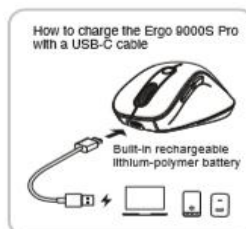
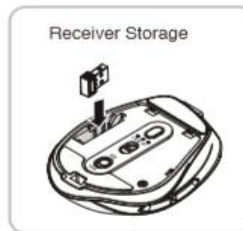

Button Assignment

Front



- ① Left button
- ② Right button
- ③ Scroll wheel with middle button
- ④ DPI switch
- ⑤ Forward
- ⑥ Backward

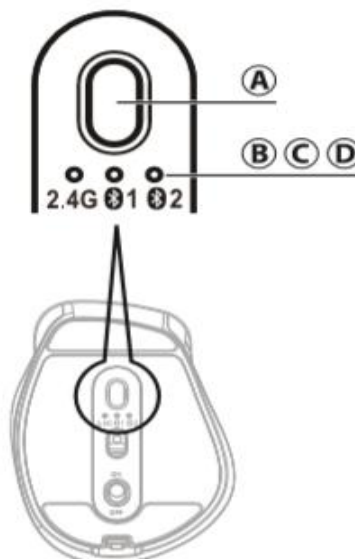
Back



- USB-C rechargeable port (Ergo 9000S Pro)
- ⑦ Mode button
Red : 2.4GHz (Default)
Orange : Bluetooth BT1
Green : Bluetooth BT2
- ⑧ Power: On/Off



Connection Process



English

1. **2.4GHz mode** (Red light flashes): Plug the receiver into USB port, and start working.
2. **Bluetooth mode installation**: - BT 1 (Orange light flashes)
- BT 2 (Green light flashes)
 - Step (A) : Starting BT pairing
Long press Mode Button for 2 seconds into pairing mode
 - Step (B) : Pairing
Confirm the light flashes turn into the orange/green
 - Step (C) : Select pairing name
Choose Genius BluetoothM1 or Genius BluetoothM2
 - Step (D) : Pairing process done
Start working
3. **Mode switching**: Press Mode Button (A) to switch 2.4GHz/BT1/BT2
