



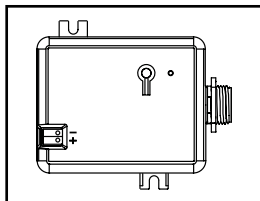

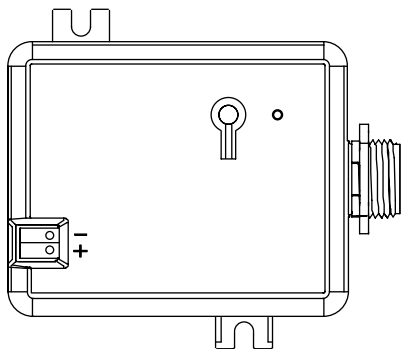

Tools Needed

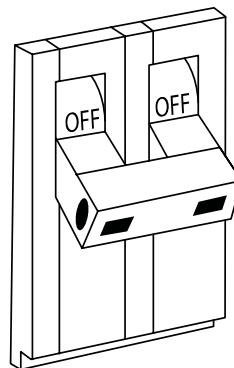
A flat screwdriver and a pair of wirecutters will be needed for installation.



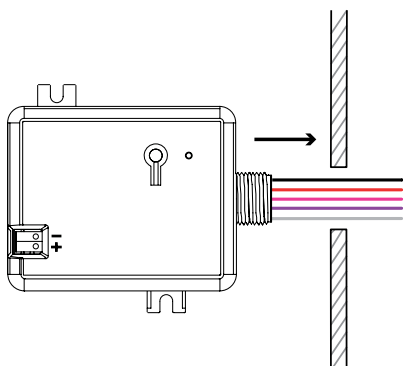
- 1** Make sure the luminaire can be controlled by a 0-10V dimmer. Carefully unpack the unit from its packaging. Inspect product for defects due to shipping.



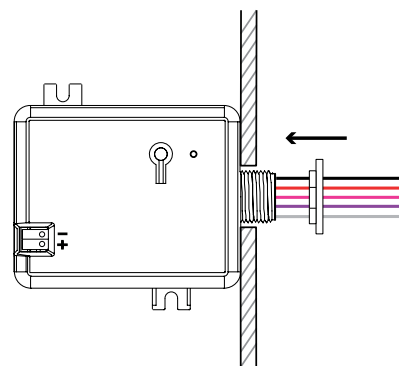
- 2** Turn off power to appropriate circuit at the breaker panel.



- 3** Route wires and device threading through a 1/2" knockout.

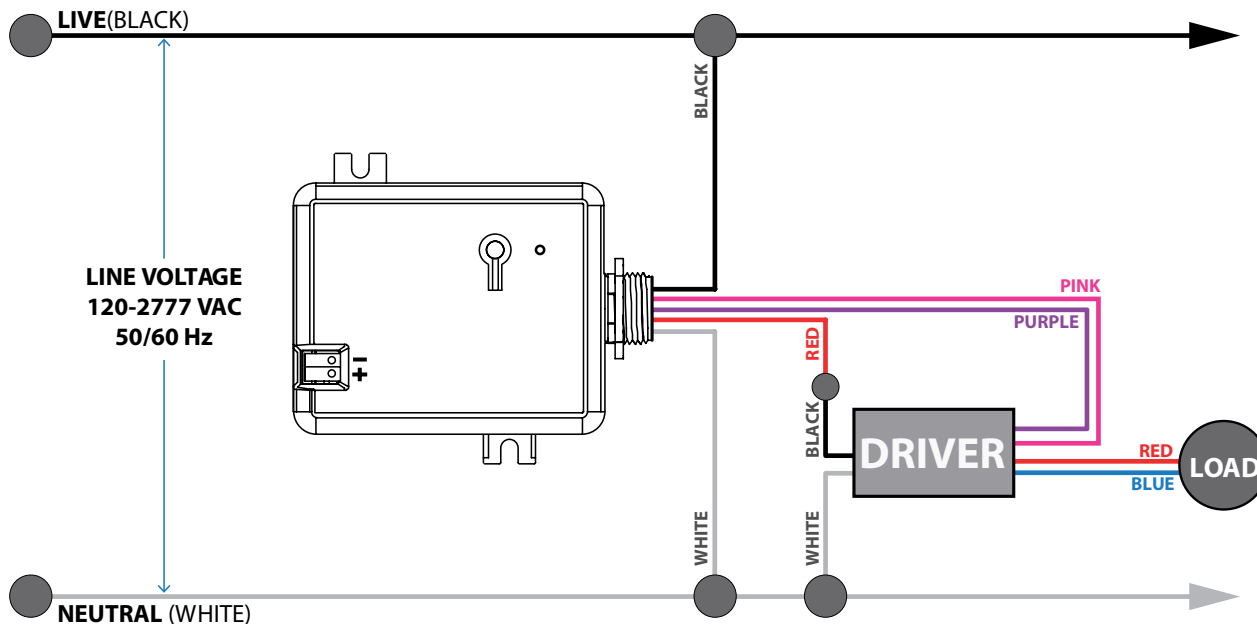


- 4** Place lock-nut over the wires and screw onto threading to tighten controller.

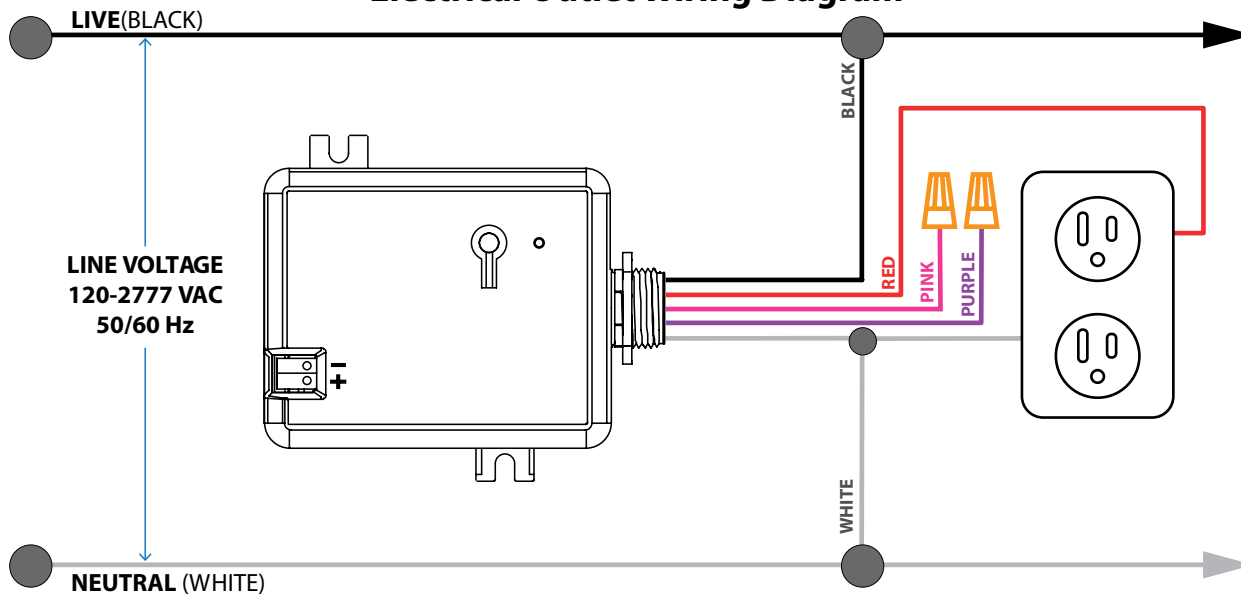


- 5 Connect the controller wires using the wiring diagrams below (according to their uses):

- 6 Turn power **ON** and follow the Nicor NLC commissioning guide.

This limited warranty is a consumer's exclusive remedy, and applies only to new products purchased and used by consumers in the United States or Canada, which are accompanied by this written warranty.

This limited warranty extends only to first consumer purchaser, and is not transferable. A consumer wishing to invoke the terms of this warranty must first obtain an RGA number within 30 days of discovery of the defect, and return the product to NICOR for inspection. Once verified to be covered by this limited warranty, NICOR will, at its discretion, repair, replace or refund the purchase price of any product that does not conform to this limited warranty.

This limited warranty covers only defects in material and workmanship associated with normal installation and intended use of the product.

THIS LIMITED WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER THE FOLLOWING:

Normal wear and tear

Defects or damages resulting from improper installation, operation, storage, misuse or abuse, accident, or neglect;

Defects or damages resulting from improper service, testing, adjustment, installation, maintenance, alteration, connection to out-of specification electrical service, corrosive or damp environments, or connection to incompatible equipment or devices (e.g., connecting non-dimmable lighting products to dimmers);
