Quick Start

Pair & Connect

Pair refers to the first time sync with a device. If wirelessly paired with a 2nd device thereafter, the stored into of the 1st device will be erased, new pairing has to be done to work with the 1st device.

Connect refers to the operation linking to an ever paired device, whose device info has been stored in the controller automatically.

Charge the battery

The controller can be charged via type C USB cable on DC power supplies (output Voltage 5V, current ≥ 250mA) including but not limited to:

- mobile phone charger
- Switch dock
- computer
- others with USB electricity output, like power bank

The controller supports playing during charging. The 4 LED lights stay lit once full charged.






Connect to Switch








Connect to Android




1-4 2-2 Once succeed, light stays on.

Connect to PC


Option 1: USB

Note:


Press and hold \otimes + \otimes until lights run.

Turn on Bluetooth, add the device "GamepadX".

Work as Bluetooth XINPUT device in Windows, and Xbox One Controller in Steam.

Option 3: Bluetooth (Switch)








Press and hold (+ B until lights run.

Turn on Bluetooth, add the device "Pro Controller".

Work as Nintendo Switch Pro Controller in Steam. Not work in Windows itself.

Connect to iOS



Press and hold (+ Y until lights run.

Turn on Bluetooth, connect the device "Xbox Wireless Controller". Same on Apple TV and Mac.
