## **Disposal Information**

- Ultenic products are made from high grade recyclable materials. Recycle where possible.
- The battery should be removed from the machine before disposal.
- Dispose of or recycle the battery in accordance with local ordinances or regulations.
- Dispose of the exhausted filter unit in accordance with local ordinances or regulations.






## **03 USING YOUR U20**

## **Getting Started**

- 1. Slide the battery onto the handle until it clicks securely in place.
- 2. Align the Vacuum nozzle opening with the top of the bendable tube and slide it on until it clicks into place.
- 3. Slide the bendable tube onto the neck of the Floor Nozzle until it clicks into place.

For proper operation, ensure all components are completely connected and clicked into place.



## **Charging Your Vacuum**



Charge the battery completely before using it for the first time. Allow approximately 4 hours for this.

It's important to fully charge your new machine before using it for the first time, and after every clean. This is because the battery and monitoring system's algorithm learns' over time, and fully charging your machine helps it to more accurately calculate and display remaining runtime.


Connect to the charger either directly or in the wall mounting.


The battery indicator light on side of the battery will flash during charging.

When the battery is fully charged, the battery indicator light stays white.

Your battery is fully charged when the display shows 100%.

\*Your machine won't operate or charge if the ambient temperature is below 5°C (41°F). This is designed to protect both the motor and battery.






## How to screw the wall mounting bracket to the wall?

3 screws with expansion plugs are supplied for attaching the wall bracket.

You will also need a battery-operated screwdriver or a drill (with a drilling diameter of 6 mm).

Depending on the wall bracket, select a distance of 115cm (Floor brush suspended in the air) or 102cm (Floor brush on the ground) between the bottom edge of the wall bracket and the floor.

You will need a suitable location near a free power socket for mounting the appliance on the wall. Be careful not to damage any cables laid in the wall.





## **Display and Control**

#### **Power Modes**

Your machine offers three distinct power modes, each tailored for specific cleaning tasks. Switch between modes effortlessly by toggling the gear.

Floor Mode: Balanced for hard floors (50-55min runtime).

**Carpet Mode:** Enhanced for low-pile carpets (30-35min runtime).

Turbo Mode: Ideal for heavy debris or long-pile carpets over 1.8cm (15min runtime).



## **Carpet Cleaning Tips:**

• Use "Carpet mode" for low-pile carpets and "Turbo mode" for long-pile carpets over 1.8cm.

Move slowly to allow the brush roll to fully engage, especially for carpets with embedded hair,
 ensuring effective agitation and lifting of hair and dirt.

#### **Runtime Countdown**

During use, the display shows the countdown in minutes.

When charging, it shows the battery percentage.



## **Alerts**

The alerts you might see are:

" : When the charge level falls below 10%, the charging indicator flashes at 2 times per second to remind you that charging is required.

": The floor brush is clogged and needs to be removed for cleaning.

": The main motor or tube is clogged and needs to be removed for cleaning.



## **04 MAINTAINING YOUR U20**

## Cleaning the Dustbin and Filter

Regularly check the dustbin level and empty it as needed. Clean the filter every 3-4 weeks or more frequently if used heavily.



## **Emptying the Dustbin:**

- Remove the dustbin from the machine.
- · Use the provided cleaning tool to dislodge any hair and remaining dust.
- Ensure the dustbin is thoroughly clean before reassembly.




#### **Cleaning the HEPA Filter:**

- Gently shake the filter to remove loose debris.
- Use the cleaning tool to brush off any stubborn particles.
- If necessary, rinse the filter with water and allow it to air dry.
- It is recommended to replace the filter every 3 months to ensure optimal performance.

#### **Notes:**

Both the dustbin and the filter are washable. After cleaning, place them in a well-ventilated, warm area to dry completely. It is crucial that the filter is completely dry before reinstalling it into the machine. Using a damp filter can damage the machine and reduce its efficiency.







## **Cleanning the Floor Brush**


To maintain optimum performance, check your floor brush bar regularly and clear any obstruc tions.

Make sure your machine is disconnected from the charger and make sure your machine power is turned off.

#### Steps:

- 1. Press the release button on the end of the tube. Place the floor brush up side down.
- 2. Twist the end cap and slide the brush roller out of the floor brush.
- 3. Use the provided cleaning tool to clear any debris or blockages from the roller brush.

Your Floor brush head and brush roller aren't washable. Wipe over with a damp lint-free cloth.



## **Clearing Blockages**

Disconnect your machine from the charger before looking for blockages.


Be careful not to touch the trigger and be aware of sharp objects.


#### Steps:

 Check the main body.
 Remove the bin and check for blockages in the main body of your machine. Make sure any blockages are completely cleared and all

parts are fitted before using your machine.

- Check the bendable tube and floor brush head Check the tube for blockages.
   Check your floor brush head for blockages, following the instructions to remove the brush roller, where necessary.
- Re-assemble your machine.
   Refit all parts securely before using your machine.
   Clearing blockages isn't covered by your guarantee.
