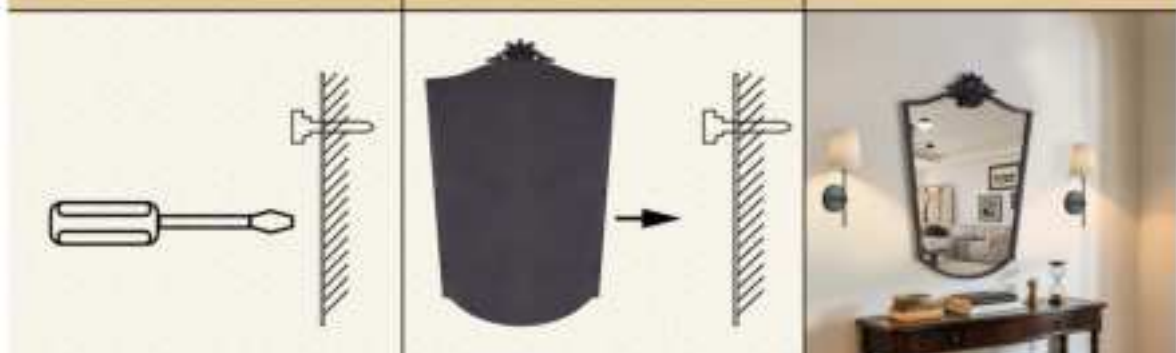

Not sure which size to choose?

To choose the right size bathroom mirror, you can refer to the following guidelines.

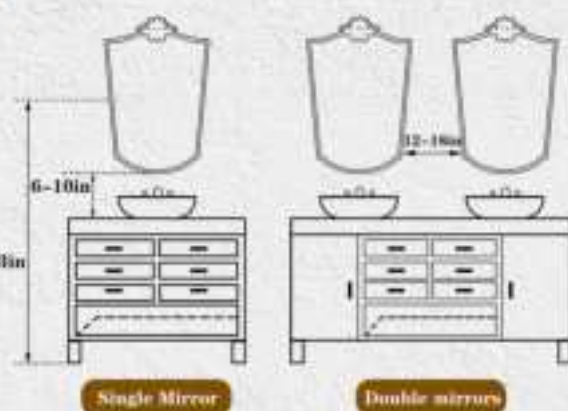
Width:

Typtrally, the bathroom mirror should be narrower than or equal to the width of the vanity. If you have two mirrors and need to install a wall sconce between them, a spacing of about 12 ~ 18 inches in the middle will look more balanced. You can also adjust the distance slightly based on the actual dimensions

Height:

The bottom of the mirror should be about 6 ~ 10 inches above the top of the sink to prevent water splashes on the mirror.

The center of the mirror is typically about 59 ~ 63 inches from the floor, providing a comfortable height for most adults.
