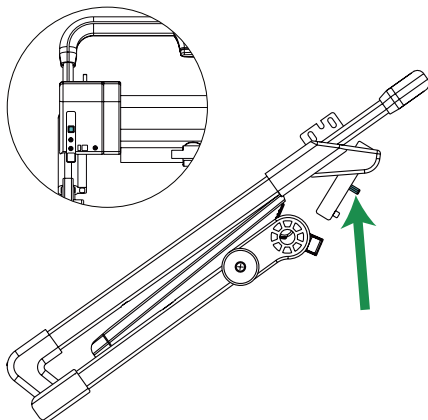

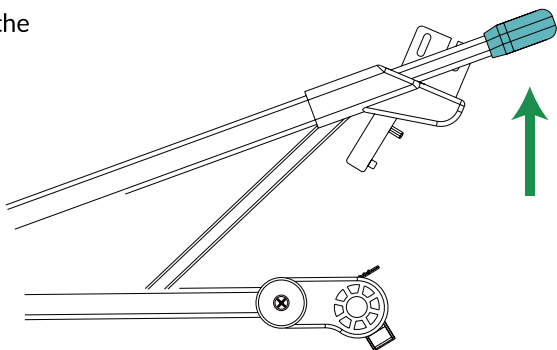

Assembly instructions

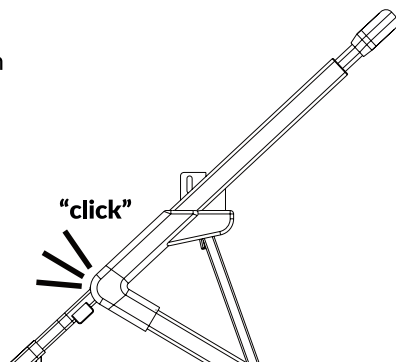
- 1** Lift the release button to unlock the pushchair frame.



- 2** Lift the handle to open the pushchair frame.

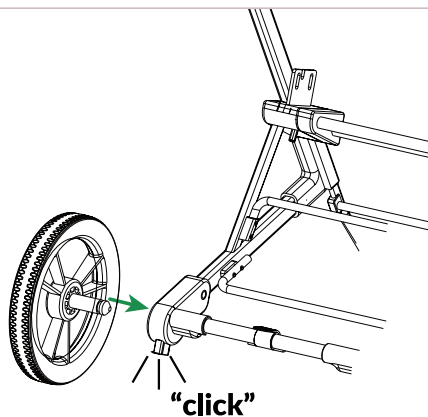


- 3** When the frame is opened you should hear a “click” sound on both sides of the frame. Please check that the pushchair frame is locked safely into position before use.



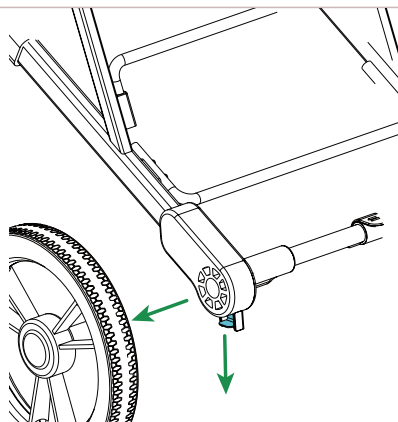
4 Assemble the rear wheels

Take one of the rear wheels and insert it into the plastic hole in the rear axle until it clicks into position. Repeat for the other side.



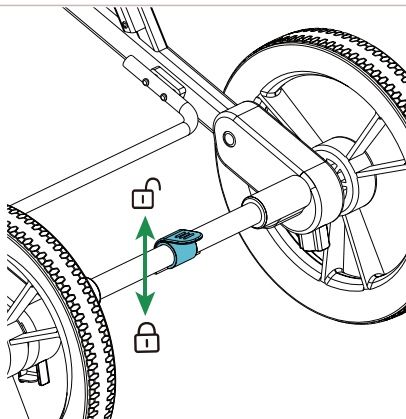
5 Remove the rear wheels

Pull the rear wheel release knob and remove the wheel by pulling it outwards.



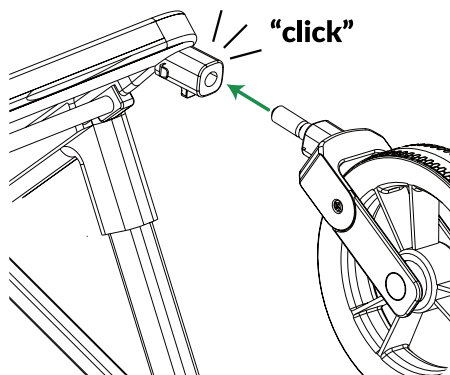
6 Apply the brake

Step down on the brake pedal. Lift the pedal to release the brake.



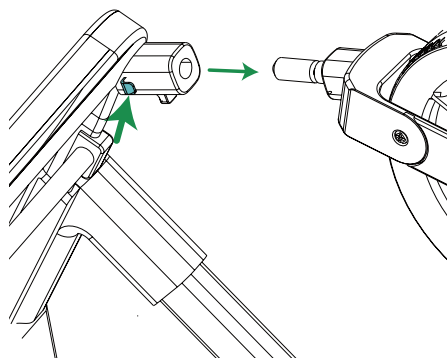
7 Assemble the front wheels

Take one of the front wheels and insert it into the plastic hole in the front frame until it clicks into position. Repeat for the other side.



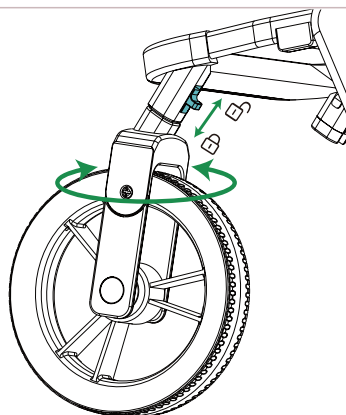
8 Remove the front wheels

Press the small metal pins as shown and at the same time pull out the wheel.



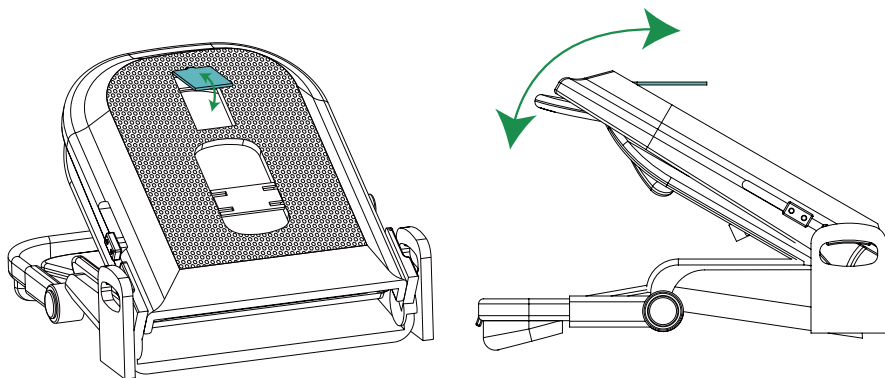
9 Locking the front wheels

Lift up the plastic button on the front wheels to lock into a fixed position. Press down the plastic button to release it, allowing 360° rotation.



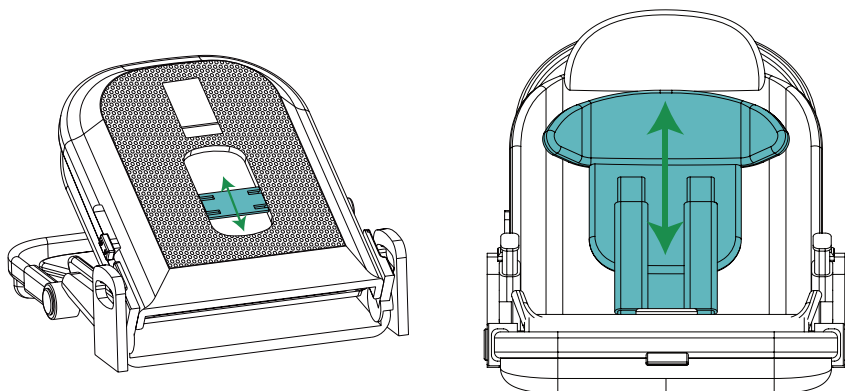
10 Assemble the seat

Pull up the lever on the top of the seat back to open the seat and to fold open the seat.



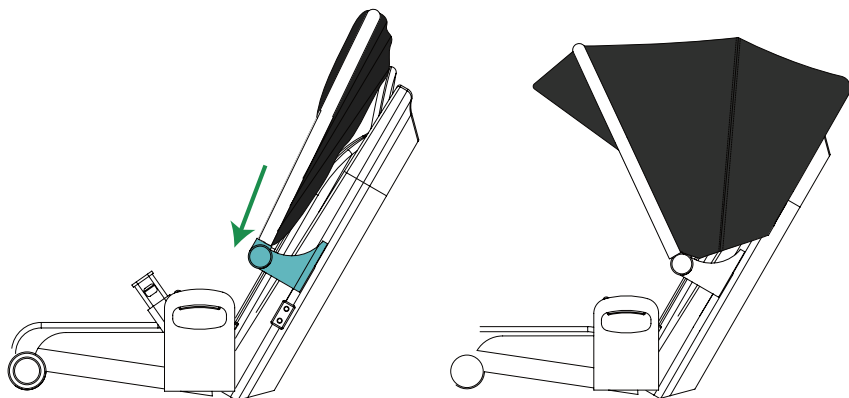
11 Canopy height adjustment

Press the button on the back side of the seat unit to adjust the height of the canopy and head rest. The height can be adjusted to 3 different positions.



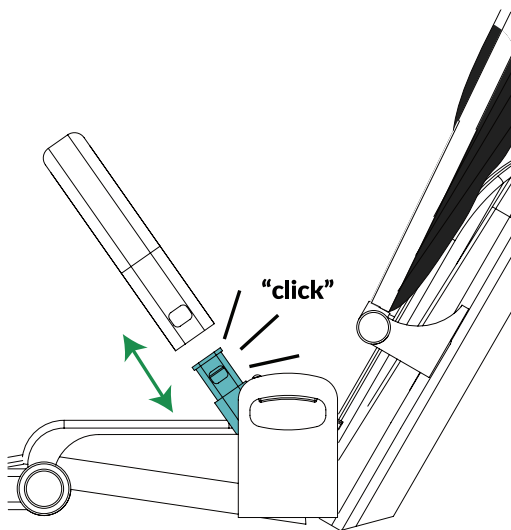
12 Assemble the canopy

Insert the hood plastic into the seat.



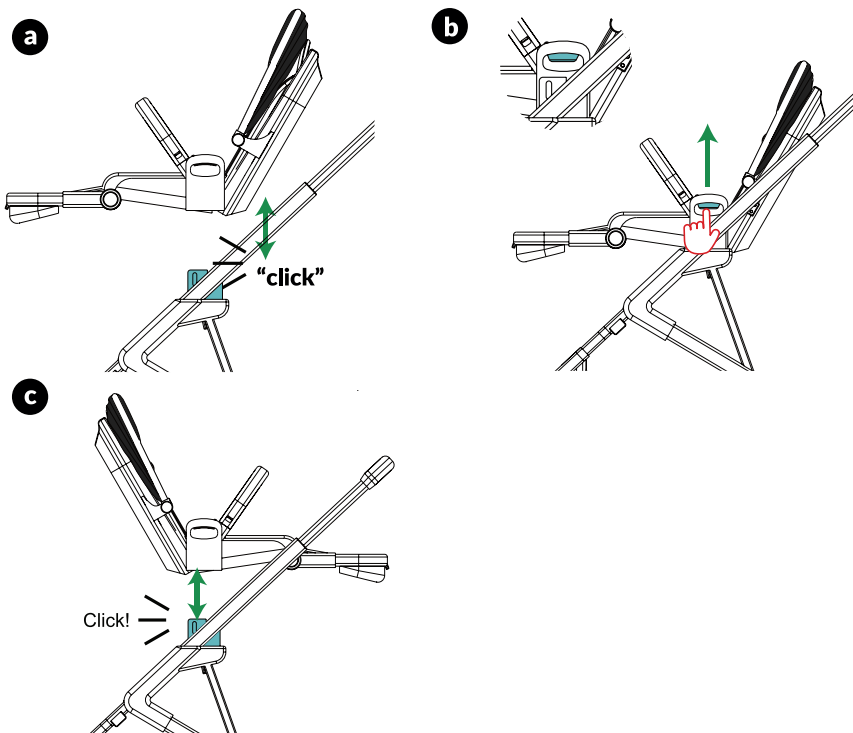
13 Assemble the bumper bar

Insert the bumper bar on both sides of the seat. Make sure to lock the bumper bar into place by hearing a “click” sound from both sides.



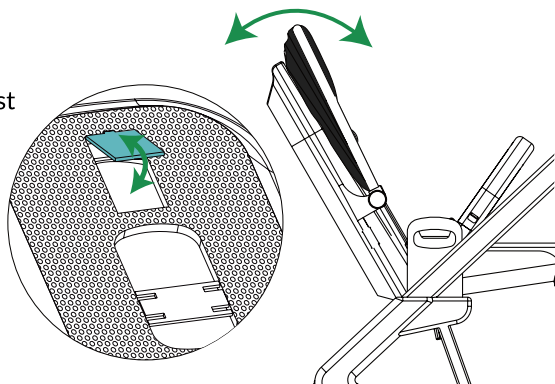
14 Assemble the seat

Click the seat onto the frame, making sure to hear a “click” sound from each side to let you know it is securely attached (a). To remove the seat press the button on each side and lift at the same time (b). The seat can be clicked back onto the frame facing the opposite direction (c)



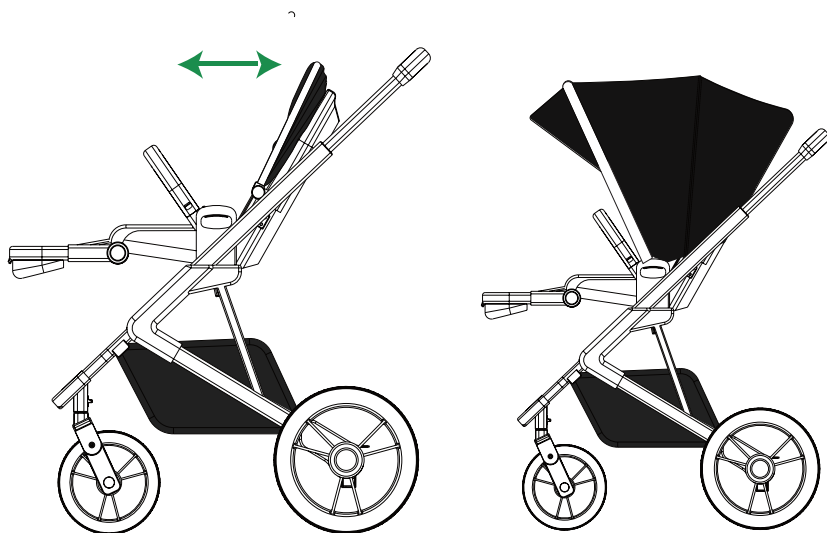
15 Seat recline

Pull the lever on the back of the seat to adjust the backrest position. There are 3 recline positions.



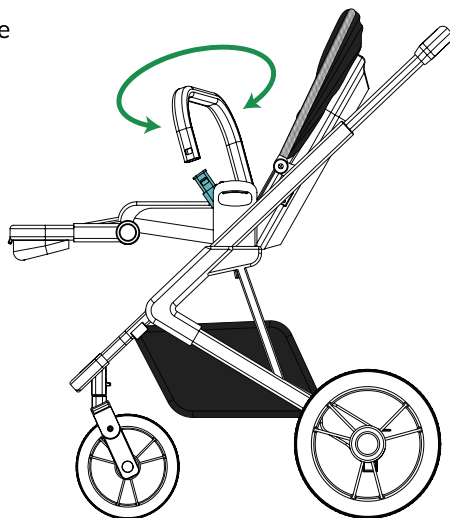
16 Adjust the canopy

The canopy can be pulled out to extend it and pushed back in to fold it back.



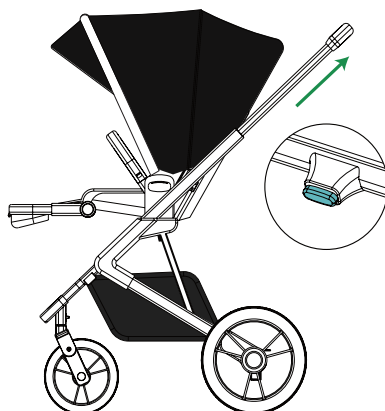
17 Bumper bar

Unlock and pull out one side of the bumper bar to rotate it 360°



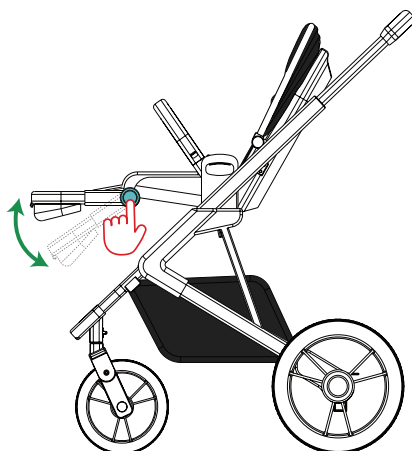
18 Adjust the handle height

Press the button on the handle to extend it.



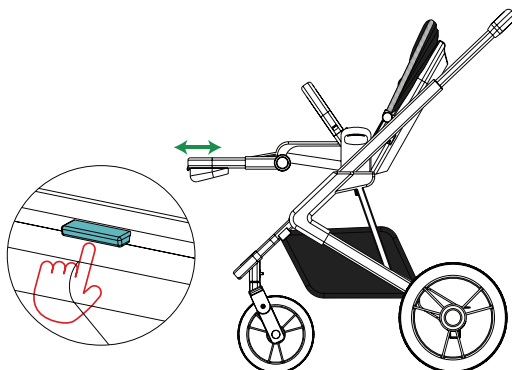
19 Adjust the foot rest

Press the buttons on the sides of the foot rest and move it into your desired position. There are 3 different foot rest positions.



20 Extend the foot rest

The length of the foot rest is adjustable. Push the button under the footrest and pull to make it longer. To reduce the length, press the button and push the foot rest in.

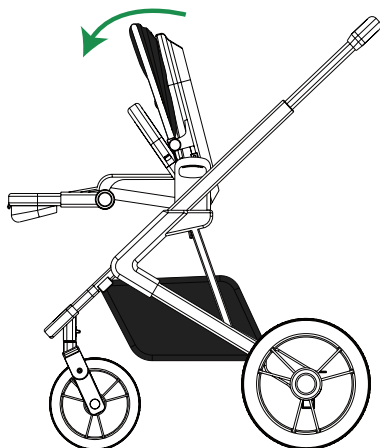


Folding the pushchair

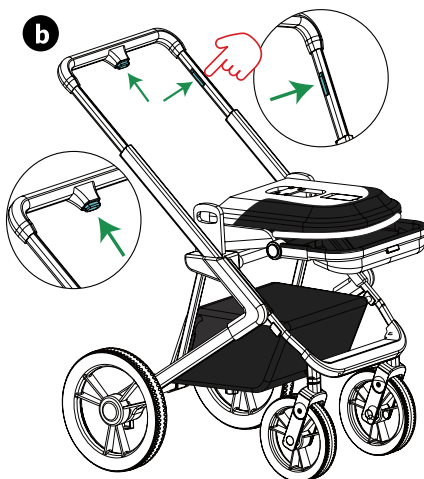
1 Folding the pushchair with seat world facing

- (a) Fold the seat forward using the recline lever on the back of the seat.
- (b) Press the second lock and at the same time press the handle adjust button, then push down the handle with a little force to unlock the pushchair.
- (c) - (d) Press the handle adjust button to lower the handle down, once the pushchair is folded completely you will hear a “click” sound. The pushchair can stand after folding.

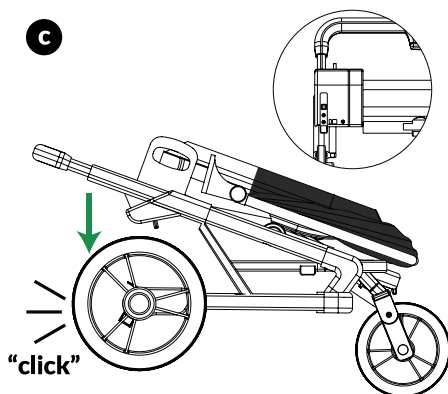

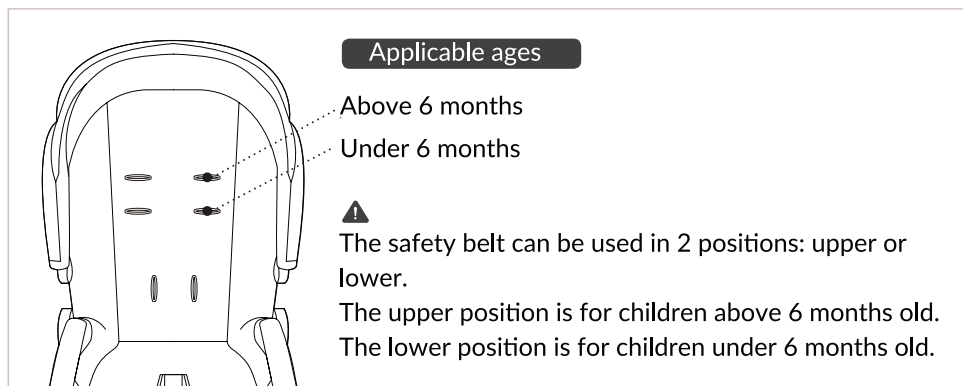


2 Folding the pushchair with seat parent facing

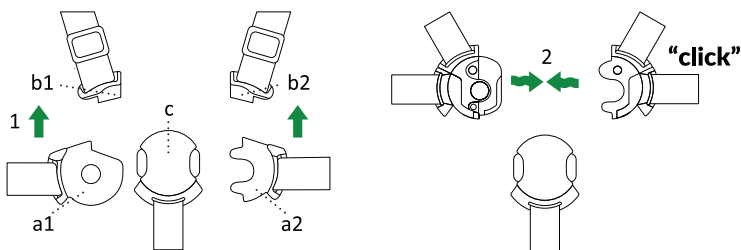
- (a) Fold the foot rest up towards the backrest.
- (b) Fold the back rest and foot rest to a horizontal position.
- (c) Press the second lock and at the same time press the handle adjust button, then push down the handle with a little force to unlock the pushchair.
- (d) Press the handle adjust button to lower the handle down, once the pushchair is folded completely you will hear a "click" sound. The pushchair can stand after folding.



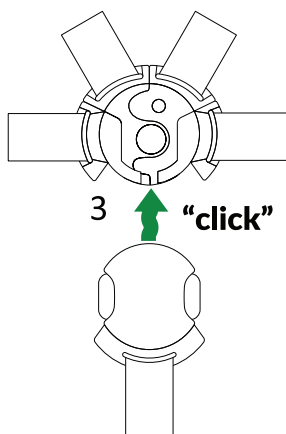

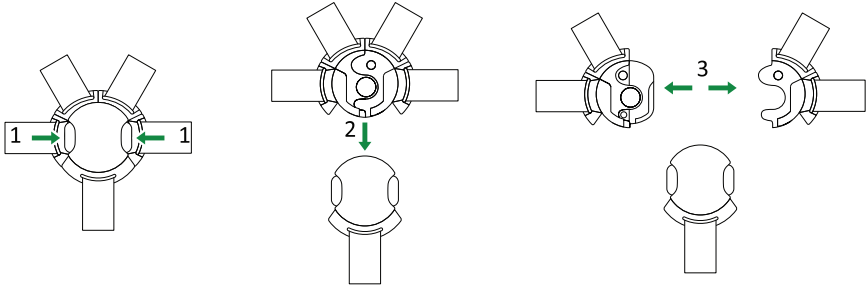
- 1 Insert part **b1** into part **a1**, insert part **b2** into part **a2**, a “click” will indicate that they are attached correctly.



- 2 Place part **a2** on top of part **a1**, place the buckle component “**c**”, as shown in the image above on top of the combined parts **a1+a2**. A click will indicate they are attached correctly

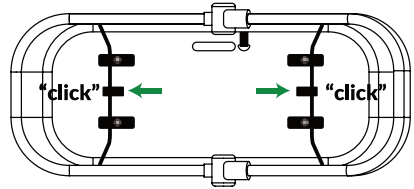
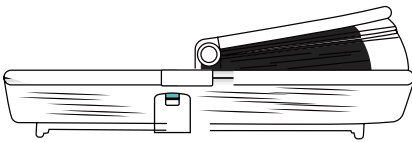


- 3** To release the buckle, press the buttons on either side.

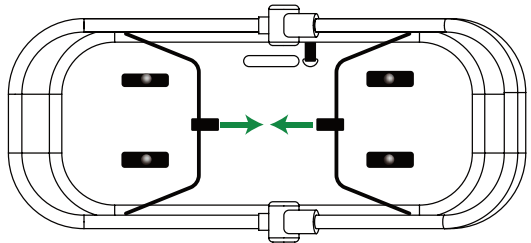


Assemble the carrycot

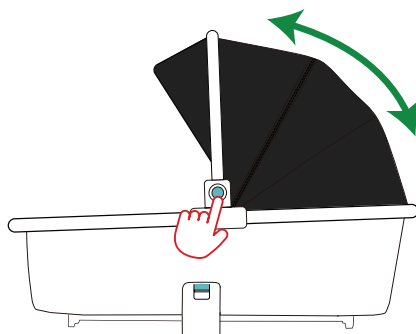
- 1** Remove the bedding and the mattress and then squeeze the metal tensioners on the bottom plate of the carrycot body in the direction shown until they lock into the special holders. You should hear a click sound once in place.



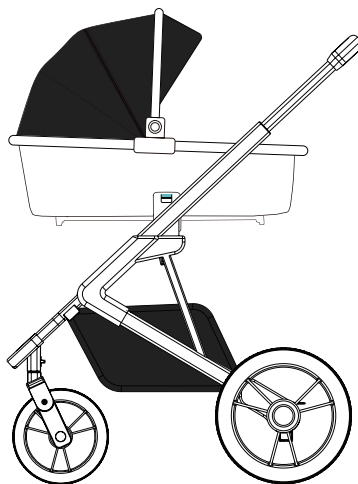
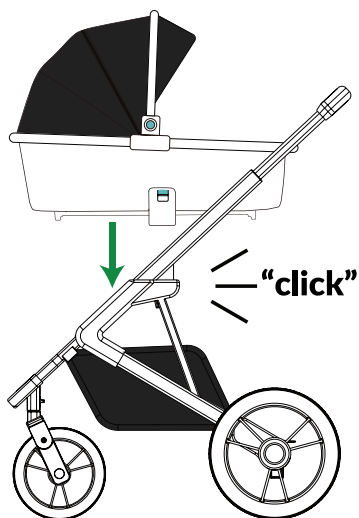
- 2** Reverse the above steps to collapse the carrycot down flat.



- 3** Press the buttons on either side of the carrycot canopy to adjust the canopy position. There are 4 different positions.

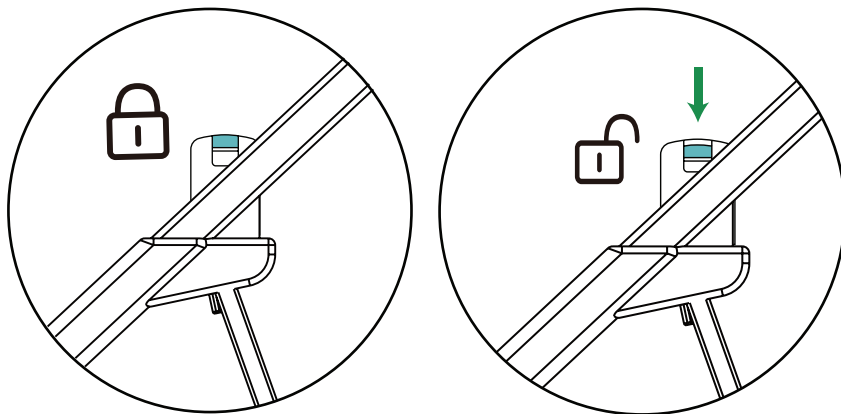


- 4** Place the carrycot onto the frame. You will hear a “click” sound to mean it is secured in place. Make sure you check the carrycot is properly secured onto the frame before use.



5 Removing carrycot from the frame

Press down the memory buttons on either side of the carrycot one by one. Then lift the carrycot up to remove from the frame.



NOTE

The carrycot is designed for children up to 6 months old or up to 9kg, who cannot sit, kneel or pull themselves up by themselves.

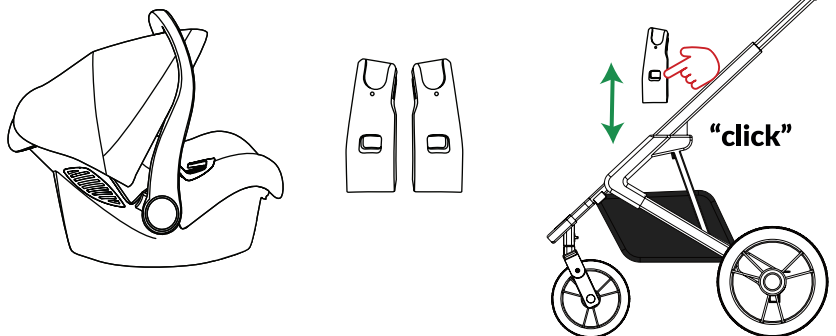
Make sure the carrying handle is locked in the correct position before moving the pram body.

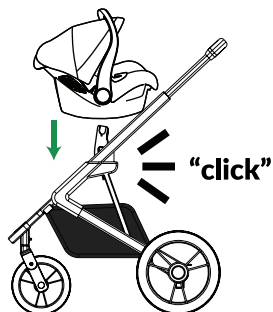
Do not use additional mattresses of thickness of more than 15mm.

Attaching the Car Seat (sold separately)

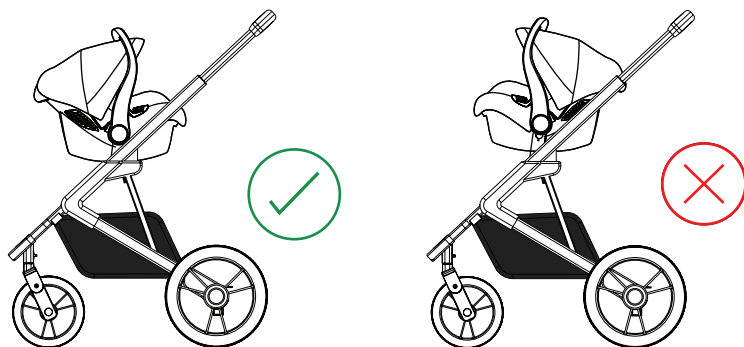
- 1 Take the car seat adaptors and fix them onto the pushchair frame until you hear a click sound meaning they are correctly fitted.



- 2 Align the car seat over the adaptors then push the car seat slightly down onto them until you hear a click sound meaning it is correctly fitted. Make sure you check the car seat is properly secured onto the frame before use.

WARNING: Ensure that all the locking devices are engaged before use.

WARNING: To avoid injury ensure that your child is kept away when unfolding and folding this stroller.

WARNING: Do not let your child play with this stroller.

WARNING: Always use the restraint system.

WARNING: Check that the pram body or seat attachment devices are correctly engaged before use.

WARNING: Do not put hot drinks or liquids in the cup holder.

WARNING: This product is not suitable for running or skating.

WARNING: Do not insert any additional mattresses into the stroller.

WARNING: Accessories which are not approved by the manufacturer shall not be used.

WARNING: This pushchair has been designed for one child and shall be used for the transport for only one child!

WARNING: The parking device shall be engaged when placing and removing the children.

- The product is only suitable for one (1) child.
- The product shall not be used as soon as the child is able to sit by himself, roll over and can push itself up on its hands and knees.
- Maximum weight of the child: 9kg.
- Do not add additional mattress.
- This product is compatible with the chassis of the stroller.
- Only use on a firm, horizontal level and dry surface.
- Do not let other children play unattended near the carry cot.
- Do not use if any part of the carry cot is broken, torn or missing.
- Do not leave flexible carrying handles inside the carry cot
- Never leave your child unattended.
- Only use original replacement parts. It may be unsafe to use substitutes.
- Be aware of the risks presented by an open fire and other heat sources such as electrical heaters, gas flames etc. especially if they are in the immediate vicinity of the carry cot.

Pushchair Do's & Don'ts



Do use your brakes!

Ensure the parking brake is engaged during the loading and unloading of children & when the stroller is stationary.



Do always use the restraint system!

Ensure that the child restraint system is correctly fitted at all times.



Do keep your stroller clean and dirt free.

Use a clean white cloth, warm water and a mild detergent to keep your stroller clean.



Do always keep two hands on the handles when pushing.

You could lose control of your stroller if not steering with both hands.



Do follow manufacturers instructions when assembling and using your stroller.

For safety, please refer to our instruction manuals or contact customer support if you're unsure.



Don't use your stroller up and down stairs!

Don't use your stroller up or down stairs or to bump kerbs.



Don't hang bags off the handles!

Bags and other items should not be hung from the handles as this can affect the stability of the stroller.



Don't run or skate with your stroller!

Our products are not suitable for running or skating.



Don't carry the stroller with baby inside!

Our strollers are not designed to be carried with your baby inside them.



Don't put hot drinks in the cup holder.

Hot drinks burn and can easily spill from the bottle holder.



Don't jetwash your stroller.

Some jet washers are very powerful and could damage parts of your stroller!



Don't leave your child un-attended in their stroller.

Always keep your child and stroller in view to avoid accidents.



Don't treat your stroller like a trolley.

Don't load your stroller up with all your shopping as they are not built for this purpose and could cause damage.



Don't use your stroller as a bumper cart!

Damage can easily occur if your stroller is knocked into other things.

Even with your brakes on your stroller is at risk from tipping or sliding on extreme gradients!



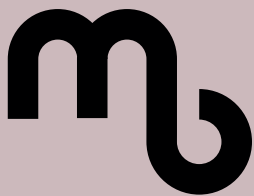
Don't sit in the strollers unless the user is under the guideline weight.
