### IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY

#### WARNING

To reduce the risk of injury, fire, electric shock, and property damage resulting from improper use of the appliance, carefully observe the following instructions. This unit contains electrical connections and moving parts that potentially present risk to the user.

##### THE POWER NOZZLE, WAND, AND HANDLE CONTAIN ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS:

- Never use or store near water.
- Do not connect multiple tools.
- Do not use cords.
- Turn off tools before changing them or using them.
- 1. Never use power cord or any part of the unit. DO NOT use tools with damaged power cords or plug. If the handle begins to smoke, stop your vacuum cleaner by the power cord switch. Unplug and turn off.
- 2. DO NOT use power cord on wet surfaces. Use only on dry surfaces.
- 3. Using from a outlets other than the wall outlet is dangerous.
- 4. Tools and accessories can cause serious injuries if used carelessly. Do not drop, hit, or drag, or drop onto hard surfaces.
- 5. The power cord is a Class II tool. DO NOT use when damaged, cut, or cracked.
- 6. DO NOT use the vacuum cleaner by the handle or the power cord.
- 7. DO NOT plug the power cord. Plug the plug, not the cord.
- 8. DO NOT remove the power cord from the power cord socket on the cord or the handle.
- 9. DO NOT use the vacuum cleaner on the power cord, close a door on the cord, or it becomes too damp or damaged.
- 10. Throw away damaged cords or do not use them.
- 11. DO NOT use vacuum cleaner on power cord or handle when wet.
- 12. Keep away from heating surfaces.
- 13. Always unplug the vacuum cleaner after use and before cleaning tools.

##### GENERAL USE

- 14. Use only on clean, dry surfaces.
- 15. Know your vacuum well.
- 16. Keep the vacuum cleaner moving over the carpet area at all times. Do not stand in the carpet tools.
- 17. DO NOT clean vacuum cleaner on carpeted surfaces such as white carpets.
- 18. DO NOT plug or unplug the cord while the vacuum cleaner is operating. Doing so may damage the power cord or the vacuum cleaner.
- 19. DO NOT use the vacuum cleaner on carpet when there is more than one person using it. It may reduce airflow.
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##### DUST CUP/FILTERS/ACCESSORIES

- Clean and replace the vacuum cleaner's dust cup and filter regularly.
- 21. Replace the dust cup filter every six months.




### ASSEMBLING YOUR VACUUM

#### STEP 1

TIP: Push firmly into base of handle connection.



#### STEP 2




1. Press handle firmly into base of handle connection.  
2. Press lower dust wand onto handle.

#### STEP 3

TIP: Push firmly into base of handle connection.




#### STEP 4



3. Place pad onto wand and slide onto handle.  
4. Connect hose into back of power cord and secure.

#### STEP 5



5. Place tools on the handle by pressing down.

### USING YOUR VACUUM IN UPRIGHT MODE

**WARNING: DO NOT use to pick up drywall dust, fireplace ash, or embers. DO NOT use as an attachment to power tools for dust collection. These applications present a risk of fire.**

#### WHAT DOES THE BRUSHROLL INDICATOR LIGHT MEAN?

##### Solid Green

The brushroll is working  
and the unit is upright.

##### Solid Red

The brushroll is working  
and the unit is upright  
and the handle is tilted.

##### Flashing Red\*

The brushroll is working  
but your vacuum is not  
upright. Turn your vacuum  
upright and surface, by  
pressing the Ejector Device.

##### No Light

The brushroll is off because the  
vacuum is upright and handle is  
tilted.


## USING YOUR VACUUM IN POWERED LIFT-AWAY<sup>®</sup> MODE

**WARNING:** Ensure solid footing when using in Lift-Away mode. Using for an application where you lack stability may result in personal injury.

**NOTE:** To use the Powered Lift Away feature, lift cordless mode.


### WHAT IS POWERED LIFT-AWAY?

Our Powered Lift Away feature allows you to lift the pod from the main unit while maintaining the same power and suction strength. This allows you to clean stairs, corners, under furniture, etc., after your spouse.



#### POWERED LIFT-AWAY CLEANING

- Press Lift-away button to lift pod off floor nozzle. You are now ready to clean the hard-to-reach areas.



#### LIFT-AWAY<sup>®</sup> CLEANING

- Push handle to lift the main unit. OR
  - Push foot to lift the main unit.
- Allow dirt to accumulate & push into floor. When dirt builds up, it's time to clean the floor.

## MAINTENANCE

To clean your vacuum's dust or debris control, follow these instructions. Unplug unit before and after any cleaning.

**WARNING:** To reduce the risk of shock and unintended operation, turn power off and unplug unit before servicing.

Hand wash with water only to prevent damage from cleaning chemicals. Allow ALL filters to dry completely before replacing in the vacuum to prevent liquid from being drawn into electric parts.


**IMPORTANT:** Do not wash the Pre-Motor HEPA Filter.

### RECOMMENDED FILTER CLEANING SCHEDULE:

Pre-Motor Filter Kit  
(Foam & Felt)  
XFF1580  
Clean monthly.

Post-Motor Filter  
(HEPA)  
XEP1580  
Clean once a year.

### STEP 5



#### CLEANING THE FILTERS

- 1. Pre-Motor (Foam and felt):** With the dust cup attached to the unit, pull the handle until the foam and felt filters are visible. Wash with water, soapy water, or a HEPA filter cleaner.
- 2. Post-Motor (HEPA):** Turn the HEPA filter clockwise to remove it. Wash with water, soapy water, or a HEPA filter cleaner.



## MAINTENANCE

**WARNING:** To reduce the risk of shock and unintended operation, turn power off and unplug unit before servicing.


**TIP:** When cleaning the HEPA filter, just a cloth.

### STEP 1



#### CHECKING FOR BLOCKAGES & MAINTAINING BRUSHROLL

- Turn vacuum off and unplug it.



#### EMPTYING THE DUST CUP

- Unplug the unit.
- Hold dust cup over a trash bin and open the empty-out switch to empty.

- Pull up to expose the 3-way Shutoff switch. Turn the handle back and forth to push the lock open in the cleanup position.
- Remove cleaning cap. Note: Shutoff switch may be held open with the handle. Then, disengage the brush roll by pulling the power switch up. Turn the handle to lock the Shutoff switch.

## TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

**WARNING:** To reduce the risk of shock and unintended operation, turn power off and unplug unit before servicing.

**Vacuum is not picking up debris. No suction or light suction.**

- Check filters to see if they need cleaning. Follow instructions for rinsing and drying the filters before re-inserting in the vacuum.
- Dust cup may be full; empty dust cup.
- Check hose, hose connections, nozzles, and accessories for blockages; clear blockages if required.
- Remove any string, carpet fibers, or hair that may be wrapped around the brushroll.

**Vacuum lifts area rugs.**

- Turn off unit to disengage the brushroll. Move switch to Hard Floor setting for suction-only cleaning, and turn unit back on.
- Suction is powerful. Take care when vacuuming area rugs or rugs with delicate woven edges.
- To minimize suction, refer to Suction Control section for more information on how to use.

**Brushroll does not spin.**

- If Brushroll Indicator Light on the floor nozzle turns red, the brushroll has stopped spinning. Immediately turn off and unplug vacuum, disconnect the nozzle, and remove blockage before reconnecting and turning vacuum back on.
- If brushroll indicator light repeatedly turns red on carpet, try moving suction release to minimum.
- With the power on, move the handle, which will automatically turn on the brushroll.
- Make sure the carpet height selector is not set to Hard Floor.

**Vacuum turns off on its own or indicator light flashes red.**

- This vacuum is equipped with a motor-protective thermostat. If your vacuum overheats, the thermostat will automatically turn the suction motor off. Perform the following steps to restart the thermostat:

- Turn vacuum off and unplug it.
- Empty dust cup and clean filters (see Maintenance section).
- Check for blockages in hose, accessories, and inlet openings.
- Allow unit to cool for a minimum of 45 minutes.
- Plug in vacuum and turn it on.

- If hose is not fully connected to the pod, it can cause a poor electrical connection and the hose can come loose. Turn the vacuum off.

- Turn vacuum off and unplug it.
- Empty dust cup and clean filters.
- Check for blockages in hose, accessories, and inlet openings.
- Remove cord from cord hook so hose latch can be open and engaged.
- Ensure you hear an audible click at all connection points:
  - Where hose meets back of pod (may require additional force; pull on hose to ensure latch is fully engaged)
  - Where wand plugs into floor nozzle
  - Where handle plugs into wand
- Plug in vacuum and turn it on.

Note: If vacuum still does not start, contact a service center.




### WHAT'S INSIDE:

- (A) Wand
- (B) Motorized Floor Nozzle
- (C) Handle and Hose
- (D) Pod
- (E) Duster Crevice Tool
- (F) Upholstery Tool



### ASSEMBLY

1. Insert **Wand** into **Motorized Floor Nozzle**.
2. Insert **Handle** into wand.
3. Place **Pod** onto wand.
4. Insert **Hose** into pod.
