

Use this device to record audio. When not connected to a mobile phone, turn the switch to the REC position to enable recording.



Charge

It is recommended to use the original data cable to connect the computer for charging. If using adapter, please use power adapter with charging current 1A or below to charge, otherwise it may damage the machine or cause danger. When charged, the dictaphone flashes red; when fully charged, the dictaphone always flashes blue. If the product is not used for a long time, please charge and discharge at least once every three months to prevent battery damage.
