



Installation


1 Preparing the Tripod

- □ Hit the release button (I) against the ground to open the tripod legs (H).
- □ Lift the lamp head (F) and pull the telescopic pole (G) to the required height.



2 Positioning the Light


- □ The Lamp head (F) can rotate 360° horizontally.
- □ The Lamp head (F) can rotate 180° vertically from hinge (J).



Installation (continued)

3 Lamp head Assembly (Optional)

- Remove lamp head (F) from the tripod by rotating the lamp head (F).
- The magnet integrated (K) on the base of the light can attach to any iron-based metal surface.

How to Recharge





WARNING: Keep the USB-C cover closed when not in use or used in wet locations.



NOTE: Charge this light before first use.

- When battery indicator light (D) shows one bar, the light should be charged.
- Remove the silicone USB-C cover and USB-C charger cord into the USB-C port (E). The charging voltage is 5V 2A, it takes 4 hours to fully charge the light.






Operation (continued)

2 Adjusting the Light

- Press the power button (C) once to turn the light on high mode (800 lumens output).
- Press the power button (C) again for medium mode (400 lumens output).
- Press the power button (C) a third time for low mode (200 lumens output).
- Press the power button (C) a fourth time for light flicker (flashing mode).
- Press the power button (C) a fifth time to turn the light off completely.



Care and Cleaning



WARNING: Always make sure that the worklight is cooled down before attempting to clean it.

- $\hfill\Box$ Clean the lamp head, lens cover, and lamp stand regularly with a non-abrasive cleaner.
- Allow the work light to cool down completely before storing.
- □ Store in a safe place, out of the reach of children.

Troubleshooting

Minor problems often can be fixed without calling customer service.

Problem	Possible Cause	Corrective Action
The light does not work.	□ No electricity.	□ Ensure the fixture is charged.
	□ The power button is turn off.	□ Ensure the power button turns on.
Tripod cann't fold or release.	 Foreign matter in the telescopic pole of the tripod. 	 Clean the foreign matter in the telescopic pole of the tripod.
	 The release button of the tripod isn't pressing hard enough. 	$\hfill \Box$ Need to press the release button hard enough.
