- Do not use headphones while driving, riding a bike or at too high a decibel, as this may effect your safety and/or hearing.

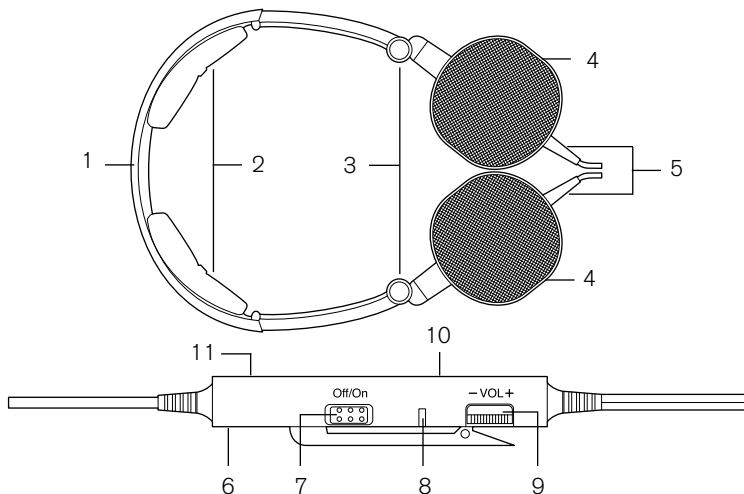
## **BATTERY PRECAUTIONS**

## **INSTALLING THE BATTERIES**

1. Open the BATTERY COMPARTMENT COVER at the back of the CONTROL BOX by pushing the cover in the direction of the arrow.
2. Insert one AAA alkaline battery into the battery compartment according to the polarity indicators.
3. Close the BATTERY COMPARTMENT COVER securely.

**Important:** Please remove the battery if storing the headphones for an extended period of time.

## USING THE HEADPHONES

1. Place the EARCUPS over the correct ears by noting the R and L indicators on the sides of the HEADBAND.
2. Adjust the headphones to comfortably fit on your head.
3. Clip the CONTROL BOX to an convenient place where the headphones will not shift when you move your head.
4. Insert the 3.5mm plug directly into your audio source.
5. Adjust the VOLUME DIAL on the CONTROL BOX to increase or decrease the volume to your preference.
6. To activate the noise cancellation feature, slide the POWER SWITCH on the CONTROL BOX to the "On" position. The LED POWER INDICATOR will illuminate red.
7. Press and hold the MUTE button to mute sound.
8. Release the MUTE button to resume sound.

## **DUAL-PIN ADAPTER/T-SPLITTER AIRPLANE ADAPTER**

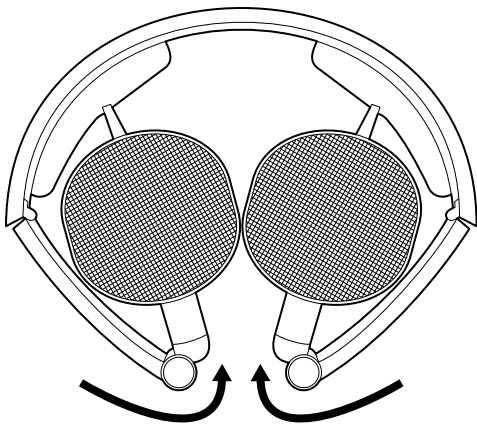
Insert the headphone's 3.5mm plug into either the DUAL-PIN or T-SPLITTER ADAPTER and then plug the adapter into your audio source.

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Before storing the headphones in the included carrying case, please fold the EARCUPS in one direction as illustrated below.

**Important:** The EARCUPS twist and fold in only one direction—forcing them to twist or fold in the wrong direction will damage the headphones.

To clean the earphones and case, wipe with a soft, dry cloth.

Service options, parts availability and response times will vary. You are responsible for delivery and the cost of delivery of the product or any parts to the authorized service center for replacement, per our instructions.
