




### How to use

#### A: Connecting the unit with a TV and making settings on the TV

- Connect the DIGITAL IN port on the unit and the digital output (optical) port on a TV with the supplied optical digital cable.
- Connect the DC IN port on the unit and the USB port on the TV with the supplied USB Type-C® cable.
- Turn on the TV.
- For BRAVIA XR, follow the on-screen instructions to use 3D surround functions. For other TVs, set your TV digital sound setting to PCM. Refer to your TV's instruction manual.

#### B: Pairing the unit with BLUETOOTH® headphones

- When you use the unit for the first time after purchase, the unit is in pairing mode and you do not need to press the # (BLUETOOTH) button.
- Press and hold the # (BLUETOOTH) button on the unit for about 5 seconds. The indicator [blue] on the unit double-flashes to indicate the unit is in pairing mode. When a BLUETOOTH connection is established, the indicator [blue] stops flashing and stays lit.
- For the pairing procedure on the headphones, refer to your headphones' instruction manual.
- Sound volume adjustment of the headphones is not available on the TV. Keep this in mind when you use headphones with no sound volume control feature.





### Connecting the transmitter and a TV


Make preparations for wireless transmission of TV audio from the transmitter to your BLUETOOTH headphones.

- 1 Connect the **DIGITAL IN** (optical digital audio input) port on the transmitter and the optical digital audio output port on a TV with the supplied optical digital cable.




- 2 Connect the **DC IN** port on the transmitter and the **USB** port on the TV with the supplied **USB Type-C®** cable.

While the transmitter is powered and receiving no audio signals, the indicator on the transmitter keeps flashing in orange.



When you pair the transmitter with a BLUETOOTH device for the first time after purchase or after you initialize the transmitter (and all the pairing information is deleted from the transmitter), powering the transmitter automatically puts it into pairing mode and the indicator on the transmitter starts double-flashing in blue.



#### Hint

- If your TV is not equipped with a USB power output port, connect the transmitter to an AC outlet with a commercially available USB AC adaptor.

### 3 Turn on the TV and make settings on it.





#### When using a non-BRAVIA XR TV:

Specify PCM as the digital audio output method on the TV.



When any digital audio output method other than PCM is specified on the TV, the BLUETOOTH headphones may fail to output TV audio successfully.

## Connecting the transmitter with BLUETOOTH® headphones

The process to register the information of a target device required for BLUETOOTH connection is called pairing. To use a device in combination with the transmitter via a BLUETOOTH connection, it is necessary to pair the transmitter with devices on an individual basis.

Before proceeding, make sure of the following:


- Bring BLUETOOTH headphones within a distance of 1 m (3.2 ft) from the transmitter.
- Connect the transmitter to a TV or an AC outlet with the supplied USB Type-C® cable.
- To avoid any sudden loud sound output from the headphones, turn down the volume of the headphones.
- Bring the operating instructions supplied with the headphones at hand for reference.

### Note

- Control over the headphones' volume is not available on any TV. Keep this in mind when using headphones without the volume control feature.


### 1 Press and hold the (BLUETOOTH) button on the transmitter for about 5 seconds.

The indicator on the transmitter starts double flashing in blue to indicate that the transmitter is in pairing mode.



### 2 Put your headphones into pairing mode to establish a BLUETOOTH connection with the transmitter.

When a BLUETOOTH connection is established, the indicator on the transmitter stops flashing and stays lit in blue.



If a BLUETOOTH connection is not established, repeat the procedure all over again from step ①.

### Hint

- The above instructions are provided as an example. For details, refer to the operating instructions supplied with your headphones.

## Note

- The transmitter comes out of pairing mode in about 5 minutes and the indicator on the transmitter stops flashing and stays lit in blue. However, when the transmitter has no pairing information, for example when you use the BLUETOOTH function of the transmitter for the first time after purchase, the transmitter remains in pairing mode.  
If the transmitter comes out of pairing mode before you complete the procedure, repeat the procedure all over again from step ①.
- Once the transmitter is paired with the BLUETOOTH headphones, there is no need to pair them again, except in the following cases:
  - Pairing information is deleted in the course of repair work, etc.
  - The pairing information of the transmitter is deleted from the paired BLUETOOTH device.
  - The transmitter is initialized.  
All the pairing information is deleted. Once the transmitter is initialized, it may fail to establish a BLUETOOTH connection with the headphones.


## Listening to TV audio through headphones

You can listen to TV audio through your BLUETOOTH headphones connected with the transmitter via a BLUETOOTH connection.

**1 Connect the transmitter and a TV, and then specify PCM as the digital audio output method on the TV.**

**2 Establish a BLUETOOTH connection between your BLUETOOTH headphones and the transmitter.**

When a BLUETOOTH connection is established, you hear TV audio coming out both from the TV and the headphones.



If no audio comes out, press the (BLUETOOTH) button on the transmitter briefly once.

### Hint

- If no audio comes out when you press the (BLUETOOTH) button, the transmitter may be connected with another BLUETOOTH device. In such a case, terminate the BLUETOOTH connection with the connected device, and then pair the transmitter with the headphones all over again.

**3 Listen to TV audio.**

Wear the headphones and adjust the volume on the headphones.



### Note

- While the headphones are connected with the transmitter, operations with the headphones, such as pausing the current playback content or skipping to the next playback content, are not available.
- Control over the headphones' volume is not available on the TV. Keep this in mind when using headphones without the volume control feature.

## About the BLUETOOTH wireless technology

The BLUETOOTH wireless technology operates within a range of about 30 m (about 98 ft).

### Supported version and profiles of the BLUETOOTH standard

A profile is a set of functions standardized for every characteristic of BLUETOOTH devices. The transmitter supports the following version and profiles of the BLUETOOTH standard.

Supported BLUETOOTH version: BLUETOOTH standard, version 5.0

Supported BLUETOOTH profile:

- A2DP (Advanced Audio Distribution Profile): Enables transmission and reception of high-quality music contents.

### Maximum communication range

Use the BLUETOOTH wireless technology between the transmitter and a device that are located within about 30 m (about 98 ft) from each other.

Maximum communication range may shorten under the following conditions.

- There is an obstacle such as a person, metal, or wall between the transmitter and BLUETOOTH device.
- A wireless LAN device is in use near the transmitter.
- A microwave oven is in use near the transmitter.
- A device that generates electromagnetic radiation is in use near the transmitter.

### Interference from other devices

Because BLUETOOTH devices and wireless LAN (IEEE802.11b/g) use the same frequency (2.4 GHz), microwave interference may occur and result in communication speed deterioration, noise, or invalid connection if the transmitter is used near a wireless LAN device.

### Interference to other devices

Microwaves emitted from a BLUETOOTH device may affect the operation of electronic medical devices. Turn off the transmitter and other BLUETOOTH devices in the following locations, as it may cause an accident.

- Where inflammable gas is present, in a hospital, train, airplane, or a gas station
- Near automatic doors or a fire alarm

#### Note

- To be able to use the BLUETOOTH function, the BLUETOOTH device to be connected requires the same profile as the transmitter's. Note also that even if the same profile exists, devices may vary in function depending on their specifications.
- Due to the characteristics of BLUETOOTH wireless technology, there is a slight delay in playback on the BLUETOOTH device receiving audio or music in comparison to the one sending it.
- The transmitter supports security capabilities that comply with the BLUETOOTH standard to provide a secure connection when the BLUETOOTH wireless technology is used, but security may not be enough depending on the setting. Be careful when communicating using BLUETOOTH wireless technology.
- We do not take any responsibility for the leakage of information during BLUETOOTH communication.
- BLUETOOTH devices to connect with the transmitter must comply with the BLUETOOTH standards prescribed by Bluetooth SIG, Inc., and must be certified as compliant. While they comply with the BLUETOOTH standards, however, there may be cases that connection attempts fail; or operations on the device, contents displayed on the device, or behaviors of the device vary depending on the characteristics or specifications of the BLUETOOTH device.

## No sound/Sound from only one speaker component/Low sound level/Distorted sound/Humming or noise in the speaker output

- While the 3D surround functions are active on the BRAVIA XR™ TV, no audio comes out from the TV. When you want to hear TV audio both from the TV and the BLUETOOTH headphones, deactivate the 3D surround functions.
- When using a non-BRAVIA XR TV, make sure that PCM is specified as the digital audio output method on the TV. For specifying the method, refer to the operating instructions supplied with the TV.
- Make sure that the TV and the headphones are turned on.
- Disconnect the transmitter from the TV and connect it back to the TV. Be sure to plug the cable all the way into the port.
- Make sure that the volume of the headphones is loud enough.
- Pair the transmitter with the headphones all over again.
- Depending on the headphones, changing the preference for the quality for music playback via BLUETOOTH connections is available. In such a case, select the “Priority on Stable Connection” (SBC) preference. For details, refer to the operating instructions supplied with your headphones.
- Make sure that the equalizer function is deactivated on the TV.
- Move the transmitter and the headphones away from a device such as a microwave oven and a wireless LAN access point.


