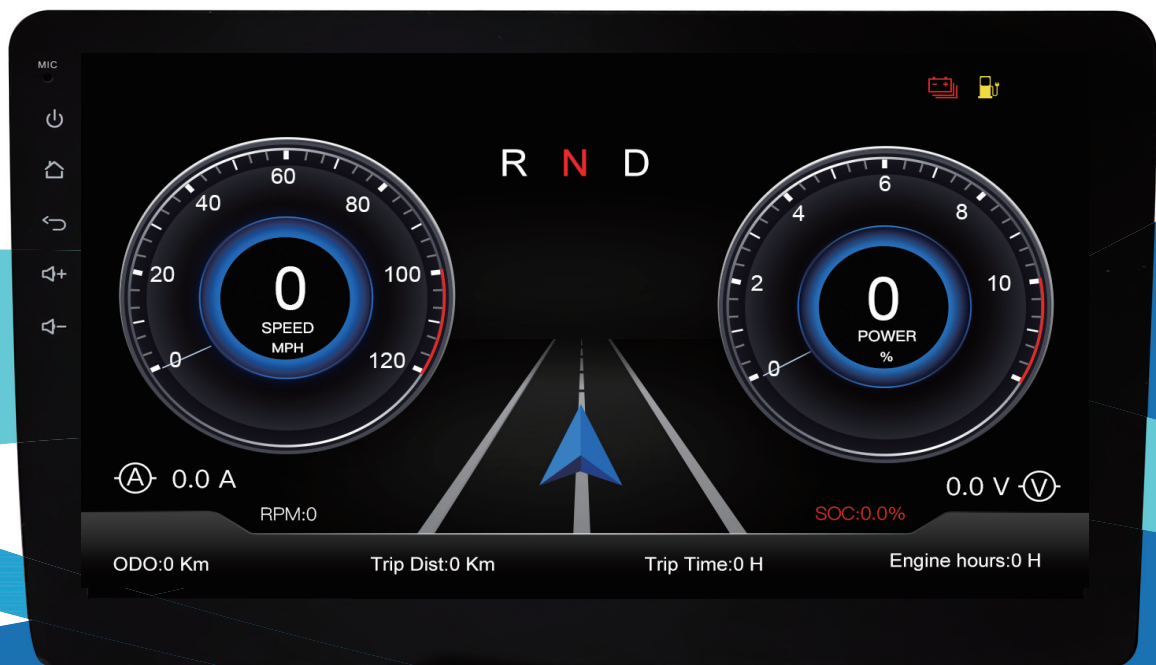

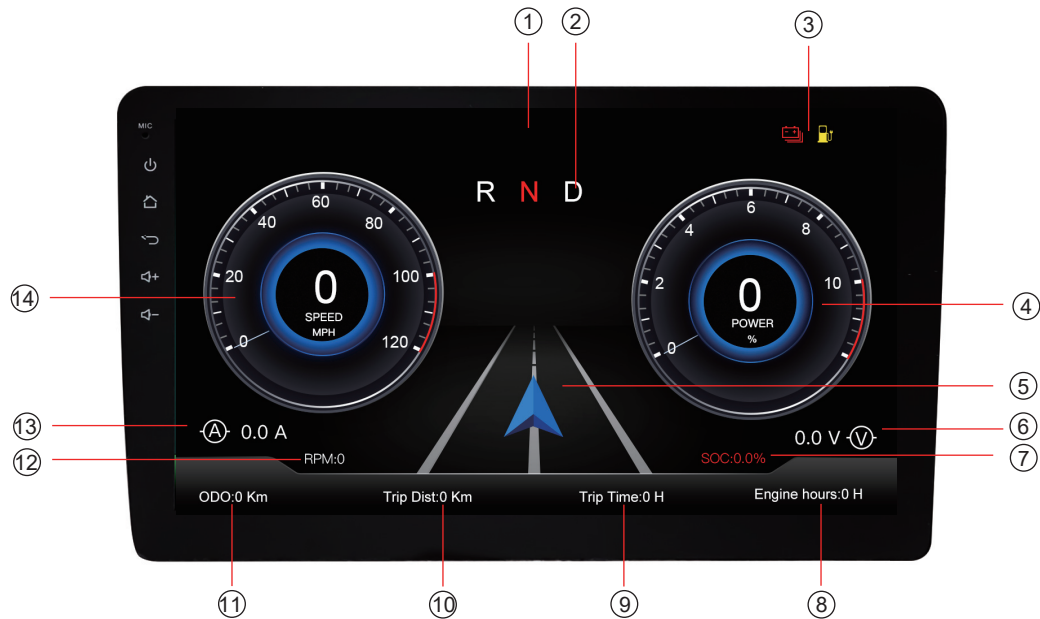

- ① **READY**
- ② **Gear level:** R N D
- ③ **Trouble light:** When there is a fault, the corresponding fault icon is displayed.
- ④ **Power meter:** Power value during operation.
- ⑤ **Car icons:** Click to access the media entertainment system.
- ⑥ **Voltage:** Current operating voltage value.
- ⑦ **Battery capacity:** Remaining battery capacity value.
- ⑧ **Total travelling time:** unit (H)
- ⑨ **Single travelling time:** unit (H)
- ⑩ **Single trip:** unit (Km)
- ⑪ **Total distance travelled:** unit (Km)
- ⑫ **RPM:** Number of revolutions per minute.
- ⑬ **Operating current:** Current operating current value.
- ⑭ **Speedometer:** Speed values during operation.

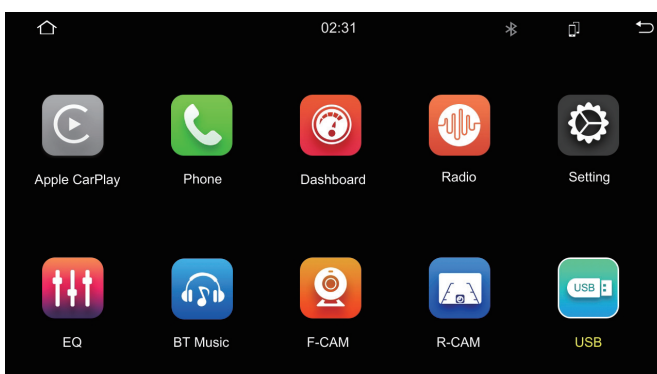
MAIN MENU OPEARATION

Tap the menu button in the home area to display more APP ICONS. Click the back button to return to the previous interface, as shown below:

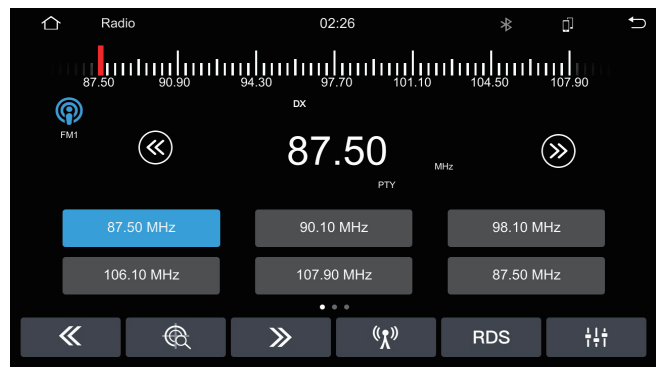

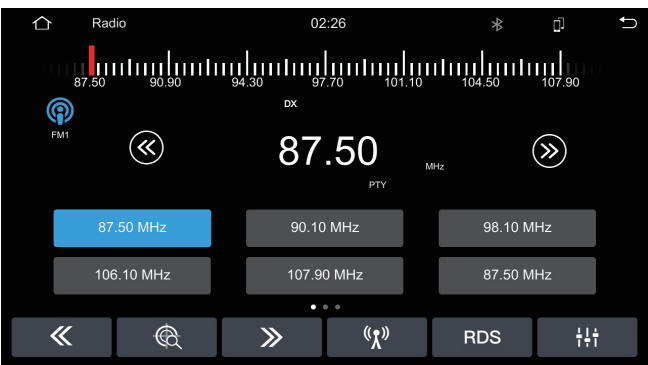

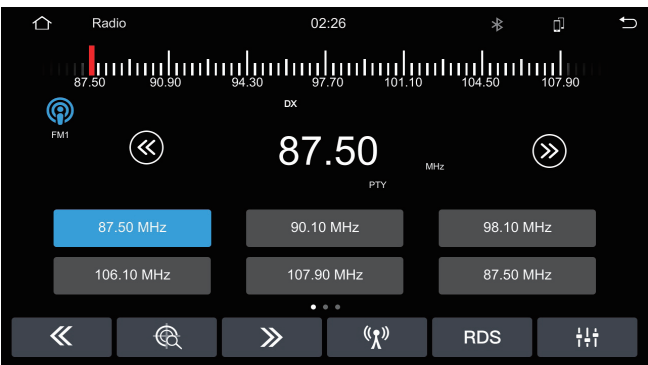

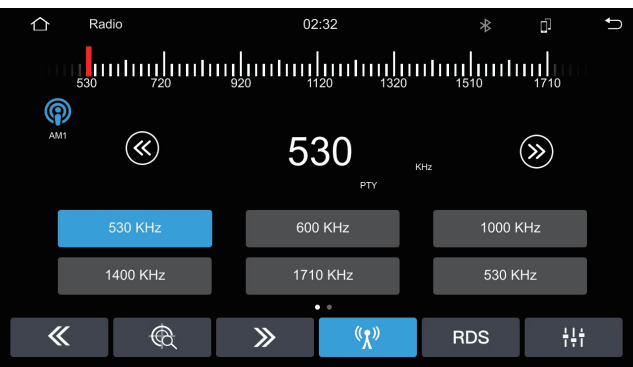

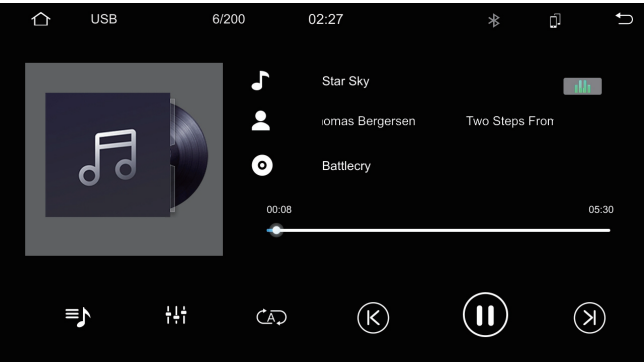
Press and hold the [Q] key for more than 2 seconds, and the searched stations will be automatically saved in the number list on the right.

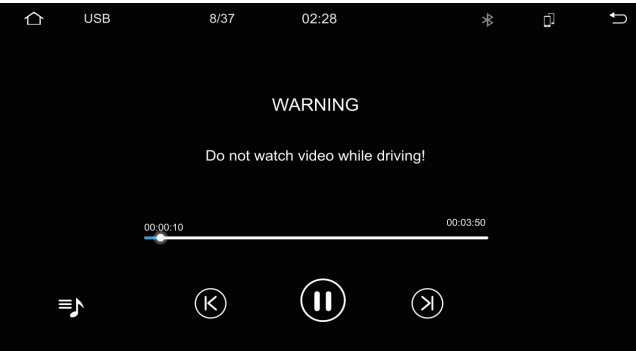

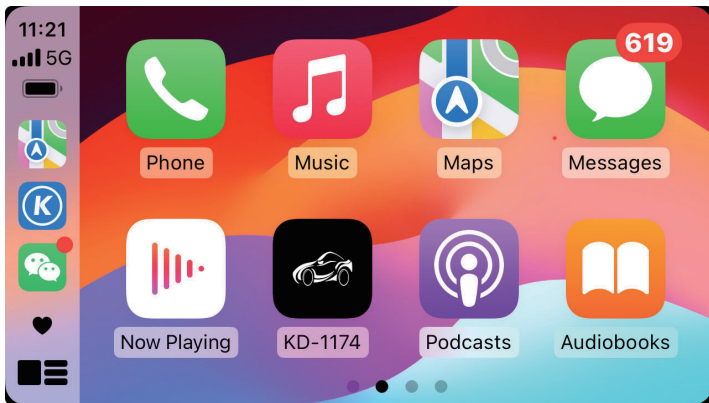
CARPLAY CONNECTION

iPhone support carplay wireless and wired connectivity

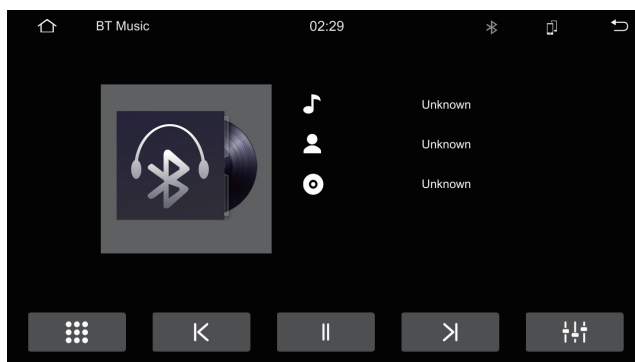
Connect to iPhone

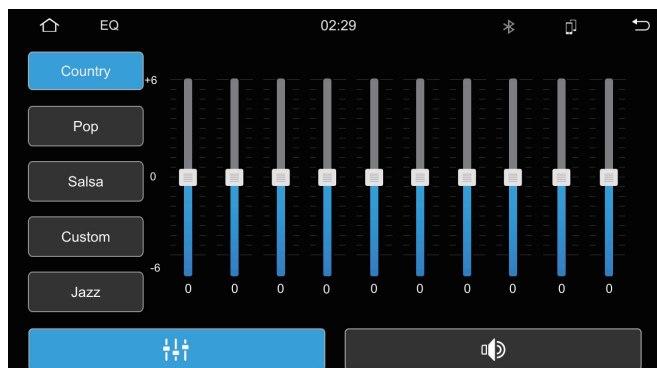

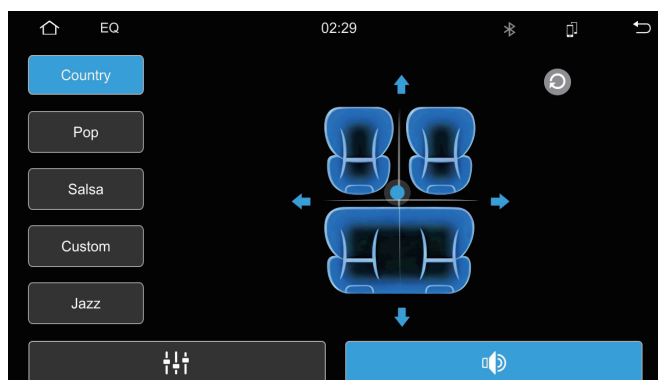



1. Press [] to enter the Homepage

Balance Settings



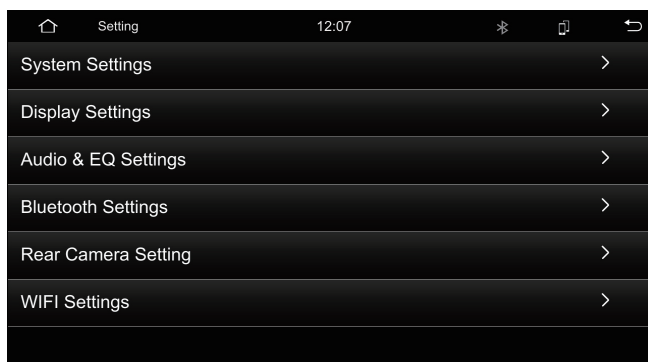

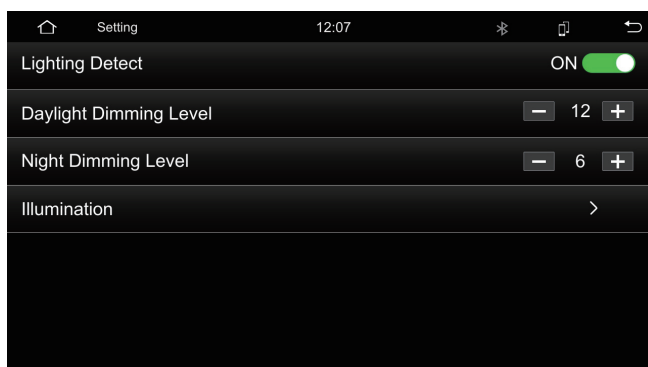

Brightness Setting:

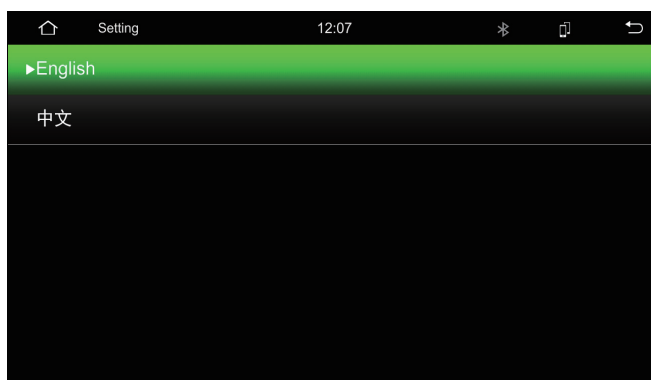
Adjust screen brightness

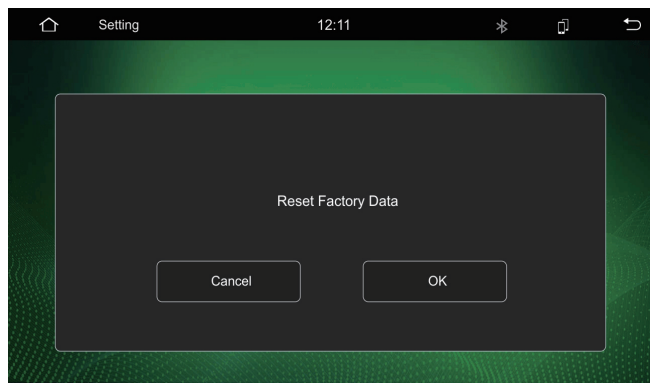
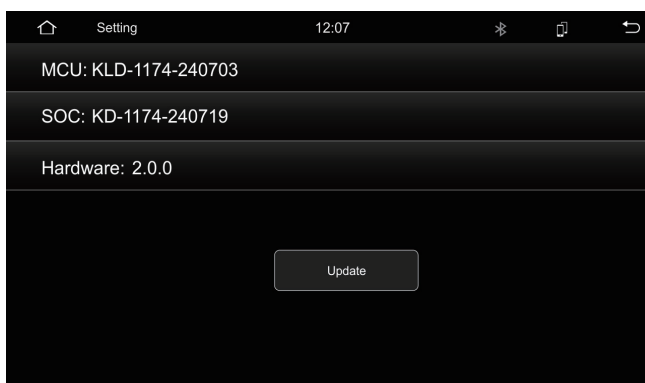

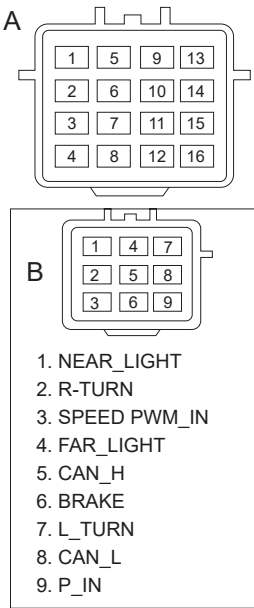
