



# Safety & Warnings

- Do not attempt to open, disassemble, or modify the product in any way.
- Ensure the speaker is placed on a stable, flat surface during use.
- Supervise children when using this product. It is not a toy.
- Disconnect the speaker from power before cleaning or when not in use.
- Use a dry or slightly damp cloth to clean the exterior. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Charge the speaker only with the included USB-C cable or an equivalent USB-C charger.
- Avoid listening at high volume for prolonged periods to prevent hearing damage.
- Do not dispose of the product in household rubbish. Please consult local regulations for proper battery disposal and recycling methods.

# Overview



1	Mode button	Press to switch between music modes.		
2	Prev. Track/Volume -	<ul><li>Short press the previous song.</li><li>Press and hold to decrease volume.</li></ul>		
3	Power/Play/Pause	<ul><li>Short press to play/pause current track.</li><li>Press and hold to turn the speaker On/Off.</li></ul>		
4	Next Track/Volume +	<ul><li>Short press the next song.</li><li>Press and hold to decrease volume.</li></ul>		
5	Light button	Press to turn the lights on.		
6	Aux Input	Connect a device using a 3.5mm aux cable.		
7	USB Port	Connect a USB flash drive to play audio files.		
8	SD Card Slot	Card Slot Insert a MicroSD card to play audio files.		
9	USB Charging Port	Charge the speaker using the USB charging cable.		

## **Operation**

### **Turning the Speaker On/Off**

Press and hold the 'Power/Play/Pause' button to turn the speaker on/off.

### **Charging the Speaker**

- 1. Connect the supplied USB-C charging cable to the USB charging port.
- 2. Connect the other end of the charging cable to a USB power adaptor (not supplied).
- 3. If the battery is low, the speaker will emit a 'low-power' voice prompt before shutting down
- **4.** During charging the indicator will turn on. When the speaker is fully charged the indicator will turn off.
- 5. If not used for extended periods, recharge the speaker at least once a month.

### **Changing Modes**

Press the 'Mode' button to cycle through available playback modes (Bluetooth, AUX, USB, MicroSD, FM).

### **Bluetooth Connection**

- 1. Turn the speaker on.
- Enable Bluetooth on your mobile device and select 'MQ-M4' from the list of available devices.

### **Aux Input**

Connect your phone, computer, or other audio source to the speaker using the supplied 3.5mm AUX cable. The speaker will switch to AUX mode automatically.

### **USB and MicroSD Card Playback**

Insert a USB flash drive or MicroSD card with supported music files into the corresponding port.

 Supported formats include SBC, MP3, and WMA, with a maximum capacity of 32GB.

### **FM Radio**

- 1. Switch to FM mode by pressing the 'Mode' button until FM radio is selected.
- 2. Press the 'Power/Play/Pause button' to automatically scan and save available stations.

### In FM mode:

- Short press 'Next Track/Volume +' button to skip to the next saved station.
- Short press 'Previous Track/Volume -' button to return to the previous station.

### TWS (True Wireless Stereo) Pairing

- 1. Power on 2 identical speakers and ensure neither is currently paired via Bluetooth.
- 2. Double-tap the 'Mode' button on one speaker to enter TWS pairing mode.
- **3.** Once the speakers are connected, open your mobile device's Bluetooth settings and connect to 'MQ-M4' to use them as a stereo pair.

### **Lighting Function**

Press the 'Light' button to turn the lighting effects on/off.

### **Music Controls**

- Press the 'Power/Play/Pause' button to play or pause music.
- Press 'Next Track/Volume +' button to skip to the next track.
- Press and hold 'Next Track/Volume +' button to increase volume.
- Short press 'Previous Track/Volume -' button to go to the previous track.
- Press and hold 'Previous Track/Volume -' button to decrease volume.
