PAIRING YOUR PRODUCT

1.Place device within 10 m of bluetooth enabled device.

2.Press the ON/OFF button to turn on the speaker. You will hear a "beep" sound. The speker body will light up, indicating that it is ready to pair.
3.Follow the instructions of your device to search for the device.
4.The bluetooth pairing name is "BT-SPEKER".
5. LED lights will flash according to music.

BATTERY CAUTION
