



#### LOCATION REQUIREMENTS

 Meanths air conditioner on a flat, level surface in a location that is at least 20" (51 cm) from any wall.

NOTE: A minimum cleanance of 30" 151 cml from the air conditioner to the wall must be maintained to: erguen german airflow.

- Montain a minimum 20" (\$1 cm) clearance around the air conditioner to not block eirflow.
- Keep the air conditioner free of any obstructions such as drapes, curtains, tidings, etc.

- . When turning on the air conditioner for the first time after plugging it into an electrical outlet, the unit will start in Cooking mode set at 75°F (34°C), and at High fan speed The control panel will display the current room temperature.

- . When turning on the unit after previous use, it will remember the last settings used.
- . After a normal shut down, please wait for 3 minutes. before restarting the unit.
- . In Cooling mode, this unit should not require water to be removed. This model has a unique design that continuously avaporates the weter.

## STEP 2 - INSTALL EXHAUST **NOZZLE TO MAIN WINDOW PANEL**




