

Press and hold the $\mathbf{0}$ button to turn speaker ON. The speaker will automatically enter pairing mode. On your smart device, in Bluetooth settings search pairing name:

Press and hold **U** button to turn off.

TWS PAIRING MODE FUNCTION

- 1. Quick press the **U** button two times, enter in to TWS pairing mode. When it is in pairing, indicating light flash quickly. After successfully, indicating light steady on.
- 2. When there is an incoming call, the main unit will have a ring, vice unit no ring.
- 3. It has a memory, after turn off it and turn on it next time, TWS pairing function is till valid.
- 4. Quick press it two times again to exit TWS pairing mode.

HOW TO OPEN THE RUBBER STRAP

- 1. Please press A to left side, the inside clip will be a little loose, better top open it.
- 2. After action 1, please open the rubber strap to the right side, now you can open it easily.
